**DOMINICAN REPUBLIC
NEW CHURCH BORN**

As Pastor Bobby's unofficial Mission advisor, I helped co-ordinate our church's second mission conference on January 23-26. The Faith Promise increased from \$48,000.00 to \$117,000, plus tithes from the offerings. Souls are saved almost every Sunday that produces a constant attendance growth to 360. Young preacher Michael Price shared his vision for some to join us on an August trip to Honduras.

Seminary graduate Luis Turcios testified as I translated about death threats that forced his family to migrate from El Salva-

dor. His family of five are waiting in Mexico to join him in Woodburn, Oregon, where he is beginning a church.

Veteran missionary to Malawi, David Robinson, listened excitedly about our Baptist International Accreditation Agency. He stated it is an answer to his prayer for such a program. Besides validating his graduates' diplomas, it will also increase enrollment.

Pastor Fernando Montt reported that Seminario Bautista Logos has 125 students in 14 countries, 29 are pastors representing 63 churches. In August there will be 13 graduates. The curriculum is being developed for the new Department of Education to prepare Christian teachers.
