Dear Mission Partners,

Marie and I thank God for your faithful prayers and support. Through your partnership, we continue to serve in Haiti and the Dominican Republic, and among the Haitian community in Florida.

Teaching Beyond Our Physical Reach: Over the past several months, I have devoted a significant portion of my time to preparing Bible study materials for Sunday School classes, ladies' groups, men's groups, home Bible studies, and personal devotions. The studies are being developed in English, French, Spanish, and Haitian Creole to serve believers across multiple countries and cultures.

For years, several Haitian pastors have encouraged me to put into writing many of the lessons and training materials I have taught in churches, conferences, and discipleship seminars. After much prayer, I concluded that this would be an effective means of advancing the Gospel. While preaching and teaching allows us to minister to those before us, written materials can continue strengthening believers long after a conference has ended or a missionary has left the field. As I work on these studies, I am often reminded of the Apostle Paul, who continued to teach and disciple churches through his letters when he could not be physically present with them. Though no writing can compare with the inspired Scriptures, his example shows how God can use written instruction to strengthen His people across great distances. My prayer is that these study books will come to fruition and help equip believers and church leaders for Christ's mission for years to come. I would also like to express gratitude to my longtime friend and ministry partner, the pastor of Victory Baptist Church in Texas, for his generous donation of a brand-new desktop computer. This gift has become an invaluable tool in preparing these materials and will help extend their reach for Christ's glory.

Discipleship for Haitians in the Dominican Republic and Tampa: I was recently in our ministry in the Dominican Republic, where doors remain wide open for discipleship and leadership training. Similar training sessions are also being conducted here in Tampa. The believers in the D.R. have a strong hunger for God's Word and a deep desire to share the Gospel through personal witness, by telephone, on social media, and in every opportunity the Lord provides. What has especially encouraged me is seeing how interconnected this ministry has become by God's grace. From Haiti to the Dominican Republic and Florida, believers are helping strengthen one another. I have also discovered that several church leaders in the Dominican Republic were once members of churches we planted in Haiti. It has been a demanding but rewarding season of ministry, and we are encouraged by the hunger for God's Word among pastors, church leaders, and believers who desire to grow in Christ and serve Him more effectively.

- The orphanage children and for God to reopen the door for us to minister in person in Haiti once again.
- Our churches, and other churches and missions affected by gang-controlled territories in Haiti.
- Our church in Tampa is looking for a larger meeting place.
- Pastor Daniel in the Dominican Republic, who urgently needs housing for he and his wife Viviane and their four children. Also for the church as it seeks financial assistance to complete the purchase of its land.

Thank you for your monthly support and continued prayers as we seek to advance the Gospel among the Haitians wherever God opens a door.
