"Yes I do." Wilber said as he lifted his hand as I ask if anyone would like to accept Christ after the message at Iglesia Biblica Bautista en Starke, FL. Wilber is Venezuelan and came to

the U.S. for asylum. A couple of weeks after his decision, he went to Chicago where his family is. He had first visited other countries and came to the U.S. as last resort.

We have a mixed congregation. They are from varios countries. We've had others in the past. **Most have never heard a Gospel Message before**. It's quite a challenge and a great opportunity to be able to convince people to come and hear the message. Having lived in Costa Rica, Peru and Mexico, we are very familiar with the culture. Even though they are in the U.S., they still prefer hearing in their language.

We are praying that Wilber and others who have moved to other States will find a hispanic church to attend. We need more chuches in these populated cities. Pray we will see others surrender to the call to help in these ministries. Praise the Lord for our hispanic pastor friends here in Florida that are reaching out to their own people. Our Fellowship of Hispanic Pastors here is growing. Several new chuches are being established.

The ministry of Rancho La Paloma Youth Camp is definitely a ministry that has served as a place of calling. Lots of youth have been saved and others called into ministry at the Camp. We served 35 years there. Our son Michael has been in charge several years now and has done a great job. However, because of new stipulations having to do with water wells and electricity supplies, the Camp ministry needs funds. Both of these factors have been upgraded and changed since we were there. Permits, etc., have caused some difficulty. The Camp needs funds to help with these things. Please pray and if possible, help with this financial need.
