

RALPH L. WIMM SR. OBITUARY
February 6, 1937 - November 25, 1992 (Age 55)



Ralph L. Wimm Sr., 55, of Joshua died Nov. 25, 1992, at a local hospital following a lengthy illness.

Mr. Wimm was a missionary with World Baptist Fellowship since 1969. He was a missionary to the Tarahuamara Indians and the Mayo Indians in Mexico. In recent years, his family has lived in Joshua, where his parents lived from 1969 until they died in 1985. He was a member of Hallmark Baptist Church in Fort Worth.

He was born in Cleveland, Ohio, and lived for many years in Dayton, Ohio, before moving to Arlington to attend Bible Baptist Seminary.

He graduated from there in 1969.

He was preceded in death by one grandson, Arron Speer of Arlington.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara Gillespie Wimm of Joshua, one son, Randy Wimm of Arlington; two daughters, Lisa Wimm Harwart and Melinda Wimm of Joshua; and four grandchildren, Dustin and Westley Harwart of Joshua and Veronica and Zane David Wimm of Arlington.
