## Missionaries to the UK

Greetings from the UK.

In recent months, the Lord has led us to Scotland, where we will be church planting in Glenrothes. We are very much looking forward to this work, as we will be able to do much more to reach the local community simply because Glenrothes Free Baptist Church has its own property in the middle of a residential area. Many, if not most, missionaries in the UK serve in ministries where they do not have their own property, so they rent a building, or a room in a building, for a few hours a week to hold services. Having a property opens a lot of doors and gives us opportunities we just didn't have before.

With that said, we left Peacehaven Baptist Church on an exciting note. In the final weeks that I was there, I was going through the Romans road with our people verse by verse. I was explaining how each verse dealt with a different aspect of the gospel, and although the Roman Road is not exhaustive, it is a good starting point for giving the gospel. During this time, I had our members practice going through the Romans road with each other. One of the six-year-olds, Christina, watched her mom give the Romans road to several other ladies in the church. Sometime after the last lesson, she asked her mom about it, and her mom was able to lead her to Christ. We learned about this on our last Sunday at Peacehaven Baptist Church.

Although we are glad to give you two pieces of good news, we do have some sad news. While Deana and I were visiting Glenrothes, Deana had a miscarriage at twelve weeks. When we were at the hospital, I was surprised to learn that twelve weeks was considered very early in a pregnancy. The hospital let us know that they have a service for the lost little ones on the last Thursday of every month, where the little ones will be cremated. Although we grieve for this little one, we are content that one day we shall meet them in heaven, as David talked about going to meet his little one in II Samuel 12:23. If things go as planned on Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, Deana and I will meet with other grieving parents, and we pray for the opportunity to tell them how they can one day see their children.

Please keep us in your prayers in the coming days, both with our witness and our responsibilities at this new church.
