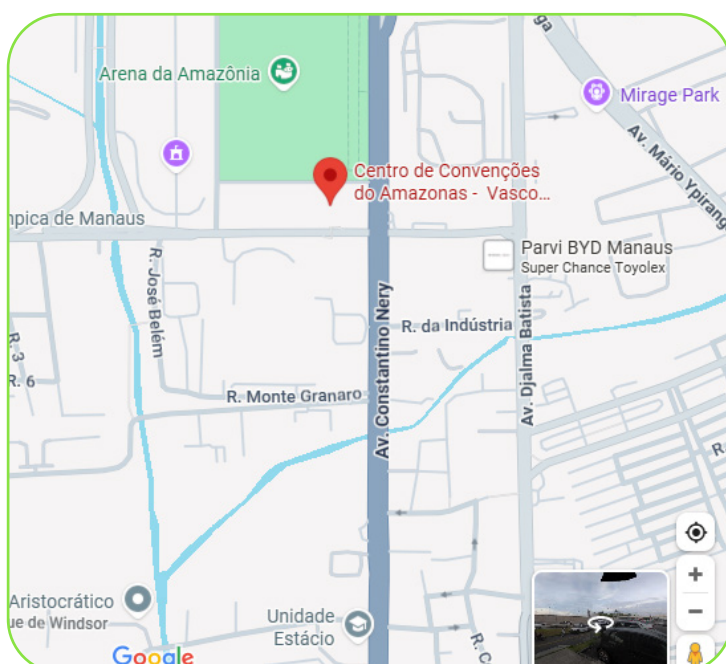

Manauara Shopping Mall



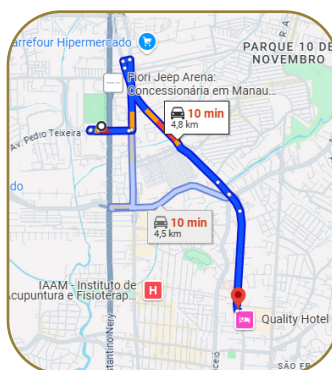

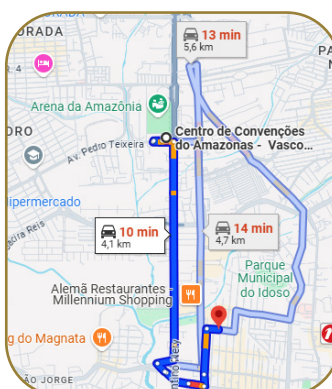

Located in the heart of the Amazon Rainforest, Manaus is the capital of the state of Amazonas and the main gateway for adventurers eager to explore the world's largest tropical forest. The city offers a unique and flavorful culinary experience, as well as a rich biodiversity with rare species of flora and fauna. Reminiscent of the golden age of rubber's production, Manaus is home to remarkable architectural landmarks, such as the majestic Amazon Theatre and the iconic Mercado Municipal Adolpho Lisboa (Adolpho Lisboa Municipal Market).

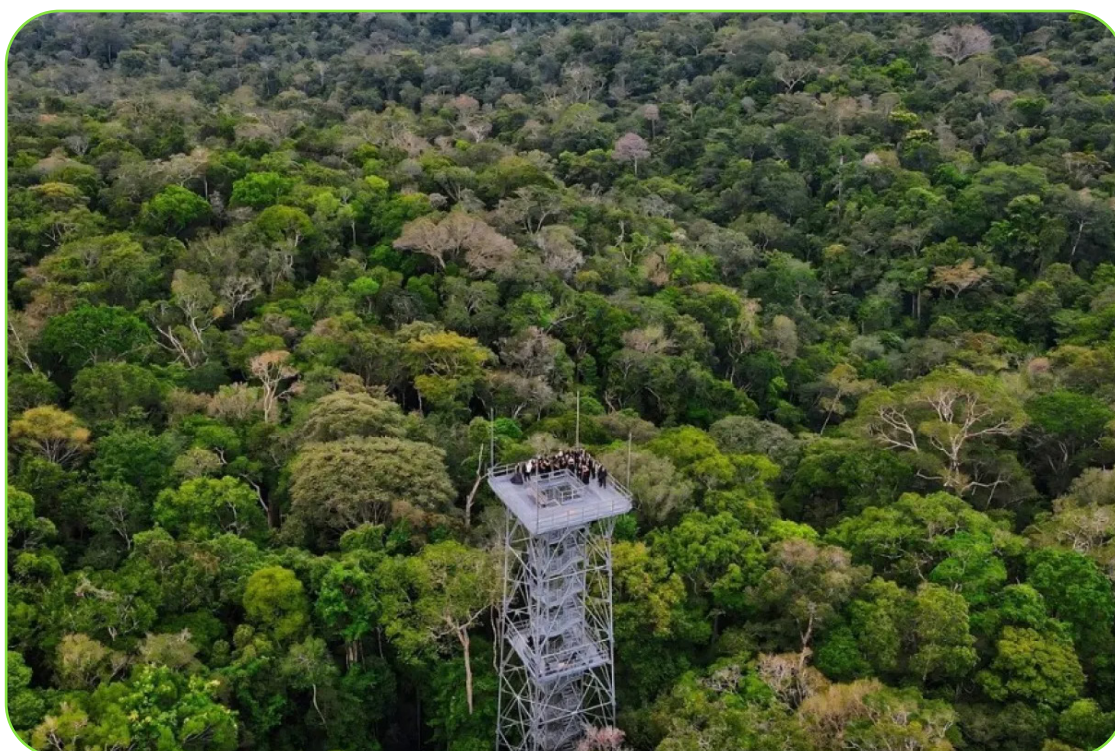
Discover the main attractions of this fascinating city:



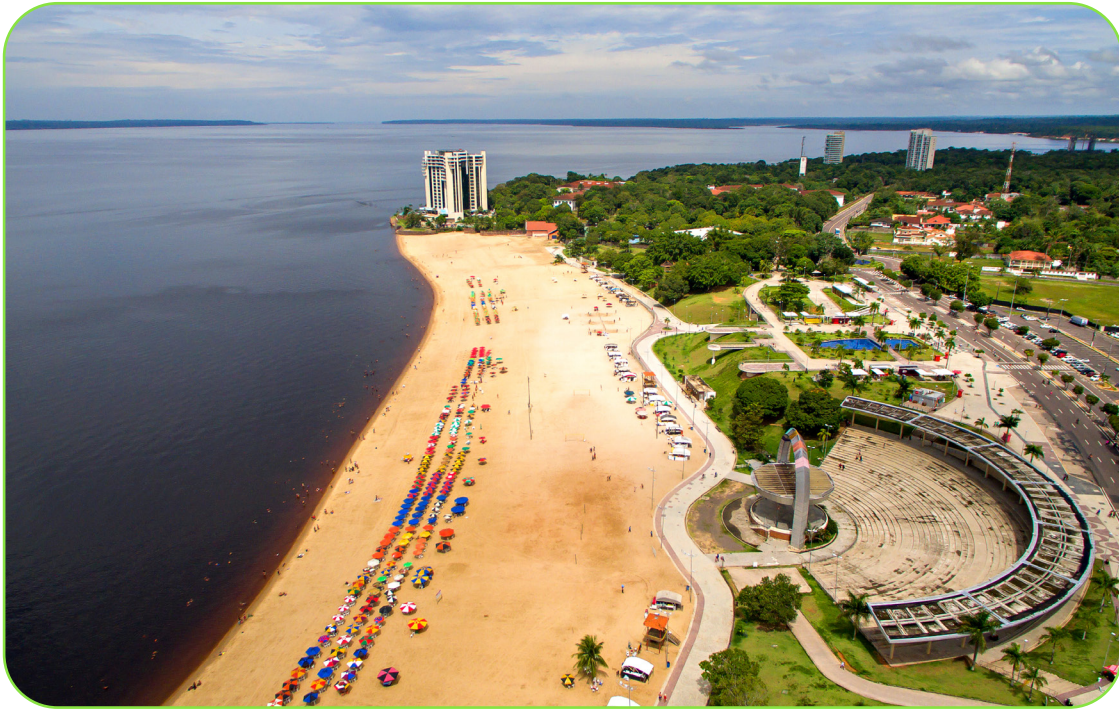
Amazon Theatre: One of the most iconic theaters in Brazil and the main landmark of Manaus.



Encontro das Águas (Meeting of the Waters): This natural phenomenon occurs at the confluence of the Negro and Solimões Rivers, where their waters—distinct in color and composition—flow side by side without mixing for several kilometers. It is one of the region's most impressive and popular attractions.



Museum of the Amazon (MUSA): Featuring a 42-meter-tall steel observation tower with 242 steps and an 81m² base, MUSA offers breathtaking panoramic views of the forest canopy. It has become one of Manaus' top tourist destinations.



Ponta Negra Beach: The most famous beach in Manaus, located in the district of the same name, Ponta Negra lies on the banks of the Rio Negro and offers a broad stretch of sand, a scenic boardwalk, sports courts, and an amphitheater that hosts concerts and events.



Museu do Seringal Vila Paraíso (Rubber Museum Vila Paraíso): It is a cultural space full of themed spaces from the rubber cycle era and is in the rural Igarapé São João area, this cultural site recreates the atmosphere of the rubber boom era. With themed spaces and historical exhibits, it is a great weekend trip for anyone looking to learn more about the Amazon's History.



CIGS Zoo: Located in the São Jorge neighborhood, in the West Zone of Manaus, the zoo brings together specimens of the jaguar, blue macaw, royal hawk, capuchin monkey and black panther, among others.



Espaço Cultural Largo de São Sebastião (Largo de São Sebastião Cultural Space): It is an important cultural and historical center. Here you can visit the Teatro Amazonas, the São Sebastião Church, the Monument to the Opening of the Ports, the Largo Gallery, the Casa das Artes, and enjoy the bars and restaurants in the surrounding area.
