I am currently in the United States, for which I'm extremely grateful. While I was praying I would have opportunity to visit several churches during my time here, but I've found that my resources are needing to be devoted to my visa process. Many of you may remember that I did have a Dominican

visa in 2018, which I then used to begin working on residency. Unfortunately when the pandemic occurred, the government offices shut down, and all of my documents are now expired. Much to my chagrin, I'm being required to begin the process all over again.

I have several things in regards to the process that I would like for you to pray over. First, please pray that the apostille on my background check will be processed and returned quickly. Second, I still have the apostille and official translation of my birth certificate from the first time I applied for a visa.

Please pray that they will accept those documents and not require me to redo them; this will save me time and money. Thirdly, please pray that once I have all the documents and send off the application, that it will be processed quickly. Our school year begins on September 2, and it would be a huge blessing to be able to have my visa in hand and back in San Pedro on time.

Due to small class sizes, in addition to teaching 10th-12th English at Las Palmas, I'll be teaching 8th grade science. Pray for the students I teach, for their learning, but more importantly for their salvation.
