Our Values

We take ownership, not shortcuts

At ERG, “not my job” is not part of our vocabulary.

If you touch a claim, a report, a credentialing file, or a client request—you own it end-to-end. Accuracy matters more than speed.

Long-term trust is built by people who take responsibility, even when it’s uncomfortable.

We value clarity over comfort

We are honest, direct, and respectful—with each other and with our clients.

If something is going wrong, we talk about it early. If expectations aren’t clear, we ask questions.

Being clear and professional matters more than being comfortable.

We move fast, but we don’t rush carelessly

Healthcare doesn’t forgive mistakes. Neither do payers.
