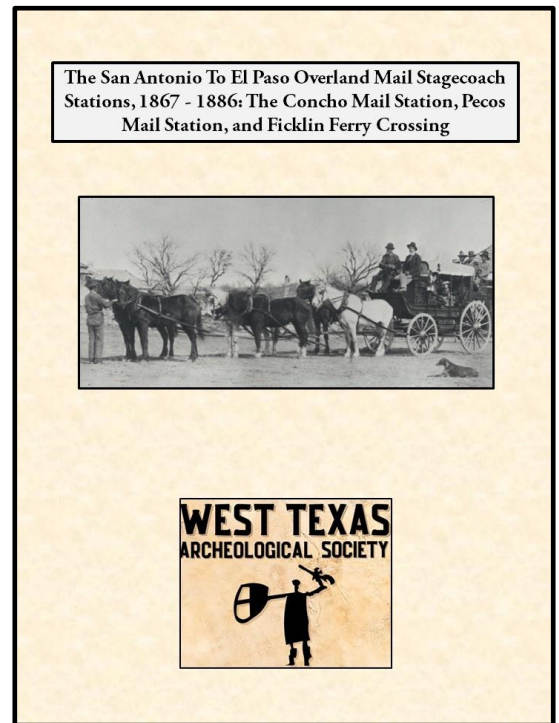

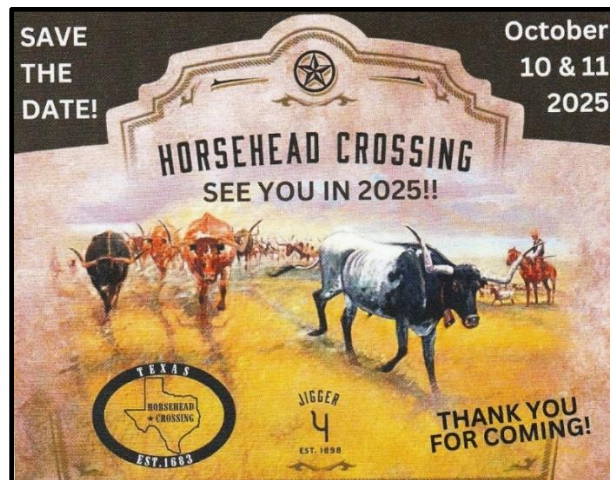
WTAS Reports to Tom Green County Library

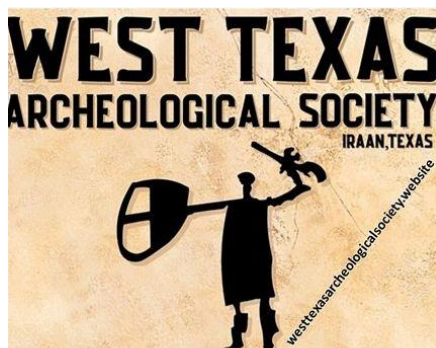
