Scoring Your Audit

Count the number of “No” answers. This number is your Margin Leakage Score.

Score (“No”s)	Diagnosis	The Financial Impact
0 - 2	System-Driven: Your firm has a strong operating system. Margin leakage is minimal and caught quickly. You are likely operating in the top quartile of firm profitability (>25%).	Low Risk: You are leaving less than 1-2% of revenue on the table. Focus on optimization.
3 - 6	Experience-Driven: Your firm runs on the experience and heroics of your leaders. You get by, but you are constantly fighting fires and leaving significant money on the table.	Moderate Risk: You are likely leaving 3-7% of revenue on the table. For a \$10M firm, that is \$300k - \$700k in lost profit every year.
7+	Chaos-Driven: Your firm is operating in a reactive state. Profitability is unpredictable, principals are bottlenecks, and burnout is a serious risk. You are confusing activity with progress.	High Risk: You are likely leaving 8-15% or more of your revenue on the table. For a \$10M firm, that is \$800k - \$1.5M+ in lost profit every year. The cost of inaction is catastrophic.

What Now?
