- 1:8   **ἐαυτοῦ, -ῆς, -οῦ** - (reflexive pronoun [not used in nominative]) - himself, herself, itself  
**πλανάω** – (verb) – I lead astray, mislead, deceive
- 1:9   **όμολογέω** – (verb) – I confess, declare, say plainly  
**πιστός, -ή, -όν** – (adjective) - faithful, trustworthy  
**δίκαιος, -α, -ον** – (adjective) – right, upright, righteous, just, fair, equitable  
**ἀφίημι-** (verb [from **ἀπὸ** {away from} + **ἱημί** {I send}]) – I dismiss, divorce, forgive  
**ἀδικία, -ας, ή** - (noun) – injustice, unrighteousness
