# How Saved Are You?

---

## **Are you ready for:**

- The kind of fun you don't have to repent for?
- Deep conversations that challenge your thinking and old beliefs?
- Your soul to be stirred as you get vulnerable and seek discomfort?
- Creative challenges that stretch your abilities and showcase raw talent?

Then you're ready to play ***How Saved Are You?***

This game was created so that 1 John 5:13 can be a reality in your life: "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life."

Whether you just got saved, you're curious about Jesus, you've been walking with the Lord for years, or you're thinking about giving up your faith, this game is for you.

## **What's in the Box?**

- Deck 1 – 45 Icebreaker Questions
- Deck 2 – 45 Deeper Questions
- Deck 3 – 45 Soul-Stirring Questions
- Deck 4 – 45 Challenges
- Assurance of Salvation Card
- 7 Steps to Salvation Card

## **Game Setup:**

1. Remove each deck from the box and place them face down.
  2. Shuffle the challenge cards. Optional to shuffle the other cards.

## **How to Play**

The game is easy, all you have to do is:

Step 1: Draw and everyone answer a card from Deck 1 → 2 → 3

Step 2: Draw and everyone complete 1 challenge card.

Step 3: Repeat the cycle.

Anyone can go first, and all used cards return to the bottom of their decks.

You can repeat this process for as long as you like or until Jesus comes back!

## **At the end of each game:**

- Read and answer the Assurance of Salvation Card and pray together.
- If anyone decides to accept Jesus, walk them through the 7 Steps to Salvation Card.

## **Deck Themes**

In each deck you will find the same 3 themes based off one of the 3 sacred objects in the Holy Place of the Old Testament Sanctuary:

### **The Altar of Incense – “Know God”**

- This is where the priests would daily burn incense, morning and evening, symbolizing the prayers and intercessions of the worshippers.
- The questions and challenges on these cards are meant to help you get to know God better as you grow through the ups and downs of life in a sinful world (John 17:3).

### **The Table of Showbread – “Know God’s Word”**

- The bread on this table was replaced weekly and consumed by the priests. This fitting symbol represents our total dependence on the word of God.
- The questions and challenges on these cards are meant to help you get to know God’s word better and to hear Him clearly amid all the noise of the world (Matt 4:4).

### **The Golden Candlestick – “Know God’s People”**

- This special piece of furniture provided continual light in the Holy Place. The priests would daily supply oil to keep the fire burning, symbolizing the continual work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers.
- The questions and challenges on these cards are meant to help you get to know God’s people better, strengthening the bonds of love that hold us together (John 13:35).

## **What Are Challenge Cards?**

Talking is good, but faith without works is dead! Challenge Cards interrupt the flow of conversation with creative actions like:

- Drawing
- Writing
- Reading Scripture
- Creating content
- And so much more!

Each challenge activates different parts of your brain and encourages everyone to do more than just talking.

\*For the full experience, have paper and pencils/pens handy\*

## **Would You Rather Examples:**

- Spend one day as Moses parting the Red Sea or one hour at the Last Supper?
- Hear God's voice audibly for one minute or have one dream where He reveals your future?
- Walk around Jericho and see it fall or walk out of Egypt with the Israelites?

## **Never Have I Ever Examples:**

- Fallen asleep in church
- Sang in front of the whole church
- Preached a sermon
- Visited a nursing home to minister
- Done door-to-door evangelism

## **Game Modes**

### **1. Spiritual Warfare** – 1 Peter 5:8

Very deep and intentional, meant to grow spiritual stamina and be ready for conflict with the enemy. Follow the instructions exactly as they are laid out in this booklet and encourage each player to lock in!

### **2. Praise Break** – 2 Samuel 6:14–15

No order, do your thing, just pick and play cards as you please, free style. You can do all questions and no challenges, or all challenges and no questions. You can divide up the group in teams and compete for some of the challenges, or just have fun, do you!

### **3. Iron Sharpens Iron** – Proverbs 27:17

Split up into small groups of 3-4. Be prepared to open your soul, be transparent, and let God mold you and prepare you for greatness.

### **4. The Secret Place** – Psalm 91:1–2

1 on 1 session with your bestie (or bro for the guys lol), spouse, fiancé, mentor, roommate, pastor, family member, new friend, boyfriend/girlfriend, or just anybody. Take your time, no rush to finish, sit in the presence of God and let Him lead, comfort, heal, and restore.

## **Assurance of Salvation Card**

- This card is meant to be read at the end of each game, no matter how long or short you play.
- The goal is that everyone who plays will continually be assured of their salvation in Jesus or invited to accept Him as their Lord and Savior.
- Sadly, there are many who struggle with the assurance of their salvation, and many more who have never truly surrendered their all to Him. Being born into a Christian home is no guarantee of salvation. God has no grandchildren, only children. (Matt 7:21-23; Rom. 9:6-8)

## **7 Steps to Salvation Card**

- This card provides a simple, biblical, step by step guide to Jesus for those who have been touched by the Holy Spirit.
- Salvation is found **ONLY** in a personal relationship with God. No denomination, ministry, or any religious organization can save anyone, only Jesus saves.
