COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

BOD 110 - Piercing Techniques (2 Weeks) - Students will learn various piercing techniques for different body areas, including ear piercings, facial piercings, body piercings, and surface piercings. This includes proper needle insertion, jewelry placement, and aftercare instructions.

BOD 115 - Practical Application (2 Weeks) - Students will typically practice on artificial skin or models before progressing to supervised piercings on consenting individuals.

BOD 120 - Client Consultation and Aftercare (1 Week) - Learn various shading techniques to add depth and dimension to your tattoos. Explore color theory and practice packing colors effectively for vibrant and lasting results.
