What is Delight Academy?

Delight Academy is a **virtual Islamic school**. We offer a constructive, educational, and Tazkiya-focused program through an initiative that blends faith-based and general education. Our program provides safe, nurturing environments that support students' faith development, structured learning, emotional well-being, Akhlaq, and social engagement.

Delight Academy's educational program is grounded in Islamic principles and enriched by faith-based instruction. It systematically builds a child's abilities by providing **discernment tools** ("Al-Furqaniyyah") that enable the children to differentiate beneficial sources of knowledge (nourishing sources) from harmful ones. It equips them with the necessary skills and experiences to make the most of beneficial sources of knowledge (productive aspect). Moreover, it safeguards him through faith-based resilience against harmful sources of knowledge (protective aspect).

Our educational program emphasizes a specialized methodology grounded in reviving the prophetic methodology in **character-building, Tazkiya**, and teaching. Thus, our main objective is to achieve spiritual enlightenment and academic growth.

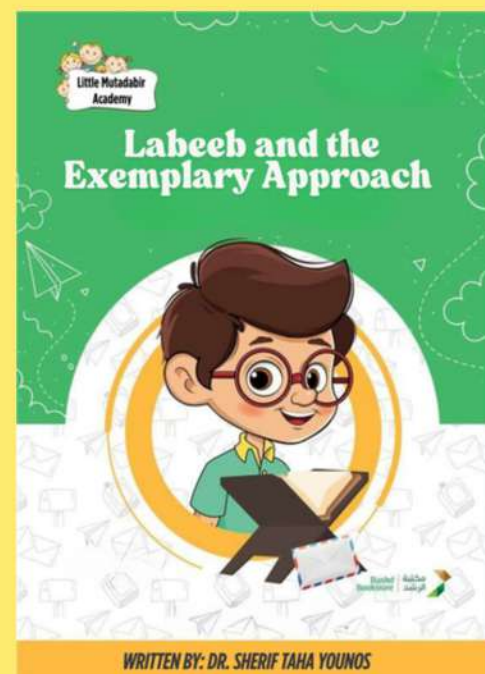
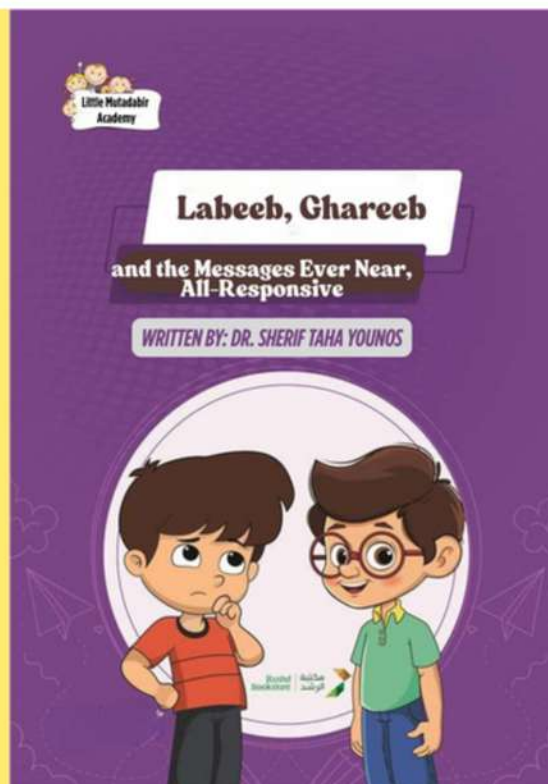
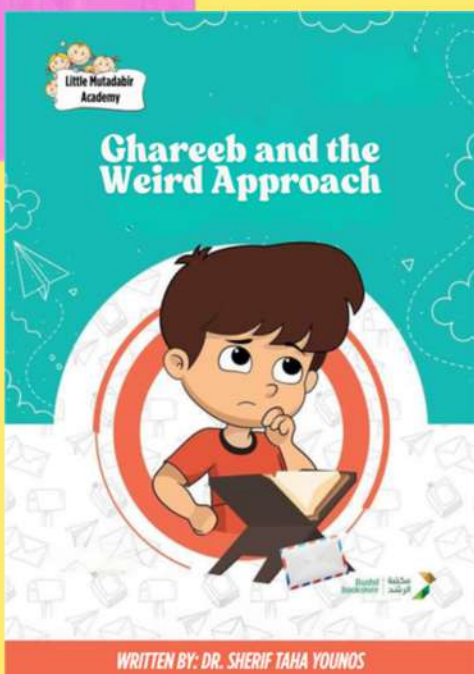
Little Mutadabbir curriculum

It is an **Award-winning curriculum** as the best tadabbur curriculum for children from the Global Committee for Quranic Reflection.

It is a constructive, **Tazkiya**-focused curriculum aimed at teaching children the Qur'an and nurturing them through it, following the same methodology by which the Prophet (ﷺ) taught the children of the Companions: 'faith before the Qur'an.' In other words, in terms of teaching priority and order, understanding, reflection (**tadabbur**), and applying the **Qur'an's meanings** come before learning its **recitation, tajweed, and memorization.**

Little Mutadabbir curriculum

The approach also devotes special attention to a child's methodological development in two main areas—growth and protection—both cognitively and behaviorally. This is achieved by equipping children with **concepts**, **skills**, **experiences**, and **tools** that enable them to deal with the beneficial and harmful sources of knowledge in the best way possible. In turn, this greatly enhances their lives and helps shape their directions and aspirations.



Al-dirāyah and Al-riwāyah of the Qur'an

In this course, we strive to establish and **enhance children's relationship with the Holy Qur'an** by linking them to the method of the Prophet (ﷺ) and his Companions in learning, teaching, and engaging with the Holy Qur'an at the level of Al-dirāyah.

We combine the teaching of:

1- Al-dirāyah of the Qur'an:
This involves five key steps:
learning its **virtues**,
understanding its meanings,
learning its practical
Wasaya, gaining knowledge
about **Allah**, and the
practical **applications** of the
surah.

2-Memorizing Al-riwāyah:
This includes **recitation**,
memorization, and **Tajweed**.

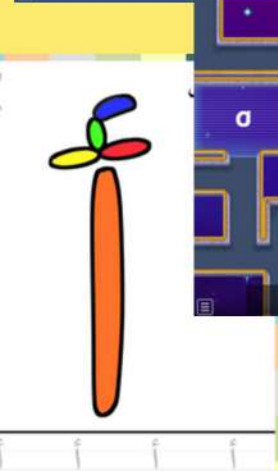

Overarching goals

1 The **methodological development** of the child to become consistently thoughtful, wise, and well-grounded in their engagement with diverse sources of knowledge—both textual and visual—as well as other educational content. We accomplish this by refining their understanding of key concepts and clearly defining the scope of various methodological activities, such as reasoning, tadabbur (deep reflection), i'tibār (drawing lessons), remembrance, insight, and related skills.

2 We strive to **revive the Prophetic** methodological approach to Tazkiya, learning, and engagement with the Qur'an—the same approach through which the Prophet (ﷺ) educated and nurtured his Companions (may Allah be pleased with them).

3 Raising our children to understand the importance and necessity of integrating form with meaning, knowledge with action, and personal righteousness with the reform of others, **prioritizing meaning over form**, knowledge over action, and recognizing reform's significance while emphasizing individual righteousness as the starting point.

4 The program aims to strengthen children's **connection to Allah** and expand their faith through both faith-based and general education content equally.

5 Offering **radical solutions** to a wide range of educational and developmental challenges, particularly those involving educational practices and methodological skills.

6 It provides a spiritually, morally, and psychologically **safe environment** combined with outstanding general education.

7 Providing a **Tazkiya-focused** educational environment that addresses intellectual and behavioral issues and fosters safe, sound thinking and behavior. This is achieved through teaching revelation according to the Prophetic methodology, emphasizing both acquiring and practicing knowledge, with consistent reinforcement and review.

Offering our Iman-based teachers and lead educators distinctive, robust, and **comprehensive faith-based training**. The teachers complete multiple training programs and Tazkiya-focused diplomas over a period exceeding four continuous years. These include the "Learning and Action Diploma" and a preparatory diploma for the "Little Mutadabbir" curriculum, where teachers study specialized programs in Tazkiya and child education and development.

Continuous improvement of the educational process for both the child and the teacher is ensured by daily centralized monitoring, carried out by specialists in educational content. Their role is to improve teacher's performance, confirming adherence to methodological and academic standards, and to provide daily oversight of the educational process, including teaching methods and assessments.

Distinctive teaching methods derived from Prophetic educational skills, relying on **interactive teaching strategies**, brainstorming, and real-life connections. These approaches also focus on developing self-directed learning skills through research-based and exploratory assignments.

Focusing on building **a strong and thoughtful foundation of knowledge for** children, we rely on the Noble Revelation through tadabbur-focused storytelling and other engaging methods. In these stories, the main characters are depicted as children of similar age, encouraging young readers to emulate their wise and thoughtful behaviors.

Focusing on developing the child's ability to **differentiate** between beneficial and harmful sources of knowledge by applying the methodological skills acquired through the Little Mutadabbir curriculum.

Focusing on "**Delightness**" as an indispensable pillar of the educational process, where the institution strives to provide the highest level of delight during class sessions.

Focusing on children's **emotional and psychological well-being** by minimizing stressors and anxiety tied to the educational process or daily interactions. This is achieved by fostering healthy communication between staff and children, and by training the team to maintain these supportive relationships.

Daily **motivation** is provided through incentive coupons, and gentleness with children is observed, following the Prophet's (ﷺ) words as narrated by Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her):

"The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: 'Allah is gentle, likes gentleness, and gives for gentleness what he does not give for harshness.'"

Optimally utilizing and **preserving the child's time** by ensuring every minute of the class session is dedicated to nurturing the child's development and skills. This is achieved through carefully structured lesson plans that maximize engagement, ensuring each class moment contributes meaningfully to their growth. Typically, a session is divided into 40 minutes of interactive instructional time and 20 minutes for supportive activities, including physical movement, and faith-based interactions.
