1. Introduction. GreenTech 2.0 is a project funded by the European Union's COSME programme with the aim to empower green tech clusters to support SMEs in exploiting growth opportunities, service innovation, resource-efficient solutions, market traction, finding investments and internationalization. It is accompanied by strategic partnering between clusters and specialized eco-systems and cities resulting in a new, joint GreenTech Services 2.0 portfolio for participating clusters, including the implementation of the ClusterXchange Programme.

9. What personal data do we process using cookies?

When you visit our website <https://www.greentech-project.eu>, the site asks your browser to store a small piece of data (text file) called a cookie on your device in order to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information. Those cookies are set by us and called first-party cookies. We also use third-party cookies, which are cookies from a domain different than the domain of the website you are visiting, for our advertising and marketing efforts. More specifically, we use cookies and other tracking technologies for the following purposes:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies.** These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but that will cause some parts of the site to not work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

How To Control and Delete Cookies Using Your Browser. 10. Data transfers, publishing. 11. Security of your information. To help protect the privacy of data and personally identifiable information you transmit through use of this website, we maintain physical, technical and administrative safeguards. We update and test our security technology on an ongoing basis. We restrict access to your personal data to those employees who need to know that information to provide benefits or services to you. In addition, we train our employees about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the

privacy and security of your information. We commit to taking appropriate disciplinary measures to enforce our employees' privacy responsibilities.

12. Data subject rights:

- Right to be informed;
- Right to access to data;
- Right to rectification;
- Right to erasure;
- Right to data portability;
- Right to object;
- Right to object to automated individual decision-making, including profiling;
- Right to withdraw the consent.

Consent to the processing of personal data may be withdrawn at any time and its withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was performed on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

13. We (data controllers) may share personal data with the following categories of companies and institutions:

- EU funds administrators;
- Professional advisers, auditors;
- Information technology services providers, like data centers, cloud services, website, software developers and suppliers, etc.;
- Advertising, marketing, automation services companies;
- Archiving, physical / electronic security, other business services;
- Government authorities, which require data according to EU or local law of a partner country of residence.
- Institutions involved in the ClusterXChange program: such as Hosts, business and financial partners, SMEs, clusters, etc. exclusively for the implementation of this project.

14. The joint controllership is based on Article 26 of GDPR. We inform that for performing the obligation connected with data subjects rights is responsible this Controller (consortium member), to whom a set of data, which part is data on the data subject, can be attributed (f.eg. Controller who provides a collaboration with host organization in their country). However data subject may contact any of the Joint Controllers about the rights granted to them by Articles 15 - 22 of the GDPR. The contacted Controller shall identify the responsible Controller and forward the request internally to this Controller. The originally contacted Controller shall carry out all necessary communication with the data subject.
