

Recycling and Proper Disposal Handbook Camden County, Georgia

Section A: Introduction

The purpose of this booklet is to help Camden County residents understand how to properly dispose of household waste.

Camden County has four different governing entities: Woodbine, Kingsland, St. Marys, and Camden County. Each government offers different solutions to their citizens for waste collection, recycling, and pickup which are spelled out here

All citizens can use the self-drop facility at the landfill for a small fee, but booklet goal is to reduce what goes to the landfill and to minimize hazardous materials sent to the landfill.

EarthKeepers Alliance Ltd offers semi-annual (April & October) eScrap collection to the public where citizens can drop off electronic and other household items.

In addition to the government and civic organizations, there are many businesses that offer proper disposal for the public. This document includes what some Camden County businesses offer.

How to use this booklet

First, check the information in Section B to determine what is available in your municipality.

If that doesn't answer your question, then proceed to Section C and find the item you wish to dispose of. The code(s) listed will direct you to a specific location(s) in Section D -- the List of Businesses or the landfill -- for proper disposal.

This booklet is designed to help citizens properly recycle and properly dispose of household items.

E. Landfill on Hwy 110

- 1. There are two self-delivery customer service entrances to the landfill.
 - a. C&D which stands for Construction and Demolition waste. Accepts building materials, yard and land clearing waste, and other types of vegetative waste such as mulch. See website for details.
 - b. MSW which stands for Municipal Solid Waste -- meaning household waste -- entrance for self-delivery bulk items, (mattresses, tires, children's toys, metal, etc.)
