

MICKEY'S NOT-SO-SCARY HALLOWEEN PARTY

Mickey has bragging rights for the best family-friendly party for all of you Halloween fans!

Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party (MNSSHP) is a seasonal, after-hours event at Magic Kingdom requiring a separate ticket for entry. The fun includes an exclusive parade, a Halloween fireworks show, lots of rare characters, ride overlays, and more.

In 2025, the event takes place on **select nights from August 15th through October 31st.**



Once inside, you can enjoy plenty of ghoulish fun!

For 2025, Disney has even added some more villainous encounters to the party this year, so things are extra spooky.

During the event, you can catch the Hocus Pocus Villain Spelltacular with the Sanderson Sisters, and watch Jack Skellington host the Not-So-Spooky Spectacular fireworks. Select rides get Halloween overlays, you can [meet Mickey & Minnie in costume](#), and MUCH more.

NOT SO SCARY HALLOWEEN PARTY!

HISTORY OF MNSSHP



In 1995, Disney World introduced a one-night Halloween event that was family-friendly (and only \$16.95!). As the years progressed, these parties have expanded dramatically! Here's a look at some of the changes that have been made to this party experience over the years.

- 2005: HalloWISHES fireworks show and Boo-To-You parade debuted.
- 2015: Hocus Pocus Villain Spelltacular debuted!
- 2019: Disney's Not-So-Scary Spectacular was introduced as the new fireworks show, replacing Happy HalloWishes: A Grim Grinning Ghosts' Spooktacular in the Sky.
- 2019: The event was dedicated in memory of Disney Legend Russi Taylor, the long-time voice actress of Minnie Mouse, and two new Tomorrowland-themed floats were added to the nightly parade.
- 2024: Mickey and Minnie appeared in neon spiderweb attire
- 2025: Meet Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse together at Town Square Theater for the first time! Rediscover Storybook Circus – transformed into a happy haunt for families with younger children, and have monstrous fun at a dance party inspired by the film ZOMBIES 4: Dawn of the Vampires.

Each year, we see new elements added to this fan-favorite occasion! Are you ready for the spellbinding surprises for 2025?



MNSSHP TICKETS

To get into this wonderfully themed party, you need a ticket.

In 2025, tickets went on sale for all guests as of May 22nd.

If you're staying at a Disney World Resort hotel, Walt Disney World Swan and Dolphin Hotel, or Shades of Green, Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party tickets were available as of May 15th.

Have you purchased your tickets? If not, you might want to get them soon – they will sell out!

In 2024, the event experienced a *rapid* sell-out. Tickets went on sale on May 15th, and by May 23rd, Halloween night (October 31st) had already sold out. By September 25th, **all** event dates for 2024 were **completely sold out** – even earlier than in 2023, when the final dates weren't booked until September 30th.



This year, 2025, Halloween night was already sold out on May 23rd. Several other dates are also sold out as of the latest updates to this guide.

We've laid out all the dates and prices for the event, along with a lovely color-coded system to let you know how **far in advance party dates sold out.**



What time can I enter Magic Kingdom with my party ticket?

Although Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party officially kicks off at 7 PM, guests with a ticket to the party can enter Magic Kingdom beginning at 4 PM.

Do I need a Park Pass Reservation if I have a Party Ticket?

If you have a ticket to Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party, you do NOT need a Magic Kingdom Park Pass reservation or park ticket to enter **after 4 PM**.

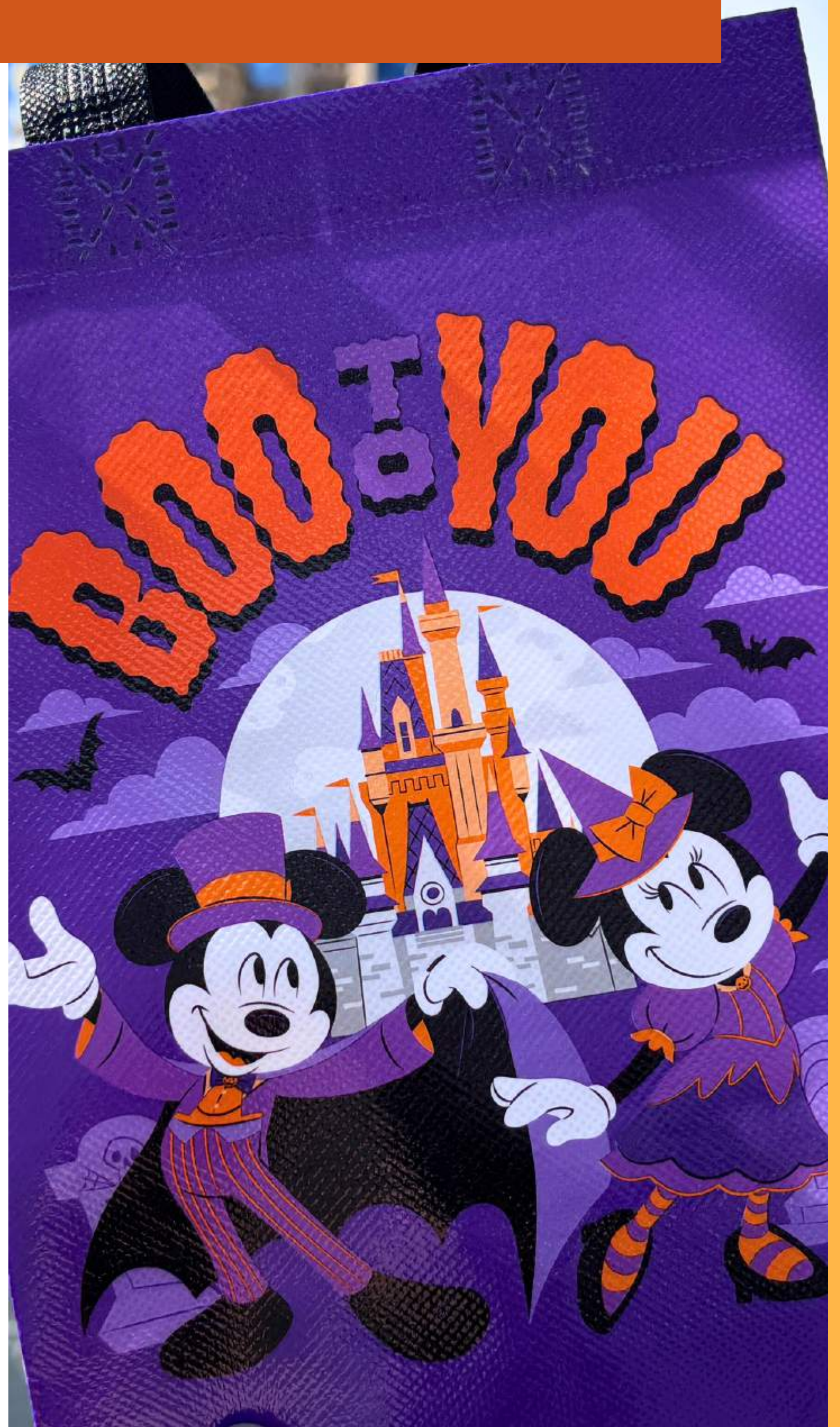
If you want to enter the park EARLIER than 4 PM, you will need a regular park ticket for Magic Kingdom, and, depending on the park ticket you get, you *may* need a Park Pass reservation.

GETTING TO/FROM THE PARTY

Unless you are staying at a nearby resort (Contemporary, Polynesian Village, Grand Floridian, Wilderness Lodge, or Fort Wilderness), **we recommend allowing for at least an hour of travel time.**

DRIVING TO THE PARTY

Whether you're staying off-property or prefer using your own car, you can park in the Magic Kingdom parking lot (Transportation and Ticket Center/TTC) and take the Monorail or Ferry to Magic Kingdom's entrance. In our experience, unless the ferry boat is about to depart, you'll make better time by taking the monorail.

PARKING FEES

Disney Resort Hotel Guests and Annual Passholders receive complimentary standard theme park parking. Standard parking fees are \$30 per day for cars or motorcycles. Oversized Vehicle Parking is \$35 per day.

TRANSPORTATION FROM DISNEY RESORTS

[Free Disney transportation](#) is available from all Disney Resorts to Magic Kingdom and typically runs until 1 AM on party nights.



TRANSPORTATION FROM ANOTHER DISNEY PARK

If you're headed to the Party from another park, you can use Disney's free transportation. From EPCOT, use the Monorail. Disney's Hollywood Studios and Disney's Animal Kingdom offer bus service to Magic Kingdom. Just keep in mind: transportation back to your original park may not be running when the Party ends late at night – so if you parked at another park earlier in the day, you'll likely want to move your car to Magic Kingdom before heading in.

UBER, LYFT, OR MINNIE VAN

During the party, or any time you're headed to Magic Kingdom, non-Disney ride share services will drop you off at the TTC, where you can take the Monorail or Ferry to Magic Kingdom. [Minnie Vans](#), however, which typically cost substantially more, drop guests off at the Magic Kingdom bus loop (just a few steps from the park).

PARTY BASICS

ARRIVE EARLY

Although Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party officially kicks off at 7 PM, **guests with a ticket to the party can enter Magic Kingdom beginning at 4 PM.**

Just look for Event Entrance signs when arriving Magic Kingdom!

One of the MOST people-y times of the party is right at the beginning when everyone is waiting to enter Magic Kingdom for the event. But, if you make it to the Magic Kingdom entrance gate by 3-ish, you will likely beat the worst of the crowds and be able to enter the park close to 4 PM. Check out the themed photo ops. Or head to some rides if wait times are fairly low. Remember that wait times tend to drop once the party starts and the day guests have left, so if a ride has a long line before 7 PM, you may want to wait and see if it drops later on.



EXCEPT IF YOU ARE BRINGING KIDS!

A quick word of warning: we know that a lot of people bring kids to this event, and some parents on our team wanted to mention that it could be a better idea to arrive late to the party if you're traveling with little ones. That way you can save the time that your kids are happy and feeling awake for when the party is really going (from 7 PM to midnight). If you show up around 5 PM or 6 PM instead of before 4 PM, you might avoid the long line to get inside and have happier kids later on when the party is really going. Of course, it's up to you to decide what's best for your group!





WRISTBAND DISTRIBUTION

Once you scan into the park, you will be given a wristband by a Cast Member. The Cast Members have on their special Halloween attire! You need this wristband so Cast Members know you're there for the party and so you can stay in the park once it closes to regular guests.

WRISTBANDS FROM INSIDE MAGIC KINGDOM

Decided to make a day of it and use a ticket for Magic Kingdom on your party day? Awesome! If you're already in Magic Kingdom for the day, you can pick up your wristband at different spots around the park. Just look for the Cast Members in their Halloween attire.

You'll typically get your wristband and a treat bag at these locations!



SPECIAL CANDY TIP

Most trick-or-treat locations hand out fun-size candy (Starburst, M&M's, Snickers, Skittles, and more), but there is one important stop you should make as you enter the party. Over on Main Street, U.S.A., Cast Members typically have a special candy just for the new event attendees that is a **larger, mid-size bag of candy**. Last year, we got a bag of Peanut Butter M&M's, and this year, we got Caramel M&M's. The candy was INSIDE our trick-or-treat bag when we picked it up near the front of the park.



GRAB A MAP!

When you get inside the park for the party, you can find **party maps** with a TON of important info for the night!

This map will show you the park layout along with which attractions are open, entertainment info, treat spots, and more. The other side of the map has useful info as well, like a look at the specialty treats available.

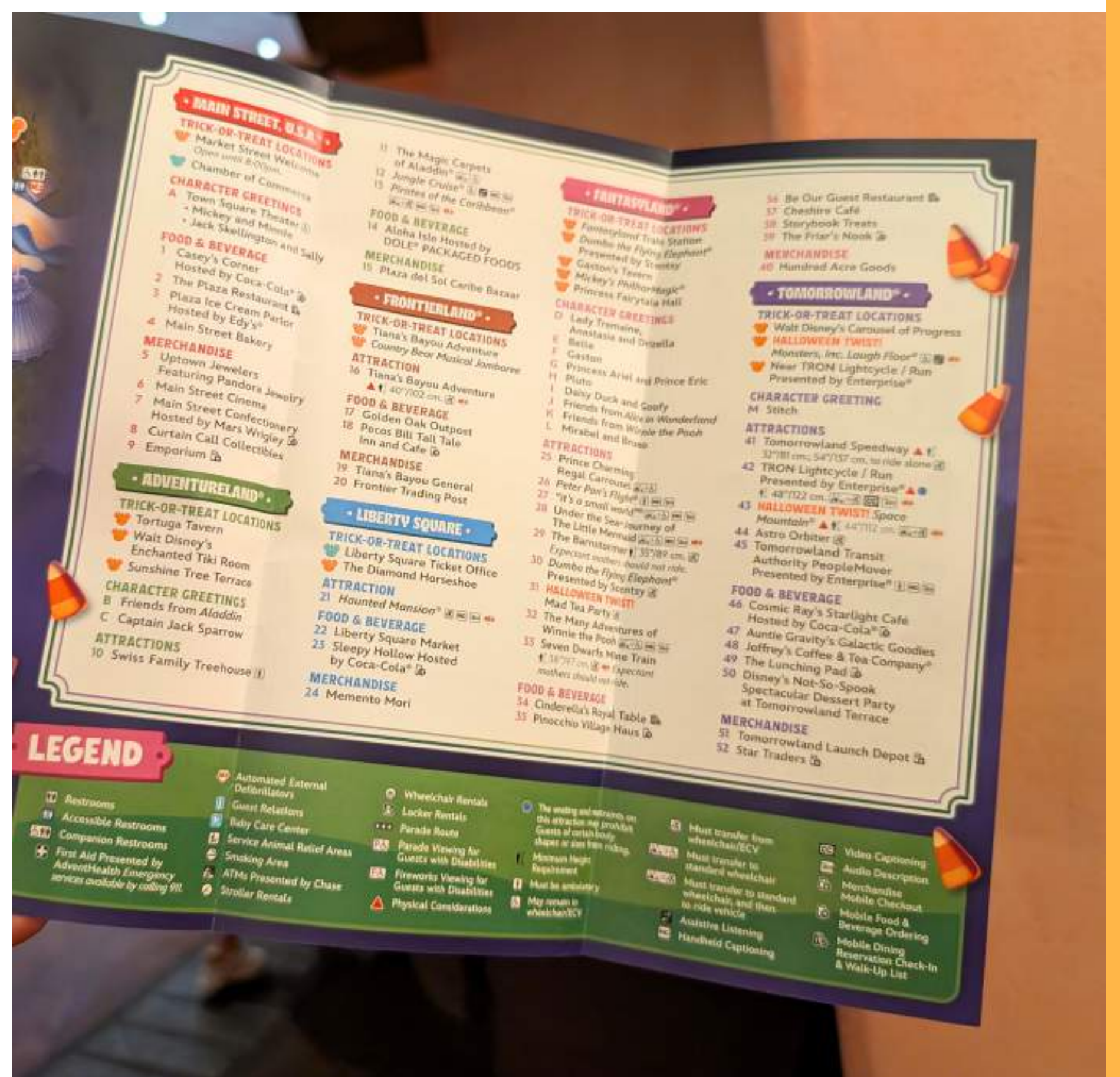
Looking for characters? Mickey's profile icons indicate all the spots with character meet and greets.

Ready for candy? Then follow the orange Mickey pumpkins to the trick-or-treat locations.

Cast Members will typically hand out maps at the park entrance, in Town Square near Market Street, and at wristband distribution locations.

In the past, we've also spotted these handy guides in the "map stands" near the entrance to the park.

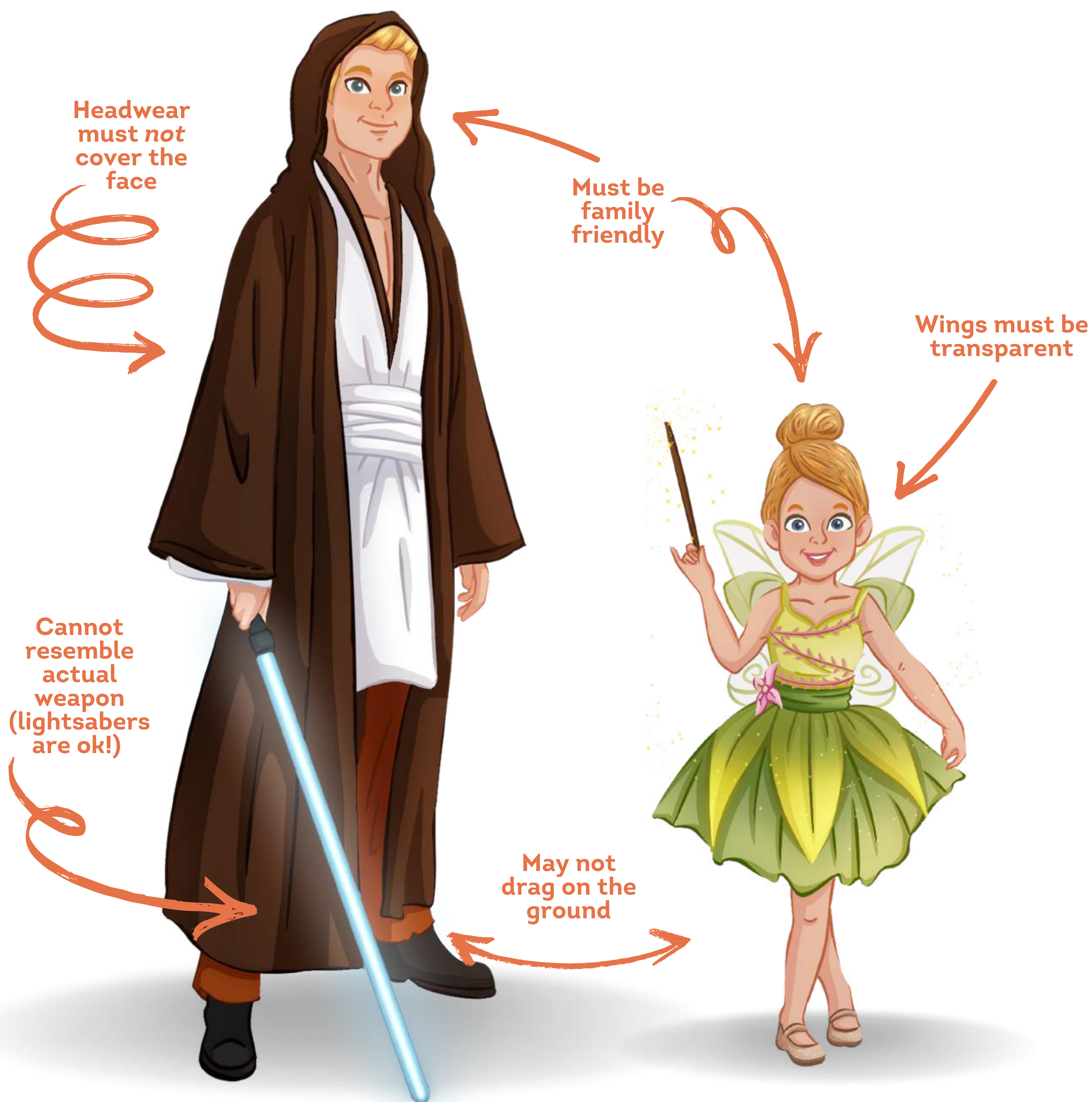
Remember, Main Street, U.S.A. crowds are fairly busy from 4-6 PM. In the past, we've seen crowds that were VERY thick around 5:20 PM.



COSTUMES

This is one of the only times adults are welcome to wear a full costume in Disney World! Disney encourages guests to **dress up** for the party, and we've seen some **awesome costumes** in the past.

However, there are some rules when it comes to dressing up. Here's a look at Disney's guidelines:



FOR KIDS AGES 13 AND UNDER

“Costumes and some costume masks may be worn; masks must provide unobstructed peripheral vision at all times with openings that allow the eyes to be fully seen.”

FOR ADULTS AGES 14 AND OVER

"Costumes may be worn according to these guidelines:

- All Guests may dress as their favorite character, but may not pose for pictures or sign autographs for other Guests.



- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable or violent.
- Costumes may not contain any props or accessories that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects or materials that may accidentally strike another Guest.
- Layered costumes or costume props that surround the entire body are strongly discouraged and may be subject to additional security screening.
- Costumes may not reach or drag on the ground. (for example, full-length Princess dresses)
- Capes may be worn if the length does not go below the waist.



- Themed T-shirts, blouses, sweatshirts and hats are acceptable.
- Acceptable accessories include: transparent wings, plastic light sabers, toy swords and tutus. Costume headwear may be worn as long as it does not cover the face.
- Costume masks of any kind may not be worn.

Guests who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into, and/or removed from Disney parks, unless his or her costume can be modified to meet the above standards.”

There's conflicting info about wearing a Jedi robe. According to one Disney panelist, Cast Members have indicated that a Jedi robe would be acceptable as long as it doesn't touch the ground. But, the panelist noted they might consider wearing Jedi robes if they don't go past the hips (following cape guidelines). Ultimately, if you wear a traditional Jedi cloak, be sure to respect Cast Member instructions if asked to remove it.



COSTUME TIPS

Yes, Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party is one of the only times that kiddos and adults alike can get all dressed up in costumes – and people tend to go all out!

We've seen some pretty epic outfits from folks, but there's one thing you need to seriously think about if you're heading to the party. Disney World is in Central Florida, and **Central Florida is HOT during the summer months.** Even later into October, the heat can still be unrelenting.

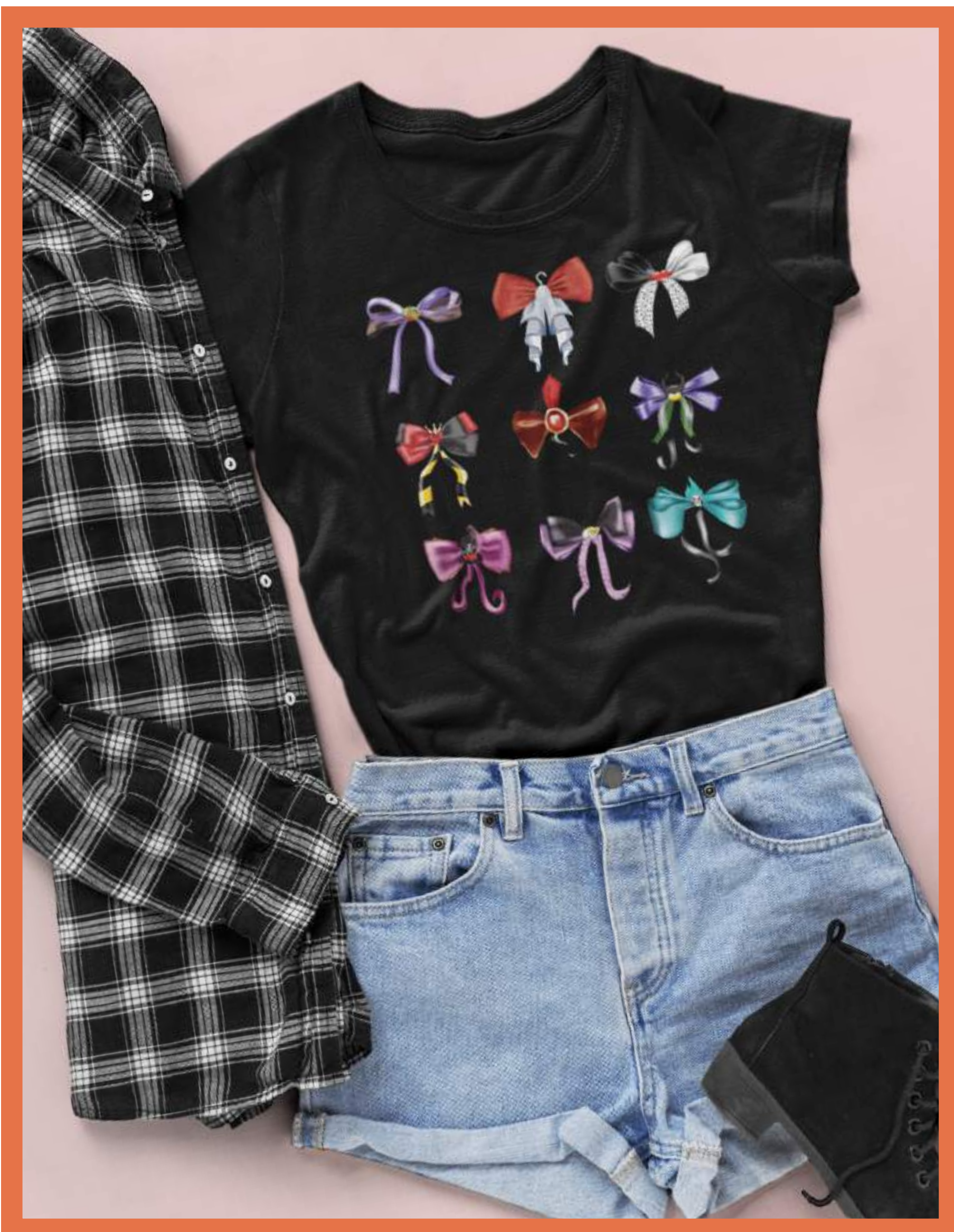
If you have a costume you've been dying to wear, **consider what the temperature will be like on the date of your visit.** Wearing a full princess gown and wig is a fabulous move deserving of respect, but getting heatstroke when you're just trying to have some spooky fun is not the main goal here.

We know, we know...your costume is just *that* incredible, and you need to show it off – at least for a bit.

To make things a little more comfortable, consider bringing your **costume** with you and changing into it a little later in the day, maybe even after the sun goes down. Try to modify your costume if at all possible to keep you a little bit cooler, and remember you can always stash your extra clothes in one of the lockers so you don't have to carry things around with you while you trick or treat!

If you're not feeling too creative, consider wearing a **unique T-shirt!**

IMPORTANT: This book reflects Disney's rules as of our latest book updates. BUT **Disney's costume guidelines are subject to change.** Look at the **Disney rules** ahead of your trip to get the latest updates. And if you ever have any doubt about whether your costume will meet the guidelines, consider erring on the extra safe side and/or being prepared with a backup plan.

DINING DURING THE PARTY



Most sit-down restaurants in Magic Kingdom will not be available during the party, but you can take advantage of loads of exclusive snacks and sips around the park at Quick Service restaurants, snack stands, and more. Keep in mind that snacks, drinks, Quick Service, and Table Service meals are NOT included in the party ticket.

If seeing rare characters and exclusive entertainment is your main focus, we suggest having a meal before you arrive or grabbing Quick Service in Magic Kingdom before the party officially starts at 7 PM.

TABLE SERVICE

[Be Our Guest Restaurant](#) and [Cinderella's Royal Table](#) are open for Table Service dining during the 2025 Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party. Advance Dining Reservations (bookable 60 days from your party date) opened on June 13th, 2025, for event dates starting August 15th, 2025. We recommend booking those meals ASAP. Although with less demand for these reservations during party hours, you could get a better chance to dine at one of these incredibly popular spots.

Before you make a reservation, keep in mind that Table Service meals typically take 60-90 minutes. That's a good chunk of valuable (limited!) party time. But, if this is your only Magic Kingdom day, and you really want to eat at one of these restaurants, by all means, make that magic happen!

QUICK SERVICE

One of our favorite parts of the event is all the exclusive snacks and treats you can find in Magic Kingdom during the party. So, if sampling exclusive food and beverages is important to you, you'll want to make these spots a priority.

If you need more than a snack, some Quick Service restaurants will serve meals so you can get a quick bite before getting back to all of the Party fun. **Want to stay ahead of the crowds? Dine a little early - around 4 PM-5 PM!**

Another great reason to dine early is that **many Quick Service locations close before the end of the Party.**

For an early meal, we recommend Casey's Corner for a hot dog or corn dog nuggets, The Friar's Nook for Creamy Bacon Macaroni and Cheese Tots, or Mexican-inspired food at Pecos Bill Tall Tale Inn & Cafe.

Here's a tip: The Spring Roll Cart near the entrance to Adventureland (from the Castle Hub) is a great kiosk to grab a quick bite without having to wait in *too* long a line.

Luckily, one of the perks of these party events is the typically shorter lines for rides; however, you may see longer lines for exclusive items like the sipper.

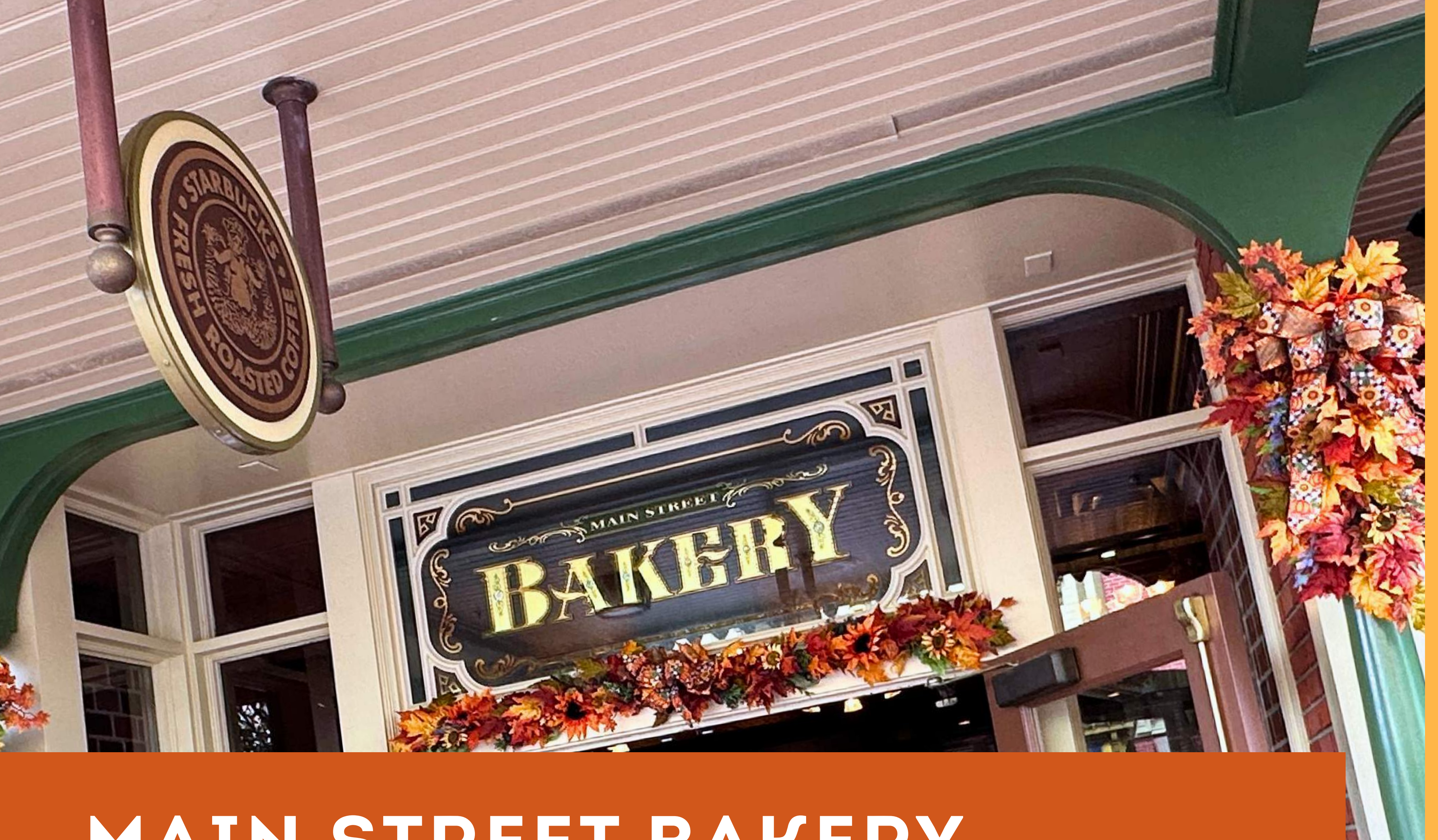

TRICK-OR-TREATING



Trick-or-Treating takes place at designated spots throughout Magic Kingdom (Allergy-Friendly options are also available), and you can go to them as many times as you'd like! You'll pick up a special treat bag from Cast Members at the beginning of the party to hold all your goodies.

Disney has a partnership with Mars Wrigley (the company behind M&M's and many other beloved candies) and they are the "signature sponsor" of the Halloween Party!

TIP: If you're looking for a Treat Location, they're hard to miss – just look for the giant inflatable markers! You can also see them designated in your Party Map.

Should You Bring a Trick-or-Treat Bucket?

Disney will hand out **free reusable treat bags**. So, there's usually no need to bring your own. However, you're welcome to bring one if you'd prefer to do that.





WHAT KIND OF CANDY IS PASSED OUT FOR TRICK-OR-TREATING?

At most trick-or-treat locations, Disney Cast Members pass out “fun-sized” packets of Mars Wrigley candy.

You’ll get treats like M&Ms, Skittles, TWIX bars, etc.

WILL THERE BE A FULL-SIZE CANDY BAG LOCATION?

This year, we received a mid-size bag of M&M's when picking up our treat bag on Main Street, U.S.A.



ARE THERE ALLERGY-FRIENDLY TREATS?

Yes! If you’re trick-or-treating and you have a food allergy, ask a Cast Member for an allergy-friendly bag.

You’ll get a teal-colored bag so that the Cast Members at trick-or-treat locations know to give you a teal token instead of candy.

When you’re ready, simply trade in your tokens for treats at the designated spots hosted by The Safe + Fair Food Company.

Sally & Jack Skellington often have the longest wait, with lines forming before the party starts. How long, you ask? Well, in 2025, at 5:45 PM, the wait was around 90 minutes. At around 10:55 PM, it was 120 minutes.

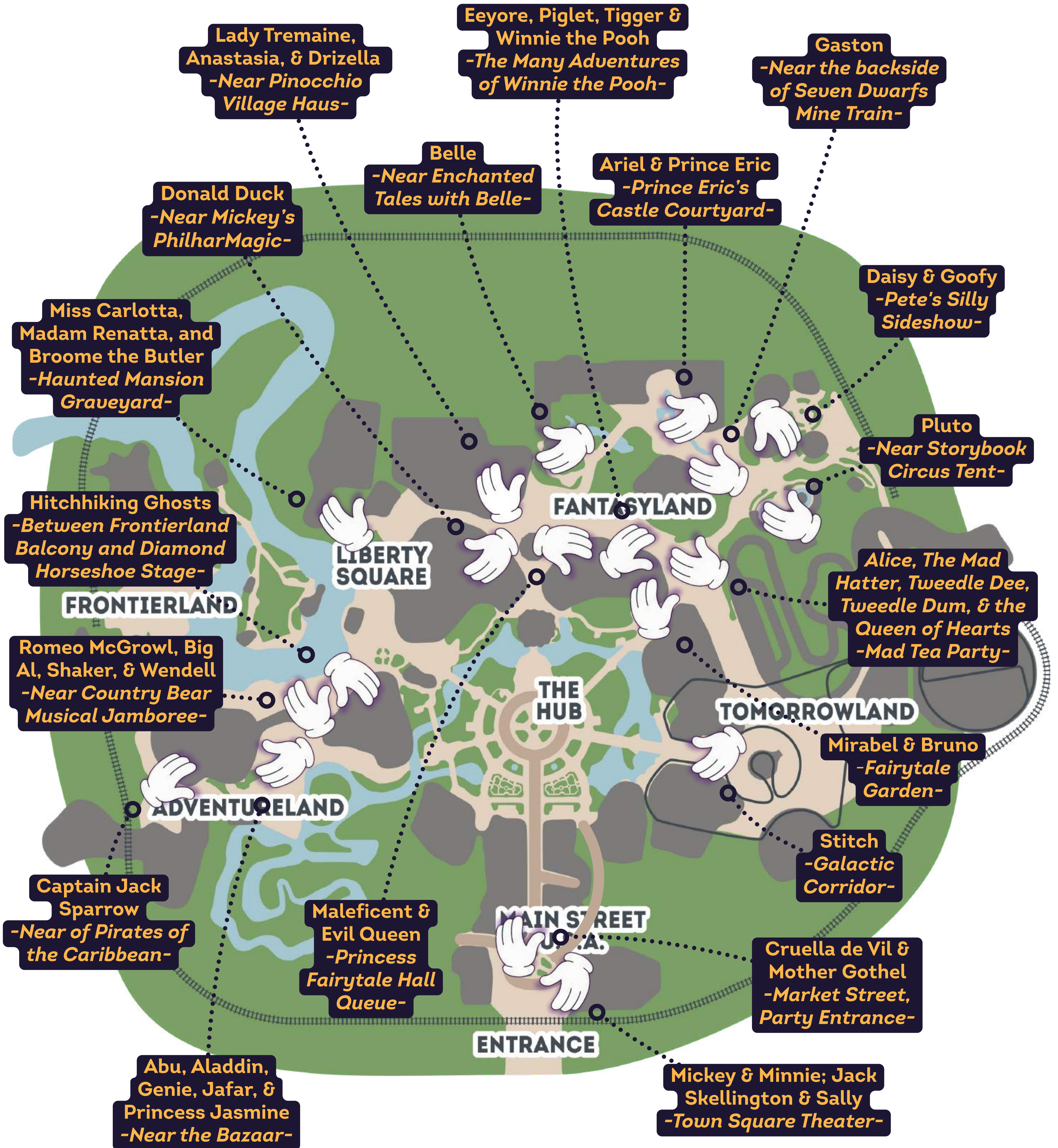

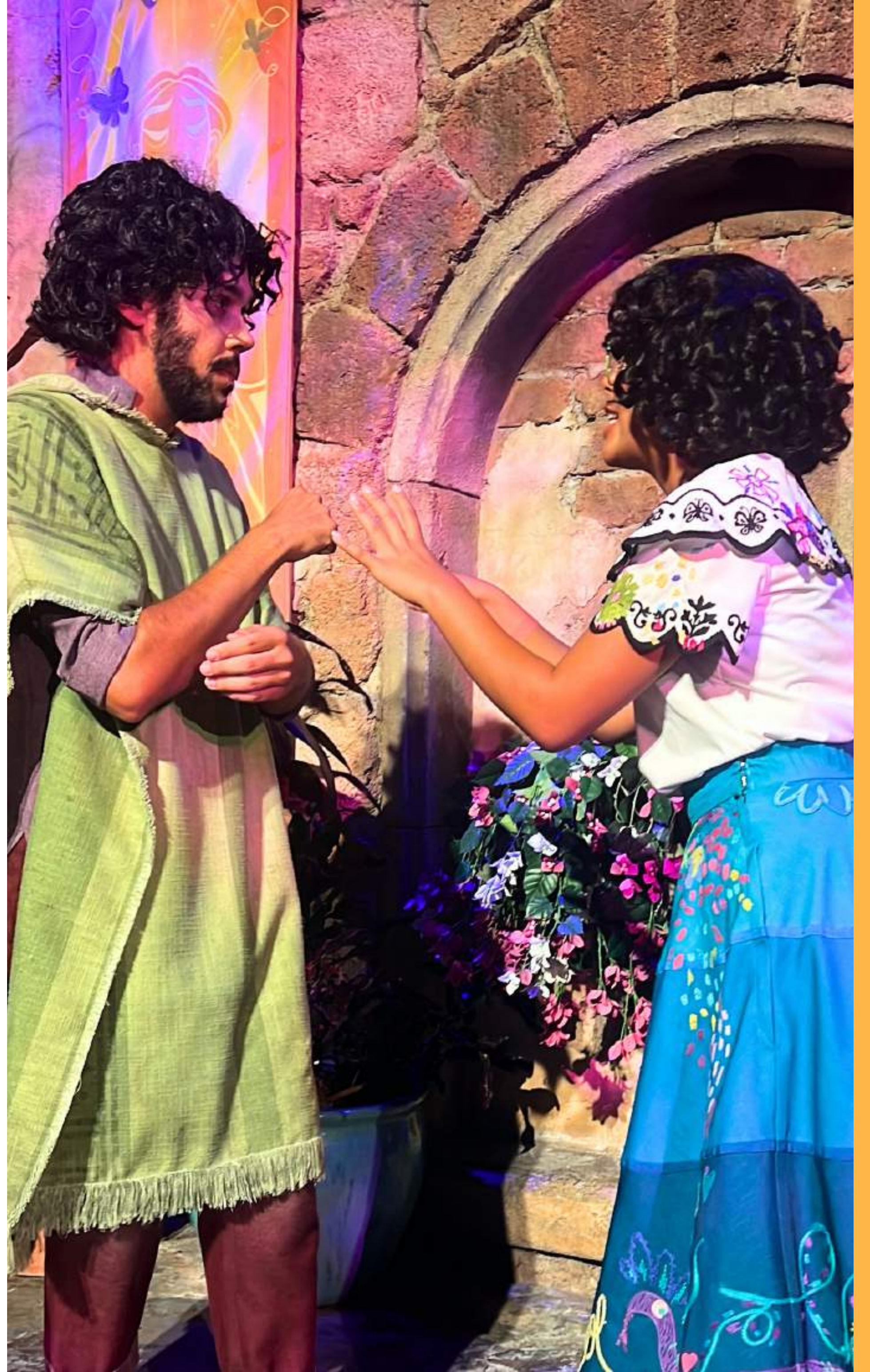

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE MNSSHP CHARACTER APPEARANCES

New in 2025: Guests can **meet Mickey and Minnie TOGETHER in their spooktacular costumes** at Town Square Theater. (In the past you could meet Mickey on his own, and Minnie in a separate area, but now they're together!

Returning in 2025, **Bruno Madrigal and Mirabel from Encanto** host a **special meet and greet** in the Fairytale Garden in Magic Kingdom. Mirabel meets here each day, but Bruno joining her is an exciting option to see during the party.



In 2025, at 5:45 PM, on the first party night, the wait for **Jack Skellington and Sally** was 90 minutes. It was around 120 minutes at 10:55 PM. But in 2024, we saw that wait go down to ten minutes closer to 10 PM, so it can vary. If these characters are a priority, you *may* want to **hop in line as SOON as you can**, or keep an eye on the wait to hop in line when it goes down.



RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS

Some attractions feature a **special overlay** during the party. Space Mountain and Mad Tea Party feature Halloween-themed overlays (special decor and more!) during the event.

On Space Mountain, enjoy the "deep space" version of the ride in pitch-black lighting with spooky music playing.

Over in Fantasyland, the Mad Tea Party has Halloween lighting. The overlay creates a fantastic ambiance as you enjoy one of Magic Kingdom's iconic attractions.

You can stop into Monsters, Inc. Laugh Floor to grab some candy during your trick-or-treating. While you are there, make sure to take a seat to listen to some not-so-scary jokes. Stay for a bit or spend your whole night laughing along. The monsters even take the time to decorate for Halloween!

You can expect some shorter lines than usual for Magic Kingdom attractions during the party as well, which is a huge bonus. For example, at 10:45 PM, Seven Dwarfs Mine Train was a 35-minute wait, and TRON was a 40-minute wait.

WHAT RIDES WILL BE OPEN DURING THE PARTY?

The following attractions will be open for guests at the 2025 Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party. Rides and attractions marked with a 🎃 indicate they typically add special effects, eerie music, or other special effects.

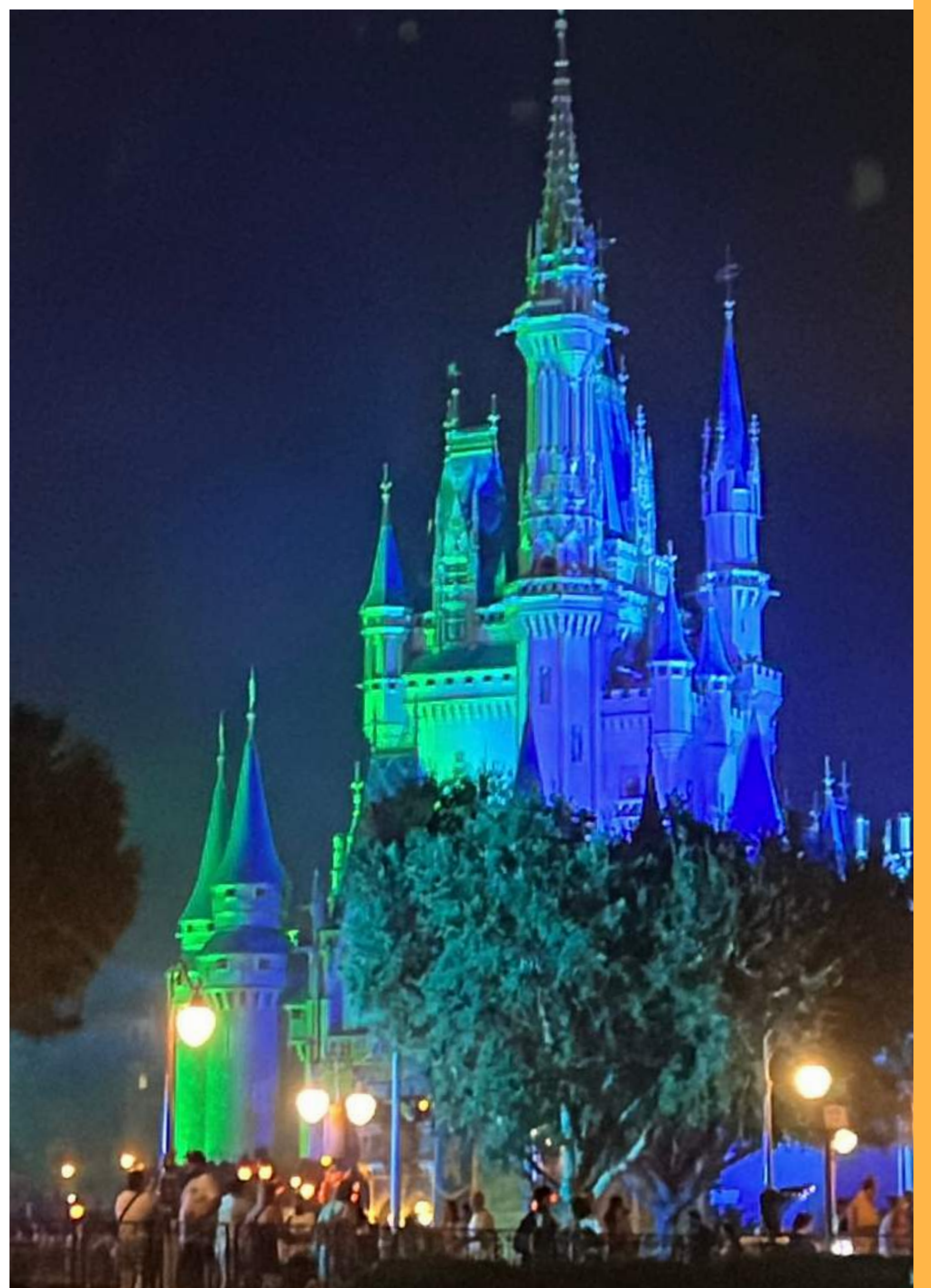
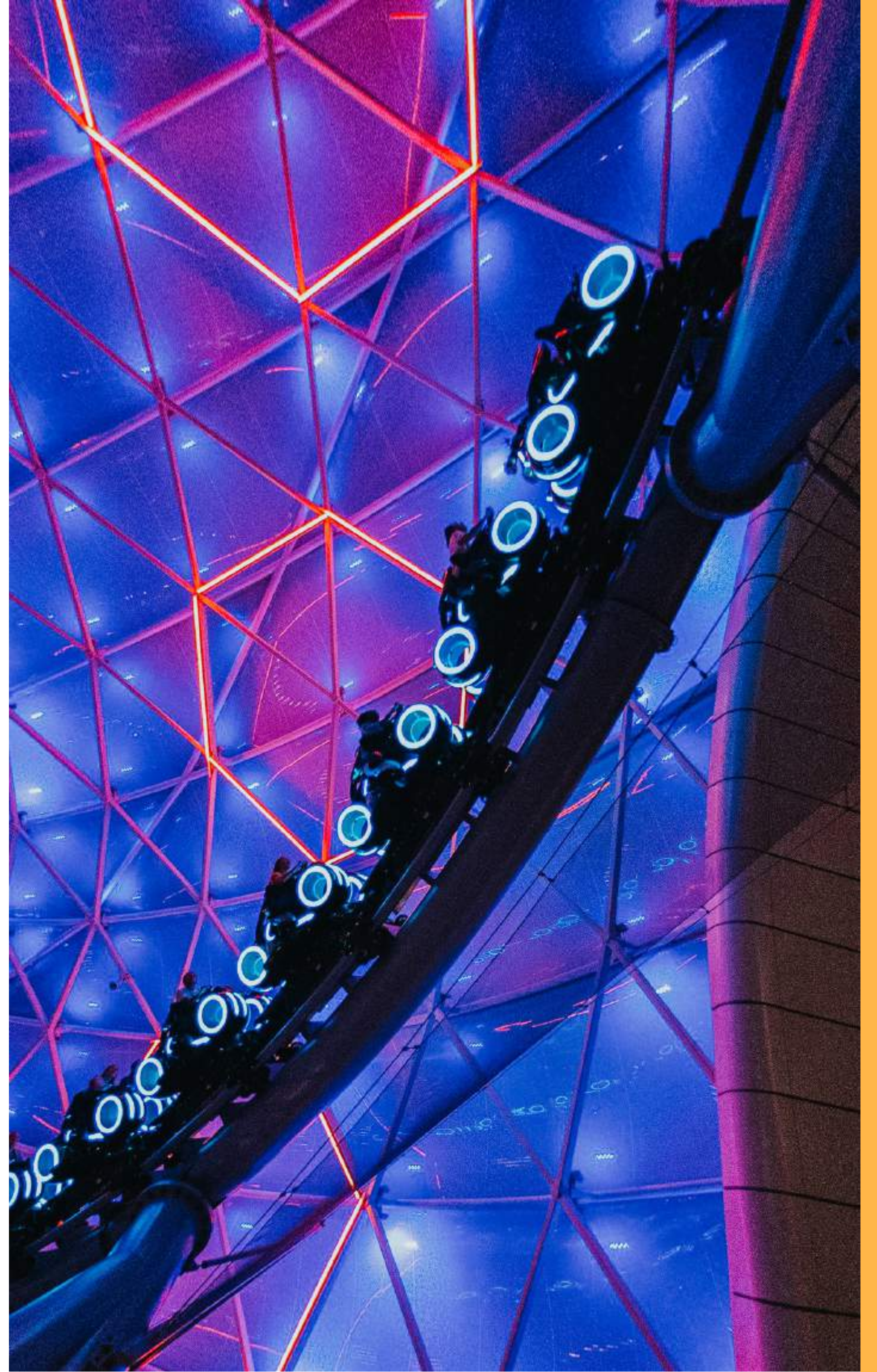

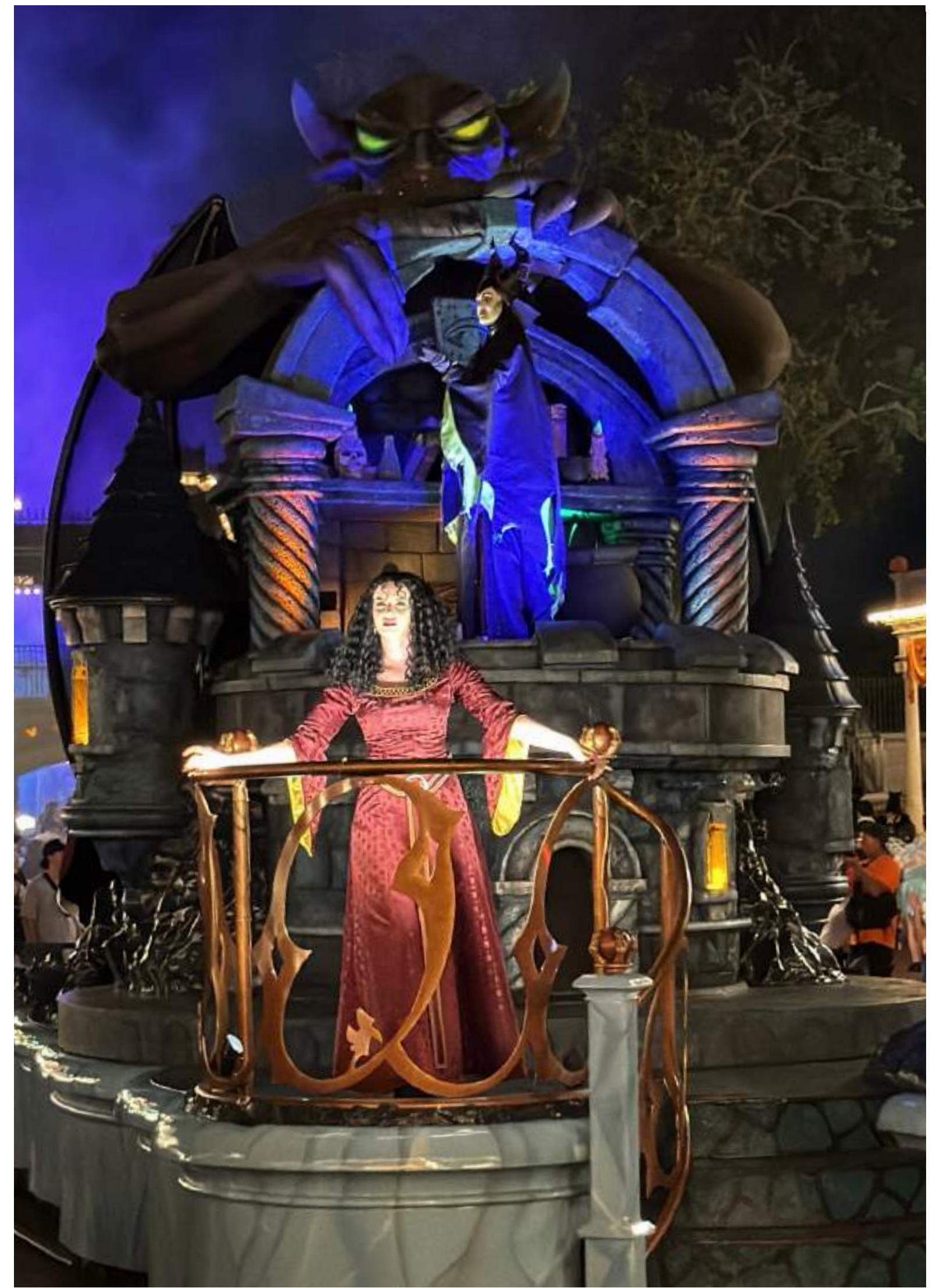

The fireworks display is hosted by Jack Skellington from Tim Burton's *The Nightmare Before Christmas*.

You'll notice different spooky projections on the castle during the show – it's a very impressive display! This year, **showtime is 10:00 PM**.



DANCE PARTIES

There will be dance parties during the party from 7 PM to midnight!

While fun for adults, it's also a great way to help your little ones burn off some energy!

In 2025, a NEW dance party debuted, **ZOM-BEATZ BASH** – a dance party that celebrates the Disney Channel film *ZOMBIES 4: Dawn of the Vampires*.

Popular with the younger set, **Disney Junior Jam** at Cosmic Ray's Starlight Cafe returns this year.

And don't miss the fun over in **Storybook Circus**, where a **DJ Ringmaster** keeps the party going alongside two separate treat trails and some of your favorite Disney pals!





PARADE

Mickey's Boo-To-You Halloween Parade is a returning favorite...and it continues to delight to this day. The parade features characters dressed up in their Halloween costumes, plus some unique characters like the grave-diggers from the Haunted Mansion.

Joining the festivities, Ursula, Cruella de Vil, Tinker Bell, and Minnie, Daisy, and Clarabelle dressed as the Sanderson Sisters are in the Parade!

Don't miss **the Headless Horseman**, who will ride ahead of the Boo-to-You Parade, weather permitting.

The parade is offered twice nightly. **The showtimes are 8:15 PM and 11:15 PM.** If the parade is a priority for your family, get a spot early! If you're staying late, you'll find lower crowds at the second parade.

We love watching these festive frights as they march through Magic Kingdom!

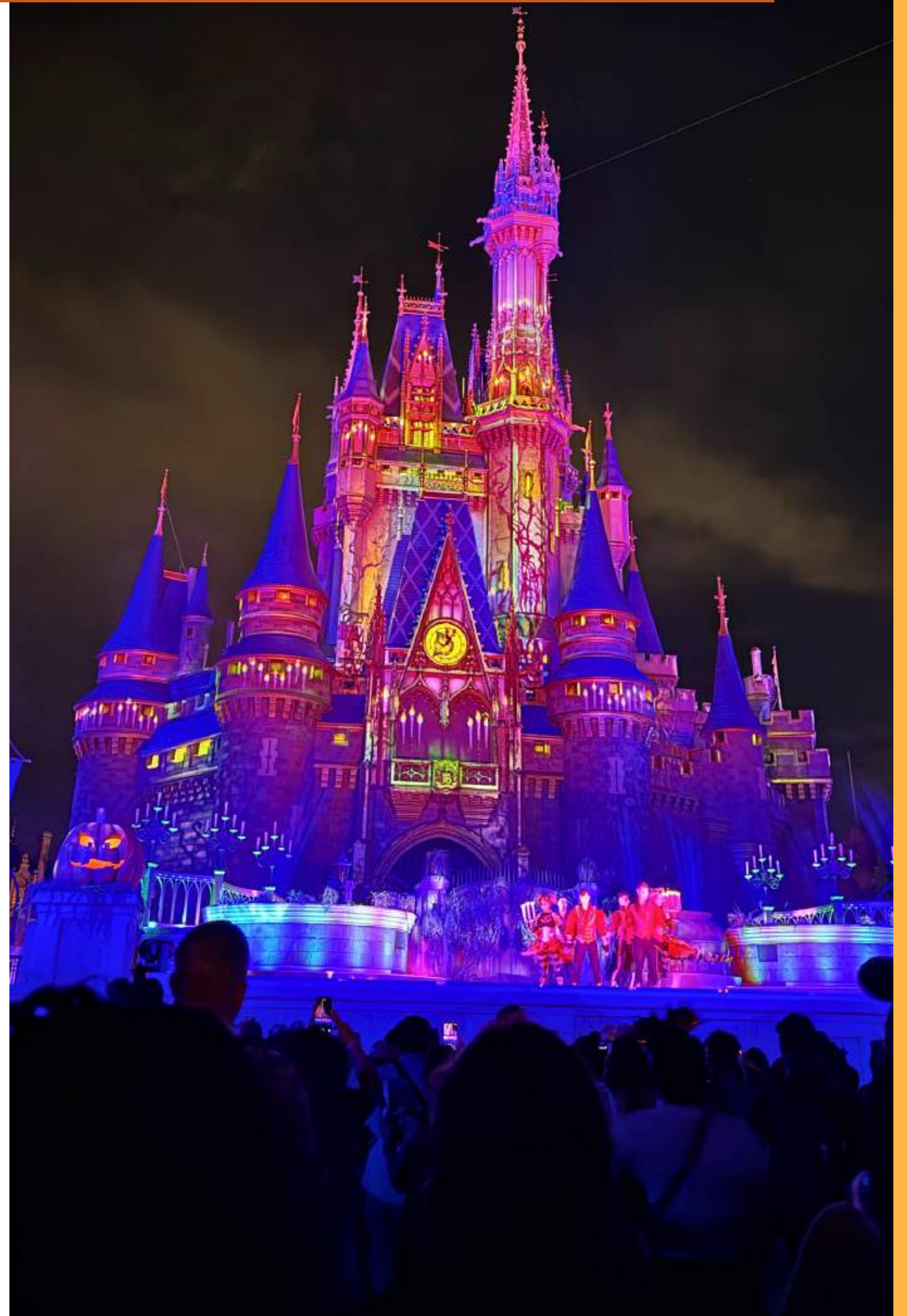

ARE THE FIREWORKS DESSERT PARTIES WORTH THE COST?

If you want to guarantee a good spot to watch the fireworks without spending time reserving your seat, you may want to consider one of the fireworks dessert parties.

Whether or not the dessert party is worth it will depend on your budget and priorities. It can be nice to save time and not worry about reserving your spot for the fireworks! However, even without staking out a spot hours in advance, we have, in the past, been able to find a great viewing position.



Another factor to consider is the treats. If the desserts sound amazing to you, you may want to pay for the party. But remember that there are **a LOT of party-exclusive Halloween treats** that can be found at various Quick Service restaurants around the park. And you can also get candy by trick-or-treating at the various stations around Magic Kingdom! So, if you're going to fill up on those treats, you may want to skip the dessert parties.

PLAZA GARDEN DESSERT PARTY

- \$99 for adults, \$59 for kids (ages 3 to 9)
- Includes the same buffet of treats and drinks at Tomorrowland Terrace Restaurant as mentioned to the left
- Reserved **standing space** in the Plaza Garden, located in front of Cinderella Castle, to watch the fireworks
- Check-in begins 1.5 hours before fireworks begin. Guests can check in at the entrance to Tomorrowland Terrace Restaurant.



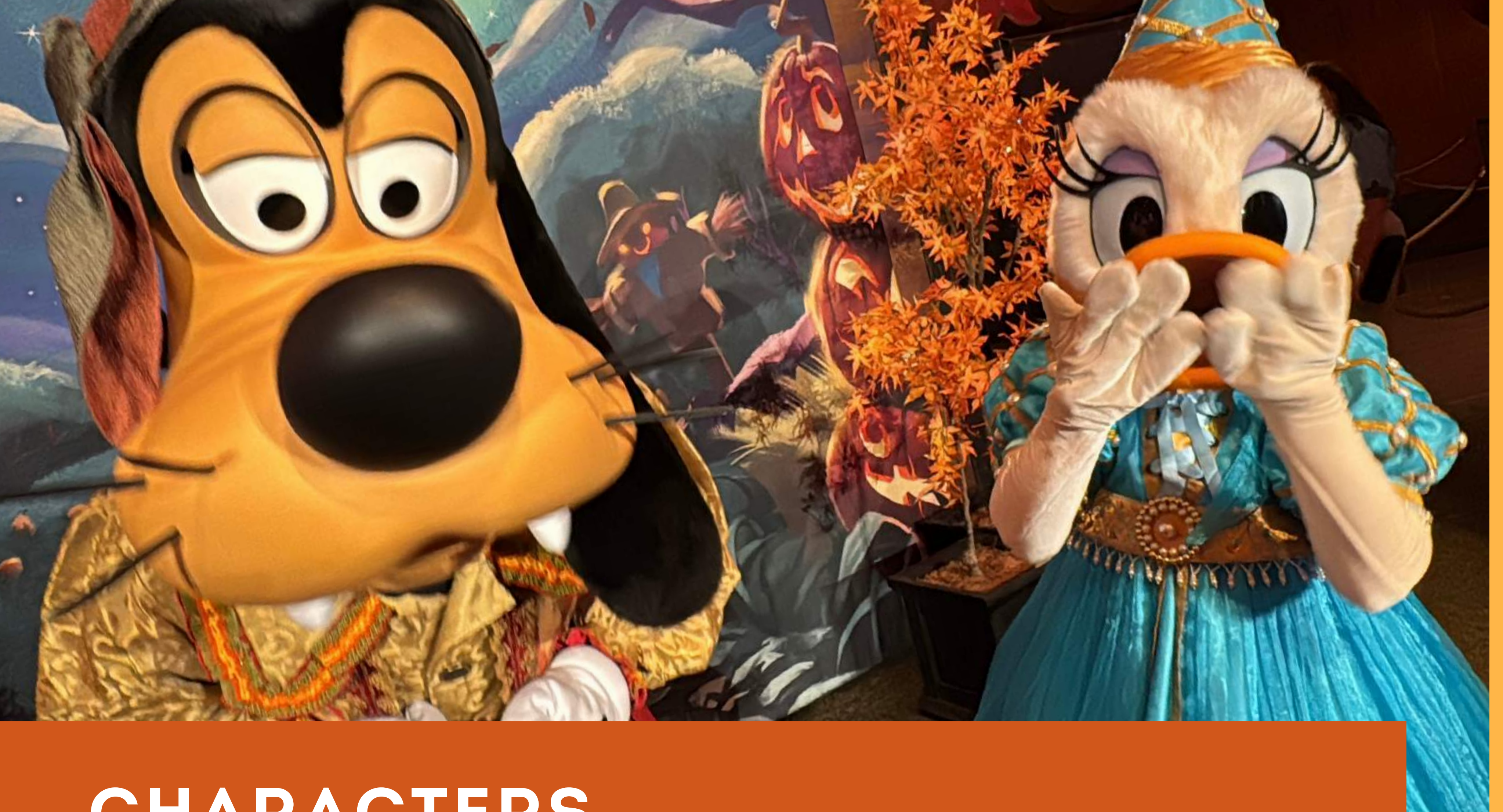
MNSSHP ITINERARIES

MNSSHP FAQs

Whether it's your first time at Mickey's Not-So-Scary or your 30th, you probably have questions about how the party works, what's different or new this year, what things you should definitely not miss, what crowds are like at the party, and so on. We've gathered up a list of your questions, and we have all the answers!

IS THE PARTY WORTH THE COST?

Note that you do NOT need separate Magic Kingdom tickets or a Park Pass for this event. As an extra reminder, your ticket to the party will give you access to the park starting at 4 PM, and then the party at 7 PM. So it could take the place of a "regular" park ticket if you want to justify the cost that way.



You will not have as many hours in the park as a regular park ticket would give you. However, you may get on more rides than during a normal day since crowds will likely be lower during the party.

Is the party **worth the cost**? That's a decision that ultimately will depend on what you want and what's important to you. If trick-or-treating in Disney World (costumes allowed, with some restrictions), seeing unique characters, and watching a party-exclusive parade sounds like a dream to you, then it might be worth the purchase.



WHAT ABOUT INCLEMENT WEATHER?

You can [read about what we learned about when inclement weather affects Party evenings here](#).

If you're at Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party and some of the entertainment is canceled due to weather, Disney *might* offer you a "rain check." Head to a Guest Relations desk and ask about this possibility – they may be able to give you a new party ticket for another night as compensation. Often, these compensations are offered on a case-by-case basis, and they will not always be offered at all. But it never hurts to (politely) ask!

IS LIGHTNING LANE MULTI PASS AVAILABLE DURING THE PARTY?

No, [Lightning Lane Multi Pass](#) (formerly Genie+) is not available during parties.

However, from our experience, ride wait times are *usually* pretty low. Many rides may not have wait times over about 25 minutes, and many popular rides may be walk-ons.

HOW CROWDED WILL THE PARTY BE?

From our experience at different Not-So-Scary parties, Magic Kingdom feels much less crowded during most of the party. There are pretty big **crowds** at the entrance to get inside around 4 PM, and you'll be surrounded by a lot of people during the fireworks show and parade as well.

But many of the rides may have wait times of 20 minutes or less, and you typically won't have to wait in any long lines to trick-or-treat.

However, in our experience, the first night feels extra crowded. If you're thinking of the crowds for rope-drop but for the entire party, you've got the right idea!





WHAT TIME DOES MAGIC KINGDOM CLOSE FOR DAY GUESTS ON PARTY DAYS?

Magic Kingdom closes for day guests at 6 PM on days when there's a Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party.

If you have a park ticket for Magic Kingdom but do NOT have a Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party ticket, you will have to exit the park by 6 PM. Disney hands out wristbands to party-goers so that Cast Members know who is staying for the party.

DO I HAVE TO LEAVE AND RE-ENTER MAGIC KINGDOM IF I'M ALREADY SPENDING THE DAY IN THE PARK?

If you choose to buy a park ticket for Magic Kingdom on the day you're going to Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party, you will not have to leave Magic Kingdom and re-enter once the party begins. You can stay inside the park and hop right into the celebrations once they begin!

Remember to [get your wristband from one of the designated wristband stations](#) so that Cast Members know you're staying for the party. There are a few different stations throughout the park.
