

RIDE DESCRIPTION: 33, 66-mile Road Rides follow a mostly flat to rolling course along the very scenic Recreation Road. The 66-mile ride is an out and back from Cascade to Wolf Creek and return. The 33-mile ride is out halfway and then back or self-shuttled Wolf Creek to Cascade. **Gravel Ride:** The 41 mile course loops through wild range lands, laccoliths, and meadows with 1,500 feet total elevation gain.

<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: Both rides start and finish in the Cascade City Park, located 30 miles SW of Great Falls. Rider check in opens at 8:00 am. Rides start at 9:00 am. **Snacks and drinks** are available for riders along the road course. Gravel ride is self-supported. Gravel course directions at Ride with GPS <u>link here</u>.

<u>SAFETY:</u> Riders must **obey all traffic laws** and always wear a helmet when riding or warming up. The courses will be **open to traffic.** Always remember that **you** are responsible for your safety on the highways.
