


The Miss American Teen International Creed:

Venue / Hecommodations



Host Hotel

This year's host hotel will be the Embassy Suites by Hilton Fort Lauderdale 17th Street, located at 1100 SE 17th St, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33316. It is strongly recommended that delegates needing overnight lodging stay at the host hotel. However, delegates are free to stay elsewhere if they have other affiliations, points, or discounts. Delegates under the age of 18 must stay with a parent or quardian over 25 years old.



Arrivals / Departures and Registration

Schedule your arrival and pageant check-in no later than 5:00pm on Friday, August 29th for the full (3-day) event and 6:30am on Sunday, August 31st for the final (1-day) pageant. It is important for delegates to fully understand that pageant fees must be submitted by the published deadline as headcount must be confirmed for meals, travel excursions, swag bags, t-shirts and purchases needed per person. However, you will be able to purchase pageant tickets and any available royalty merchandise on site. In case you are one of the newly crowned titleholders, please do not schedule your departure from the hotel prior to Monday morning.

State / National Queen Appearances

Delegates are required to make at least two (2) appearances each month. At least one appearance should be a community service project or charitable event. Tag @missamericanteeninternational to be featured on our social media.

Mandatory Competitions







INTERVIEW, 40 POINTS

Wear an interview outfit that showcases your personality, style, and makes you feel confident. The interview will be panel style (all judges at once). It will be brief, but will give you the opportunity to introduce yourself and discuss your personal goals and objectives. Questions will be based on your Interview Resume' (mandatory submission).

FUN FITNESS, 30 POINTS

Select a coordinated athletic-wear outfit that is fashionable and represents your Teen Spirit to receive a fun fitness score. Judges will be looking for the individual who is confident, energetic and healthy, with a strong sense of self-esteem. Modeling only, no workout routines allowed onstage.

EVENING GOWN, 30 POINTS

Gives each delegate the opportunity to capture the audience and judges through her natural beauty, personality, poise and grace in a floor length gown. A variety of gown types are permitted. Delegates should ensure their choice is age appropriate and makes them look and feel their best.

ON-STAGE QUESTION, 10 POINTS (TOP 5)

The Top 5 delegates in each division will answer a question for additional points.

Optional Competitions



ACTIVE WEAR

- ☑ One winner per age division; this competition is separate from the Fun Fitness competition
- ☑ Delegates model athletic attire of their choosing
- ☑ Outfit can represent a sport or athletic theme
- ☑ Outfit may be any color, but no swimsuits allowed
- ☑ Delegates are judged on physical fitness, fashion style, confidence and overall presentation



FUN FASHION (RUNWAY)

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Delegate models a red carpet style outfit of her choice to showcase her personality and sense of fashion style on the runway
- ☑ Judges will be looking for modeling ability, personality, overall appearance and stage presence



SPOKESMODEL

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Delegates present a speech on stage based on their platform or chosen community service initiative
- ☑ Presentation must be between 45 and 60 seconds
- ☑ Attire may be your interview outfit or a similar style
- ☑ Delegates are judged on content, personality and overall presentation



Top Scholar Award

- Delegates must submit current school transcript
- ☑ Current Academic Grade Report showing both cumulative and latest grading period must be submitted to qualify

National Community Service/ Missionary Award

- ☑ One overall award will be given regardless of division
- ☑ Delegate must submit a written essay describing their service project experience, the impact made, and what they learned from the experience

Interview Award

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Winners are chosen based on the individual scores on the Interview portion of mandatory competition

Ad Sales Award

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Winners are chosen based on optional commercial and support ads for the program book

Optional Competitions



PHOTOGENIC

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Black and white or color photos are accepted and may be up to size 8.5" X 11"
- ☑ All photos must be submitted at pageant registration. Be sure to include name and age division on the back of all photos
- ☑ Fee \$50 per photo (unlimited entries)



COVER MODEL / PHOTOSHOOT

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Delegate will participate in a photoshoot to capture a magazine editorial cover photo and editorial spread
- ☑ Delegate must coordinate her wardrobe, makeup, hairstyle and accessories to execute her theme for the shoot
- ☑ Delegates are judged on modeling ability, creativity, and professionalism
- ☑ Fee \$100 (includes photos)



PORTFOLIO

- ☑ One winner per age division
- ☑ Delegates submit their modeling portfolio containing a variety of casting, commercial and editorial style photography
- ☑ Photos must be bound, no loose photos
- ☑ Delegates are judged on content, professionalism and overall presentation

Competition Policies



Sponsorship Fees / International Package Fees

Our Sponsorship Fee covers the cost of all mandatory competitions to win a division title. The International Package Fee covers events during Internationals, gifts, group meals and associated incidental costs.

Separate Costs

In addition to their pageant fees, delegates may purchase optional competitions or activities when available. Competition related costs are at the delegate's own expense, such as photography, hair and makeup, competition wardrobe and incidentals. Cost of optional activities and competitions are posted on our website, along with approved vendors for hair and makeup.



Dressing Room Policy

Delegates may have one parent or guest to assist them backstage; however, the helper must purchase a backstage pass in lieu of a ticket. It is strongly suggested that delegates choose outfits and hairstyles that are easy to maneuver quickly without a parent's assistance. Do not leave money or valuables in the dressing rooms as they are unsecured. Miss American Teen will not be responsible for lost items or valuables. *No food is allowed in the dressing rooms or in the theater*. Only Miss American Teen authorized hair and makeup vendors are permitted backstage and in the dressing room.

Important Notice: Absolutely NO CAMERAS or cell phones are allowed in the dressing rooms. Picture taking is not allowed in the dressing rooms — no exceptions. Anyone found in violation of this policy will be disqualified.

International Royalty

What is expected of Titleholders?

The Miss American Teen International Royalty Court will become a part of a small, but growing sisterhood like no other. International queens are typically invited to attend pageants and events across the country and can use their titles to promote their personal platforms on a national level. As our pageant system grows, so will the responsibilities and benefits of our titleholders.

If selected as Miss American Teen International or a member of the International Royalty Court, keep in mind that you are always representing the pageant and, as such, will be held to the highest standards of conduct. Winners are expected to promote their titles during their reign. Bullying, hate speech, violence, unsportsmanlike conduct or any behavior not representative of the morals and ideals of the pageant system will be grounds for contract termination and loss of title and prizes.

International titleholders will receive modeling invitations for fashion shows both domestic and international. However, personal expenses in excess of their travel allowance may be required. Sponsors may be recruited to assist with personal travel costs.

International titleholders must make a minimum of four (4) appearances (once every three months) throughout the year and post at least once monthly on their official social media accounts.




Pageant Hair & Makeup


Hair and makeup Team

Pageant Photography Package


