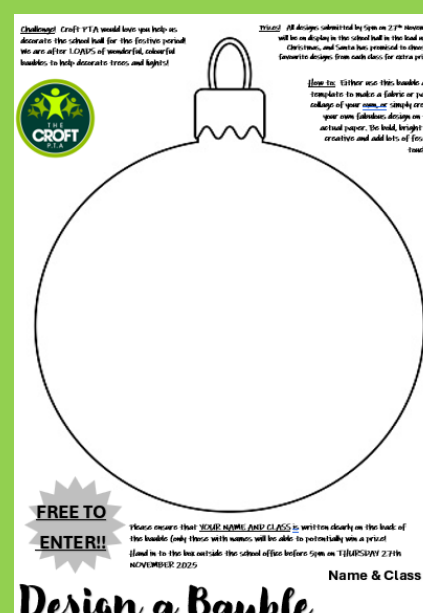
**Coming home in bags soon!**

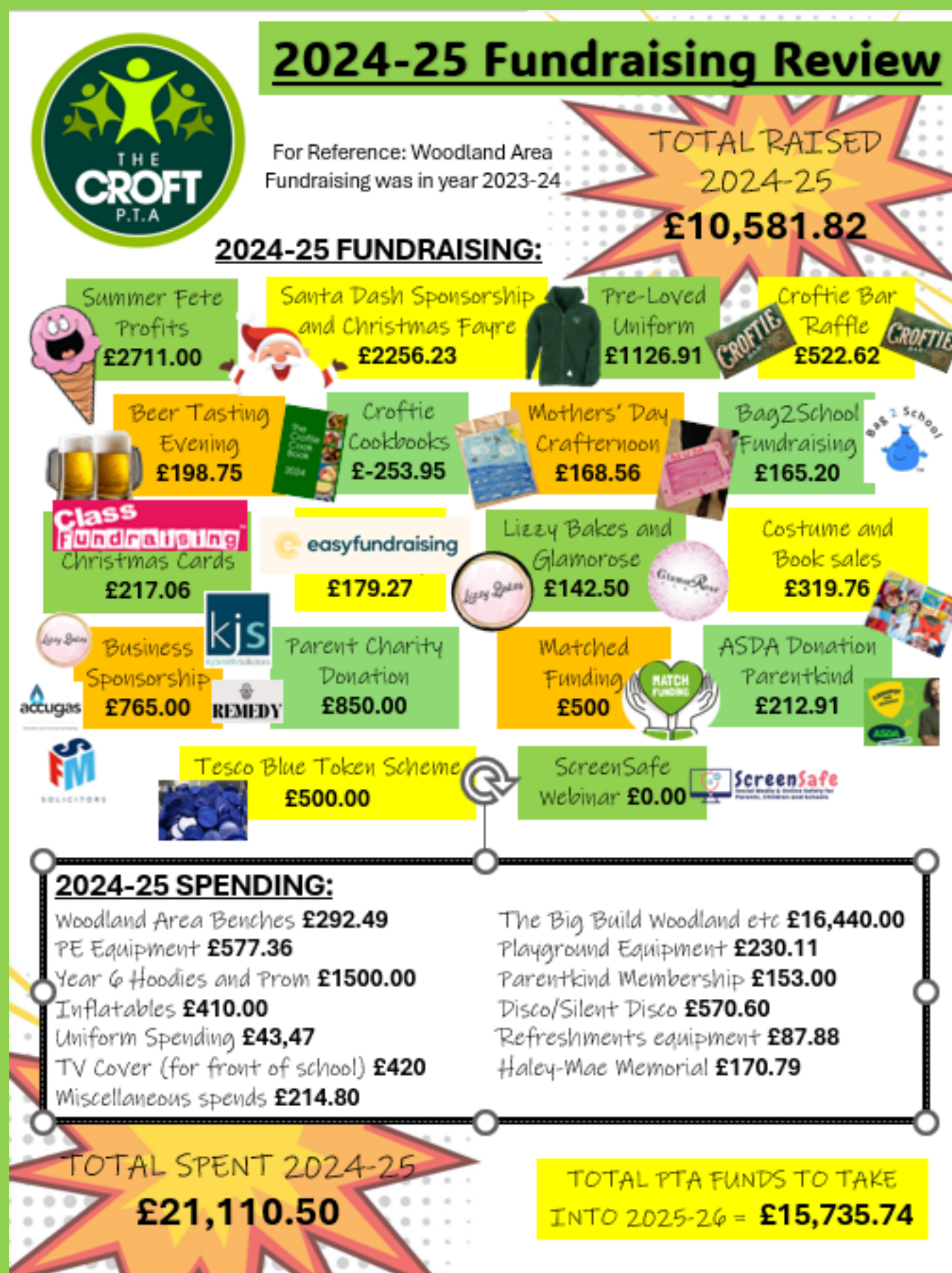

## More Information about money raised and spent this year...

Croft PTA are always extremely grateful for the financial support you give us. This helps us in our goal to provide more financial support for the pupils of Croft Primary School. Each year we listen to and number of funding requests from parents, students and the school itself.

The biggest thing we have funded this year is a second goal/basketball net to match the one already up on the top playground. This is something that all of our Crofties will use in lessons as well as in free time. As with all “school safe” play equipment it came at a heavy cost - £6000 – so this has taken up the majority of our spending this year.

You may not know but we also donate £1500 every year to each year 6 group which pays for their personalised leavers hoodies and goes towards their end of year Prom. This is a commitment we have made for the foreseeable future and something that says “Thank you” for the many years that parents have supported the PTA and events. We also spent money, this year, on brand new books for KS1 students to aid their literacy and as you already know, we fund discos and “bounce” events for all students to join in with. We aim to try to provide something for everyone!



We are, this year, in discussion about using money raised to support STEM activities in school, renew playground markings, purchase interactive play equipment and are still hopeful that we can pursue an arrangement to use more green space from GLL and the council. These would all be big purchases so the more support we get, the more we can do for your children!!

Finally (and perhaps even more importantly) we do also hope that you appreciate the events we put on in terms of pure ENJOYMENT and we do try to create a really lively ATMOSPHERE and COMMUNITY at Croft. Croft PTA hopes that you will continue to support events for these reasons as well as for opportunities to fundraise!
