Dear Prayer Warriors,

March – April 2026

Thank you for your continued prayers especially during this turbulent time and aftermath of the **Category 5 Super Typhoon's destruction**. It was larger than Hurricane Katrina that hit New Orleans in August 2005. Katrina's winds reached 175 mph while Sinlaku's hit us on April 13th and didn't just pass over in a few hours like Katrina did in 6 hours, ours **paused right on top of us for 3 ½ days with sustained winds of over 185mph**. Damage for Katrina was estimated at \$125 billion dollars with 1392 deaths. Although they haven't estimated the damage to our island, we have been without water and electricity for 4 weeks now since it's destruction hit. But thanks be to our God not a single person has died on the island though 6 men are missing out at sea.

In the picture above you can see we've lost the whole roof to our **activities center**. Here is where we held outdoor youth programs and **I store my tools** in the **tool room** (that got completely soaked). It's also where we build all the things we use in the ministry. The roof's 16 cross beams (purlins and struts) all need replaced with the tin roof and wiring for lights. Instead of covering the entire activity center, Lord willing, we're just going to try and cover the tool room, bathroom and supply room measuring 70ft X 55ft which is half of the original roof. Three of the original 8 rigid frame rafters are still standing, thank the Lord! Several of our wonderful churches have come together to help us buy a **solar-powered generator** that will give us electricity for lights, an AirCon and a freezer. The government is replacing poles and transformers as fast as they can but estimates are 2 to 3 months before they get to us. Please pray it goes faster because the heat is extreme at night when we try to rest in 85-100% humidity. Another church has generously sent DeWalt batteries, a few tools and a gas powered generator. I've been able to use solar-powered street lights. I carry them out in the mornings to be charged and back in again at night. Please pray for the safe arrival of the solar-powered generator and for the Lord to continue to supply the rest of the needs. **God has been so GOOD!**

Our building was one of the first to get water. So, we've started a **new ministry** to help everyone we can by giving out free water to all who come to services and drinking water to those in need. Plus, after everyone has enjoyed our Bible study and soup, we opened up our showers. Everyone loves it. This storm has made our Christians more attentive to the needs of their friends and neighbors. I've personally been able to start 6 more Bible Studies on Salvation besides the 5 I'm already doing with folk. Jenny Zhang got saved and another young man is struggling with surrendering to God and eternal security. After the storm, everyone is eager to talk about God and heaven.

Please pray for: 1) More souls saved; 2) Jing Jing and her son, Titus, who is undergoing a major surgery; 3) Gloria's pinhole surgery on her leg has been scrapped out 3 times and it's still not closing after 5 weeks. 4) God to continue to supply our rebuilding needs.
