In October, **Primera Iglesia de Vista Catalina** baptized three young men, Isidro, Alex, and David, who have been a part of the youth ministry. The church had a missions emphasis month which included a trip to the sugar cane village to evangelize and hand out food and clothing. November was a focus on the nuclear family which included a family retreat. Some were able to bring lost friends and family members where the Gospel was presented.

Building Update: The final building permit has hit a snag. After meeting with government officials, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development says we need space for fourteen more parking spaces. This means we are in search of an adjoining lot or one close by. They are at odds with the Tourism Ministry who said we were fine since there is a public park across the street where people can park. Please help us pray we can acquire the lot soon.

Family Update: Toward the end of September, Flor was called in for her US Citizenship interview. The decision was delayed indefinitely, so we brought the boys to the U.S. to await the decision. Finally on November 15th, Flor was sworn in as a U.S. citizen! We thank all of you for your prayers regarding this matter. It has been a great lesson in patience, as well as remembering that life can change in an instant. Flor had to wait a couple of weeks after to get into the Social Security Office to make the change of status. We are currently in Mexico attending to paperwork and family matters. On December 18th, we will finally be returning to the DR!

God has been so good to us during these strange times. We greatly appreciate your prayers and support. Make sure to get some rest and enjoy family as we close out the year.
