Update on the Generator Project for the Orphanage

As many of you remember, we shared with you the urgent need for a generator to serve the orphanage school section, where several of our children and many children from the surrounding neighborhood attend classes each day. This project was born out of a desire to provide the children with a safe and reliable learning environment, especially since the city's electrical grid has collapsed. At present, most families and institutions survive only by using solar panels with batteries or generators of all sizes to power their homes, schools, and businesses. We are deeply thankful for the friends and supporters who sent donations toward this effort. Your generosity has touched us. However, after much prayer and reflection, and seeing that only a very small portion of the needed funds came in, we joyfully accept what we believe to be God's verdict for this project: it is time to bring it to a close. We fully trust His wisdom and timing, knowing that He sometimes redirects us toward other pressing needs in the mission field. As good stewards of His resources, we will be refunding the donations already received for this project.

Batteries of Blessing: God at Work Through His People

At the same time, we are overjoyed to lift up a special word of thanks to all the workers at ProVia, a company in Ohio, and especially to our partner, Joe Klink, for their extraordinary generosity. They supplied the total cost of all the batteries, plus the equipment needed, to restore the solar panel system for the children's living quarters. Because of their kindness and dedication, that system is now fully restored and will provide stable energy for the children for many years to come. What a powerful testimony of God's provision through His people!

In my previous newsletter, I promised to dedicate this update to the story of how God is raising a new generation of leaders through our ministry. They have taken their training to a new level and are boldly standing as leaders who live by the Word of God. Despite financial limitations, the church in Tampa is pressing forward with faith. They are currently raising funds for a larger space that will allow them to expand, welcome more families, and engage more effectively in global missions. It is a living testimony of God's power working through a people determined to walk by faith and not by sight. Indeed, what Marie and I began as small seeds of discipleship has now become a flourishing harvest of leaders who will shape the future of God's kingdom both locally and globally.
