## What to Look for in a Roofing Quote

Free Checklist by Environmental Pro Construction

Materials
[] Roofing material clearly specified (e.g., concrete tiles, IBR, corrugated, shingles)
[] Thickness of metal sheets listed (e.g., 0.47mm or 0.50mm)
[] Coating type noted (Polyester / PVDF / Galvanised)
[] Brand or supplier mentioned
Fixtures & Fittings
[] Flashings included
[] Ridge caps, barge boards, and side cladding listed
[] Underlay or insulation layers specified
[] Gutters and downpipes (if applicable) noted
Labour & Workmanship
[] Full labour cost separated from materials
[] Estimated timeline for installation
[] Details on roof pitch/scaffolding/height access
[] Mention of engineer sign-off (for commercial or structural work)
Clarity & Transparency
[] Quote is itemized - not lump sum only
[] Payment terms and deposits are clear
[] Site cleanup, rubble removal included or excluded
[] Validity of quote stated (e.g., 14 or 30 days)

Tip: If a quote leaves any of this out - ask why. Clarity up front avoids cost surprises later.
