Greetings from the UK.

We have hit the ground running ever since we returned from Furlough.

On the discipleship front, every Monday, I have been walking six miles with one of our members as we talk about the things of God and his next step in serving the Lord. With another member, I finished going through the book “Continue” with him right in time for him to move to London, although this was a good reminder that he belongs to God and not us. Furthermore, I have had the opportunity to teach one of our older members to drive, as he is an immigrant and never drove before coming to the UK. The only time I have to teach him is after New Testament survey on Saturday, which has encouraged him to be faithful.

Many of our members have been in church for some time and need to take the next steps in their faith. As such, I spent November and December teaching a class on how to give the gospel. It was not a surprise to find that many of them are nervous, to the point of being paralyzed, about sharing the gospel. As such, once a month, I will take the men into our Junior Church and teach them how to teach. My wife has already been teaching the ladies how to do this, and now it's time for the men to step up. I do not envision the men spending the rest of their ministry in junior church; I simply see it as a stepping stone for them as they learn to bear up the arms of the pastor, and serve in leadership roles at church.

As to outreach, please pray for us as we started our second session of “Twelve Weeks to Freedom” addiction recovery on January 7th. We have posted fliers, done some letterboxing, and put a story in the paper. Praise the Lord, we had one come to the first class. Please pray for us as we try to reach more people for Christ.

On the financial side, this is going to be an expensive year for us. Before Deana and I married, or even dated, Deana leased a car. On March 1st that lease is up, and we will be returning the car. Between now and then, we need to buy a car. In September, my spousal visa must be renewed, but they have a much higher financial threshold for it now than they did when I first applied, so one of us needs to get a part-time job to make sure we reach that financial threshold. It's an odd place to be because we are paying all our bills, but due to this change, we need to have a higher income. Please pray that God blesses one of us with the right job that both meets this need, and lets us reach our community.
