Main Ideas

1. Be Brave and Take Risks

Being a leader means you **are doing** things that feel hard. Sometimes you fail, but that's okay because you **are learning** from your mistakes. Every time you try again, you **are becoming** stronger.

"Courage is not about winning. It's about showing up."

2. Show Your Feelings

Many people think leaders must always be strong, but Brené Brown **is saying** that real leaders **are being** vulnerable. This means **being** honest about feelings like fear or sadness. When we share how we feel, we **are building** trust.

"Vulnerability is not weakness. It is the key to connection."

3. Talk Clearly and Kindly

Good leaders **are speaking** clearly and **are giving** honest feedback, but they **are doing** it with kindness. They **are not hiding** the truth or avoiding problems. "Clear is kind. Unclear is unkind."

4. Build Trust Every Day

Trust **is growing** when we listen, help others, and do what we say. It **is not coming** from big actions, but from small ones. Every day, we **are creating** trust through respect and care.

"Trust is built in small moments, not big ones."

5. Learn, Grow, and Keep Going

Great leaders are never stopping their learning. They are asking questions, are saying "I don't know," and are trying to grow. Even when they make mistakes, they are taking responsibility and are moving forward. "Who we are is how we lead."

Final Message

Dare to Lead is showing that leadership is not being about control—it is being about courage and connection. Real leaders are choosing to be kind, brave, and honest. You don't need to be perfect—you just need to keep learning, keep trying, and keep leading.

"You are enough. You are brave. You are leading with heart."
