Notice to dissolve the Saughtonhall Community Association

11th January 2026

At the 2024 AGM of the Saughtonhall Community Association held on 4th February 2025, it was proposed to convert the unincorporated SCA into a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organization which has many benefits over the current unincorporated organization. The members of the SCA who were present at the 2024 AGM voted unanimously to approve the creation of a new SCIO and upon creation of the SCIO, to transfer all assets and liabilities of the SCA (SC012605) to the new SCIO (SC054533).

The current (2012) constitution of the SCA, available on our website and at OSCR states:

Dissolution:-

If the Committee, by a majority, decides at any time that, on the ground of expense or otherwise, it is necessary, or advisable, to dissolve the Association, they shall call a meeting of all members of the Association, of which at least 21 days notice will be given, (stating the terms of the resolution to be proposed thereat) and this notice will be posted in a conspicuous place or places in the neighbourhood. If such a decision is confirmed by a two-thirds majority of those present and entitled to vote at such a meeting, the Committee will have the power to dispose of any assets held by, or in the name of, the Association.

Any assets remaining, after the satisfaction of any proper debts and liabilities, will be applied towards purposes which the law regards as charitable and for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Saughtonhall area and environs, as the members may decide at the meeting called to consider dissolution.

To comply with the requirements of the SCA resolution, notice is given here of the intention vote on the dissolution of the SCA at the 2025 AGM to be held at the SCA recreational Hall, 22A Saughtonhall Avenue, EH12 5RN on 2nd February 2026 at 7:30 PM. Members who are eligible to vote are those who are on record as having paid their subscription for 2025.

Resolution: Following the successful creation of the Saughtonhall Community Association SCIO (SC054533) in September 2025, and pursuant to the unanimous vote of the members at the 2024 AGM held on 4th Feb 2025 to transfer all assets and liabilities of the Saughtonhall Community Association (SC012605) to the new SCIO, the membership of the SCA are requested to approve the dissolution of the SCA at a date during 2026 after which the new SCIO is fully operational and all assets and liabilities of the SCA have been transferred to the SCIO.
