After the hospital doing all they could for her, she was moved to her daughter's home where she was under hospice care for the few days that she had left. Her funeral was held in West Virginia, where her son Bob Hutton officiated the funeral. Your prayers on behalf of myself and family are greatly appreciated. Her daughter and son in law had begun adding an apartment onto their home, so they could help with care for Jeanie, whose health has been declining. It lacks only a couple of weeks finishing; she has seen it, but now won't enjoy it, but she has an even better home now. I will move into the unit when finished. El Camino Baptist Church in Tijuana celebrated the Day of the Child in April. As a result of the church's visitation efforts, the Lord richly blessed with a great report. There were 1375 in attendance, 626 children, and 334 first time visitors. Sixteen buses were hired to provide transportation to the church.

Bro. Omar Avila, pastoring in Zamora, Michoacán, also observed Day of the Child with 38 first time visitors, of which 30 were adults. A mission they also have, had 30 children for the services there. He reports that they have had to discontinue a bible study that they have been having in another area that is plagued with gangs that are fighting over territory. The gunfire has made it too dangerous for them to work in the area. Bro. Omar asks prayer that God may make it possible to raise additional funds needed to purchase a lot to build on. They have raised half of their goal so far.
