



HANUKKAH

Yes, Hanukkah is celebrated in Walt Disney World. This year, Hanukkah is December 14 – December 22, 2025.

Watch for a vivid assortment of blue, white, silver, and gold [merchandise](#) items featuring the Festival of Lights, the celebration of Hanukkah. Hanukkah-inspired housewares, décor, and pins can typically be found on the store shelves throughout Walt Disney World.

A Hanukkah storyteller will share traditions along the World Showcase Promenade as part of the Festival of Holidays. Most recently, the Hanukkah storyteller has been presenting near the L'Chaim Holiday Kitchen. A celebration of eight days in length is commemorated with the lighting of eight candles on the menorah.

KOSHER MEALS

As with any other time of the year, Disney Table Service restaurants will cater to kosher needs with at least 24 hour's notice at most restaurants. (The rule of thumb, however, was previously two days in advance, and we suggest following that guideline, if possible.) Call 407-WDW-DINE or 407-939-3463 for reservations and/or to place an order for a kosher meal.

Restaurants at the WDW Swan and Dolphin resort require four day's notice by calling 407-934-1717.

Select Quick Service restaurants will have a kosher menu. If you do not see a restaurant indicated [on this list](#), it still never hurts to ask if kosher options may be available.
