# Polar Packing Checklist

# Everything you need for your expedtion cruise

## **Clothing:**

- 1. Insulating Layers:
  - a. Thermal underwear (tops and bottoms)
  - b.Fleece jacket
  - c. Insulated pants or snow pants
- 2. Waterproof Outer Layers:
  - a. Waterproof jacket (provided by the cruise line)
  - b. Waterproof pants
  - c. Waterproof gloves or mittens
  - d. Hot Hands Hand Warmers for inside your gloves
- 3. Head and Neck Gear:
  - a. Insulated, waterproof hat
  - b. Neck gaiter or scarf
  - c.UV-blocking sunglasses
- 4. Footwear:
  - a. Insulated, waterproof boots (often provided by the cruise line)
  - b. Thick, moisture-wicking socks
  - c. Sneakers/Casual shoes for onboard
- 5. Casual Clothing:
  - a. Comfortable clothing for indoor activities on the ship (T-shirts, sweater/sweatshirt, jeans, jogging pants)
  - b. Pajamas
  - c. Swimsuit for the Polar Plunge & Hot Tubs

## **Health and Safety:**

- 1. Medications:
  - a. Personal prescription medications
  - b. Seasickness medication (Motion sickness bands or patches)
- 2. First Aid Kit with basic first aid supplies
  - a. Painkillers, diarrhea meds, antihistamines, bandaids...
  - b. Tissues, Handwipes & Santizer
- 3. Sunscreen:
  - a. High SPF sunscreen for face and exposed skin
  - b. Lip balm with SPF

#### **Documents and Essentials:**

- 1. Passport
- 2. Travel Insurance
- Credit Cards (make sure to let your bank know you are traveling)
- 4. Covid Vaccination Documents (these aren't needed for travel, but I like to have them along just in case)
- 5. Make a photocopy of all of these documents to bring along just in case anything gets lost

#### **Accessories:**

- 1. Backpack A small, waterproof backpack for shore excursions
- 2. Binoculars
- 3. Camera Gear:
  - a. Camera with a telephoto lens (wildlife)
  - b. Camera with wide angle lens (scenery)
  - c. Extra memory cards and batteries
  - d.Lens cleaning kit
  - e. Tripod
  - f. Large ziplock bag for extra protection
- 4. Laptop and external hard drive (storage for photos and videos)
- 5. Electronics:
  - a. International power adapter
  - b. Portable charger or power bank

### Miscellaneous:

- 1. Basic Toiletries:
  - a. Deodorant / Perfume
  - b. Razor & Shaving Cream
  - c. Dental (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
  - d. Lotion & Face Cream
- 2. Books or e-reader for leisure time
- 3. Deck of cards
