JUNE 2026 REPORT

A \$700.00 offering from the WBF Bible Ministry funds enabled one of my first seminary graduates, Pastor Marcial Pavon, to purchase 200 New Testaments in the Miskito language. The Lord worked the miracle that was needed to acquire them. The Honduran Air Force transported them, and helped in the distribution.



The president of Seminario Bautista Logos, Fernando Montt, has been busy since leaving the States while his visa application is being processed. He has preached in churches in Mexico, Peru and Columbia. His schedule also included officiating a student's graduation in Chiclayo, Peru, plus teaching twelve hours in three day modules to a total of 405 students in those three countries. Those efforts have increased the seminary's attendance, requiring the hiring of a full-time secretary at \$350 a month. Pray God provides the \$175.00 that is lacking. Your support enables us to temporarily meet some of that need.



Our radio ministry was the initial contact that resulted in Anibal Fleitas earning his doctor's degree from Landmark Baptist Seminary. He invited me to produce a program on his newly established Radio Fortaleza in Paraguay. My two weekly programs are broadcast seven times a week. At his request the program will emphasize the Great Commission, based on our 58 years of service.

Michael Price is burdened to make his fourth trip to Honduras. Because of his past trips, God burdened him for foreign service. We are planning a trip for August 8-15. Pray some of our fellow church members accompany us. They will be blessed meeting their Honduran brethren.

The recording of my Missiology course will be used in Landmark's English curriculum. In spite of delays due to conflicting schedules, that project is advancing. It was a blessing when a Peruvian pastor told of his wife studying courses I recorded some 25 years ago.

With three fellow members of our church, two services in the local prison resulting in seven men trusting Christ. My burden of some 14 years for such a ministry will be fulfilled when I also have the opportunity to minister to Spanish speaking prisoners. Your prayers will open that door.

When Mountain View's facilities are up to code, it will open for sixteen men. Pray the resoration is soon finished. We trust God will then use us as we minister with the KJV Bible to help addicts find true peace with God.
