## **NoAH** in the Community

The Northwest Association of Horticulture (NoAH) was established in 1985 to assist gardeners and organizations as a community service. Our goal is to assist and encourage gardening in the greater Minot area.

Noah has been actively sponsoring various community projects over the years. These projects include mentoring and planting activities at Habitat for Humanity homes and the Ward County Historical Society, planting activities at the Scandinavian Gardens, sponsoring and planting of "Memory Trees" for past members and their families, working with the test garden plots at the North Central Research Extension Center, helping in the city's trail cleanup project in spring and fall, and maintaining plants at the Minot Amtrak Depot. NoAH donated funds to replant trees and flower beds for members affected by the flood. Local organizations received donations to plant trees and construct a greenhouse.

One of our most gratifying projects was the creation of the Dr. Charles and Ruth Hoffman Scholarship Fund at Minot State University. It is awarded each year to a student studying one of the Life Sciences. NoAH also nominated their longtime member Ruth Hoffman for an Honorary Degree in Biology, which was awarded to her by MSU in May 2002.

NoAH has provided scholarships throughout the years to Dakota College Horticulture (Bottineau) and Minot High School FFA students. Numerous gardening books have been purchased and donated to the Minot Public and Ward County Libraries.

A majority of our monthly meetings feature a guest speaker who presents interesting information about various aspects of gardening. We also feature plant sales for members in the spring and fall. We take advantage of the warm summer months by planning visits to home gardens and greenhouses.

We plan our meetings to be informal, informative and fun.


