Dear Pastor and Church,

October - November 2025

The first week of October (Monday-Wednesday) we had the Independent Baptist Fellowship of Thailand meeting at Bang Chak Baptist Church. I was to be the first speaker and ended up sick. I missed the whole meeting. Two other speakers followed my example. Praise the Lord, the morning sessions went well - from what I heard.

We had a one night church camp (October 12-13) for the church 31st anniversary. We left after Sunday morning services for the two hour trip to the resort. We had three seminars of three sessions each. I taught Bible Study Methods. The best session dealt with those who are the only Christian in a family or work place. There is a lot of cultural pressure especially during holidays, weddings and funerals.

In 2024 as I deliberated on how to expand the Bible Institute I began to consider teaching a class Sunday afternoon between services from 1:15 to 3:30. Since then we have taught 3 classes with 15 to 20 students a class. We have had students from 2 other churches participating. We will start Life of Christ 1 after the first of the year. We also have done block courses in Huey Saa. Block courses are one week duration. Usually start Monday late afternoon. Tuesday through Friday classes run 8:30 to 17:00.

We finished October at Lighthouse Baptist Church in Mae Sai teaching New Testament Survey. This is a young church with many new believers. The class was mainly young professionals so we lectured in the evenings from October 21 through November 2. This was one of our best classes.



They had an extreme hunger for God's Word and highly thought out questions. We started with 8 for the first week but because of work schedules 3 couldn't finish the class. At the end of our last class they presented me with a "Thank You" card. Inside was a note of appreciation for coming up and teaching the Bible and over \$100.00 cash to help with travel expenses. What a gracious group of people. We returned Sunday November 16 to teach another 3 hour session in the afternoon and then pick up a team from Lubbock Texas that evening at the Chiang Rai airport.

The Lubbock team is a construction company not associated with a church. Almost all are Christians. They were with us November 16-19. They did construction jobs on the church and Pastor Pradoc's house. They left tools for the church and bought a 55" T.V. for the children's ministry. They helped with a two day kids VBS with meals and taught English

Monday (9:00- 12:00) at a school in Chiang Khong. The school put on a 'Thank You' program for the team with traditional dances and sending homemade lanterns into the sky. All together we had three teams come in November. We split them up between the three churches. Two teams stayed with the churches in Bangkok and I took the construction team up north to Chiang Rai.

Best yet, October 19th Na-lae and E-gaew accepted Christ as their Saviour. Pray for our Christmas programs at three Malls in Bangkok. Central Bang Naa (20th). Central World (21st - 17:00 and 19:00). Paradise Mall (25th).
