

DAY 37 – Sing a New Song

Psalm 96

96 *O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.*

² *Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day.*

³ *Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.*

⁴ *For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.*

⁵ *For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.*

⁶ *Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.*

⁷ *Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.*

⁸ *Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.*

⁹ *O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.*

¹⁰ *Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.*

¹¹ *Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.*

¹² *Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice*

¹³ *Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.*

Focus: Renewal That Overflows

Psalm 96 calls for a new song because God is doing something new.

Resurrection produces fresh praise. Renewal is not quiet — it resounds.

This psalm widens the lens: all nations, all creation, all people are invited to rejoice. Lent has been deeply personal, but resurrection is powerfully public. God's salvation is meant to be declared.

When God renews us, our worship becomes witness. Praise is proclamation.

Prayer: God of renewal, let our praise overflow. May our lives sing of Your salvation. Amen.
