- (1) The Woods ARC provides the builder/lot owner with a packet containing The Woods ARC timeline, building guidelines and materials summary sheet.
- (2) The builder/lot owner submits the house plan to The Woods ARC including the completed building materials summary sheet and plot plan (to scale) showing the position of the house with its driveway access to the street.
- (3) The Woods ARC gives the builder/lot owner written approval of the house/plot plan and building materials and provides the builder/lot owner with The Woods ARC Compliance Agreement to sign.
- (4) The builder/lot owner signs The Woods ARC Compliance Agreement and submits the required check for \$1,000 to The Woods ARC.
- (5) The Woods ARC grants the builder/lot owner final approval in writing with the authorization to stake-out the property. After The Woods ARC approves the stake-out, the removal of trees and construction may begin.
