



Dear Pastor and Church family,

My name is Kannika Tucker. My husband (Tommy Tucker) and I are serving as missionaries in Thailand. I hope you had a wonderful New Year with friends and family. The reason I am writing to you is to ask you to pray about our ladies retreat and to offer you a chance to help out with the expenses. It has been on my heart for a couple years to invite our Thai Pastors' wives and Sunday School teachers on a special retreat. Almost all of our pastor wives work and so do not attend fellowship meetings. The plan is to do a 3 day and 2 night retreat in Pattaya along the beach (of course in Thailand). There will be about 15 ladies (from 8 churches) who have been serving alongside their husbands and teaching Sunday School in local churches.

My goal is to raise \$3,700. This will include rooms, food, gifts, crafts, outdoor activities, and transportation from Bangkok to the resort and back. The ladies will be coming from different parts of Thailand to Bangkok and they will be responsible for their own expenses for that part of the trip. I will be booking the transportation for us to travel from Bangkok to the resort and back together. Lord willing, I plan to hold this retreat April 30-May 2, 2026. It is Memorial Day weekend here in Thailand. At first because of cost we tried to stay away from holidays. Their work schedules made it necessary to use a three day weekend. We want to be an encouragement to our pastor's wives and Sunday school teachers and to create a time of fellowship together.
