Dear Mission Partners,

We thank the Lord for another season of ministry and for your faithful partnership in the Gospel.

Training the Next Generation

In recent months, I have continued to conduct discipleship and leadership seminars in both the Dominican Republic and Tampa, Florida. It has been a demanding but rewarding season as we seek to equip believers to grow in God's Word and serve their churches more effectively.

The Bible study curriculum I mentioned in my previous letter continues to develop steadily. It will take time to complete, but we trust the Lord will use these resources to strengthen believers and equip future generations long after our personal ministry opportunities have passed.

A Special Need in the Dominican Republic

I covet your prayers for Pastor Daniel and the church in the Dominican Republic. Daniel has been part of our ministry team for many years. He was among the men we disciplined and ordained as pastors. He later became an important member of our church-planting team in Croix-des-Bouquets, Haiti. That ministry was eventually forced to close when most of the residents fled the town after the 400 Mawozo gang invaded it, the same ruthless gang responsible for the widely publicized kidnapping of 16 American missionaries and 1 Canadian missionary in Haiti on October 16, 2021.



Yet God, who knows the future and orders our steps, had already prepared another field of ministry. The Lord opened a fruitful door for us among the large Haitian population living in the Dominican Republic. Once again, we are reminded

that God continues to build His church even when circumstances seem to move in the opposite direction. Today, Pastor Daniel and the congregation have an opportunity to secure the property on which this ministry is being established. The believers have made great sacrifices and have made remarkable progress toward purchasing the land. Currently, they need \$7,804 to meet their current obligation and place the remaining balance on a manageable three-year payment plan. Owning this property would provide long-term stability for the church and strengthen its ability to minister to the community for years to come.

We ask that you join us in prayer, asking our God to open the doors and provide the financial resources needed for this congregation to secure its property for the glory of Christ and the advancement of His Gospel.

- The orphanage children and for God to reopen the door for us to minister in person in Haiti once again.
- Churches affected by gang-controlled territories in Haiti.
- Our supported church in Tampa is seeking a larger place of meeting.
- Pastor Daniel in the Dominican Republic, who urgently needs housing for he and his wife Viviane and their four children. Also for the church as it seeks financial assistance to complete the purchase of its land.

Thank you for your monthly support and continued prayers as we seek to advance the Gospel wherever God opens a door.
