HISTORY

The Aiken family, Matt, his older brother Tim (Occy) their mother Evelyn, and father Adam lived a simple life. Adam was the pastor of Fulton's Keep Bible Assembly and Evelyn was involved in every community organization the town had to offer. They seemed like the perfect family. Until Evelyn left. When she abandoned her family, Adam put on a false front in a misguided attempt to prove to the congregation that his relationship with God was solid. As a result, he did not allow the needed emotional support to help him properly move through his grief. Adam isolated himself, becoming bitter and angry. Occy and Matt soon became the focus of Adam's anger.

When a unexpected friend stopped by, she witnessed Adam abusing the kids and their dark secret was out. Instead of traveling the long hard road to healing, Adam became a slave to his shame. He left the town, and his sons, behind. Occy, now 18 and Matt 15, stayed in their house with support from the congregation. Matt finished school while Occy began to tread into darker waters. Occy formed allegiances in the town and engaged in petty crimes, earning him a bad reputation as the town gossip mill kicked into overdrive.

When Matt reached 21 years of age, his relationship with Occy had deteriorated. As Matt grew closer to God Occy sank further into crime. Occy finally left Fulton's Keep after a big fight with Matt and a very public meltdown ending in a warrant for Occy's arrest. Occy left and joined a biker gang called the Hellhounds while Matt stayed in Fulton's keep to try to restore the family name. Matt took over shepherding his father's old church drawing the ire of Occy.

MODERN DAY

Our story begins when Matt and Callie have established themselves as the pastors of the renamed Keeper's Grace Bible Church. They have also become pillars in the Fulton's Keep community. They live a happy, simple life running Matt's father's church as well as repairing the family home. Life seems perfect until Occy returns after a 14 year absence. The ensuing war between the brothers threatens to tear the town apart.

Set in middle America, this thinly veiled modern take on the Cain and Abel story explores the familiar themes of conflict, betrayal, love and redemption while exposing under-represented territories as we watch - in real time - a narcissistic psychopath tear his environment apart. The viewer is let in on Occy's secret early to be able to truly understand how lies and manipulation are used to bewitch good people.

MAIN CHARACTERS

MATT AIKEN



Matt (Ben Davies- Attached) has spent years picking up the pieces of his broken life. He used the pain of his toxic childhood to become a strong leader in his community. He credits God and Callie for making him the man he is today.

Fulton's Keep has a long sorted history with the Aiken family so Matt feels it is his responsibility to restore the family name.

Occy's return triggers feelings from long ago. Including the insecurity with knowing that Occy and Callie were once lovers.

CALLIE AIKEN



Callie was a wild child growing up. That is what attracted her to Occy when they were young. Her intense love affair with Occy broke off suddenly when Occy left.

Since that time, Callie has sorted out her life. She began going to church and eventually fell in love with Matt. She embraces the responsibility of being the pastor's wife and has become a respected member of the community.

Callie is not conflicted upon Occy's return. At least, she doesn't think she is.

TIM 'OCCY' AIKEN



Occy had always looked out for his younger brother. Starting with the playground and ending with their abusive father. Occy sees God in his own father and as a result, hates everything to do with church and God.

After a meltdown that the town will never forget, Occy leaves to live a life of crime. It's not long before Occy becomes president of the Hellhounds bike club. Now Occy has plans for the town. He also has a personal vendetta against Matt. He feels betrayed by Matt's decision to follow in his father's footsteps.

BROCK OWENS



Matt's best friend. He will do anything for Matt. Sometimes that means getting his hands dirty, or bloody, or sometimes just being the comic relief.

AMANDA OWENS



Callie's best friend. Amanda keeps herself busy by running her clothing store, keeping Brock in line and being Callie's most trusted confidant.

'KAGE'



Kage is Occy's second in command. Kage takes care of "logistics", which could mean a lot of things. Kage knows how to scare people; not by the things he says, but by the things he doesn't say.

ALEJANDRO CAPILLA



Alejandro has Asbergers and as such, has a tendency to be blunt. He found a home in the church after they gave him a job doing maintenance and repairs. He likes his job but doesn't like Occy.

SEASON ONE



SEASON ONE LOGLINE

When an unseasoned pastor's estranged brother returns home to set up his criminal enterprise, the pastor steps in to protect the community while struggling to navigate his own war within.

SEASON ONE SUMMARY

Episode one begins with a knock on the door. Callie opens it to find Matt's estranged brother, Tim (Occy). Matt is suddenly plunged into a sea of emotion. All the old feelings from his childhood come flooding back. Matt struggles with this since he thought he had put his past behind him.

To make matters worse, Occy had an intense, passionate love affair with Callie before he left town. Occy's hard appearance tells the story that he has long since abandoned petty crimes for a much more sinister path. When Occy tells Matt and Callie that he wants to come home and get right with God, they do not believe him.

Occy promises that Matt will come to trust him again, but Matt is not so sure. We are let in on Occy's deception in the first episode so the viewers can watch Occy tear down his father's legacy, attempting to destroy what Matt has built in the process. We also find out that Occy has less personal reasons to come home. Fulton's Keep is the perfect sleepy little town to set up shop for his criminal organization. It helps that the mayor is one of Occy's old partners in crime.

Fulton's Keep becomes the battleground for the blood feud between brothers while Matt also fights his own war within. This classic battle between good and evil sees Matt battling his fear and insecurity while his brother tries to decimate everything he's worked so hard for.

SEASON ONE EPISODE GUIDE

Episode 1 - Resurrection

Matt and Callie are shocked when they open the door to find Occy, Matt's criminal brother, long presumed dead. Matt is conflicted when Occy says he wants to come home.

Episode 2 - Restoration

Occy quickly becomes part of the church by doing repairs on the building while trying to restore Matt's trust. Matt senses there is more to Occy's story than he's letting on.

Episode 3 - Rejection

Matt starts to become concerned that Occy has darker plans for the church and refuses Occy's offer for financial support. Occy's secret begins to come to light.

Episode 4 - Resurgence

The Hellhounds move into the warehouse to bring business into full operation. Mayor Burk starts feeling the pressure from town council to do something about the rise in crime.

Episode 5 - Re-ignition

Matt confronts Occy with proof of Occy's true intention. Occy leaves the church and threatens Matt on the way out. Matt's insecurity makes him question Callie's loyalty.

Episode 6 - Re-negotiation

Alejandro's accident puts everyone on edge. Matt goes to the Hellhound clubhouse to try to talk sense into Occy. Kage begins to question Occy's authority.

Episode 7 - Redemption

Matt secretly meets with Pete to try to persuade him to help put an end to the reign of terror the Hellhounds have been holding the town under. Sheriff Nolan disappears.

Episode 8 - Retaliation

After Pete's disappearance, Brock finds his truck vandalized while Matt and Callie begin to suspect someone has been in the house. Alejandro recovers but decides to go away for a while.

Episode 9 - Retribution

Occy interrupts Matt's sermon in an attempt to publicly humiliate Matt. When Occy's plan backfires, the church is on high alert. Matt vows to put an end to his brother's antagonism once and for all.

Episode 10 - Repudiation

The war between the Aiken brothers comes to an explosive conclusion with this shocking finale to season one.



SEASON TWO SUMMARY



After Occy lands in jail, he must learn to navigate his business from prison. He quickly comes to the conclusion that there must be someone within his organization that is working against him. Now Occy must figure out how to get out of prison in order to deal with the traitor.

Matt is recovering both physically and emotionally after his showdown with Occy. While taking a break from his pastoral duties, Matt begins to uncover the full extent of Occy's crime network and how it is tearing at the fabric of the Fulton's Keep community. This paints a huge target on Matt and Callie's back as well as putting their friends in the splash zone.

SEASON THREE SUMMARY



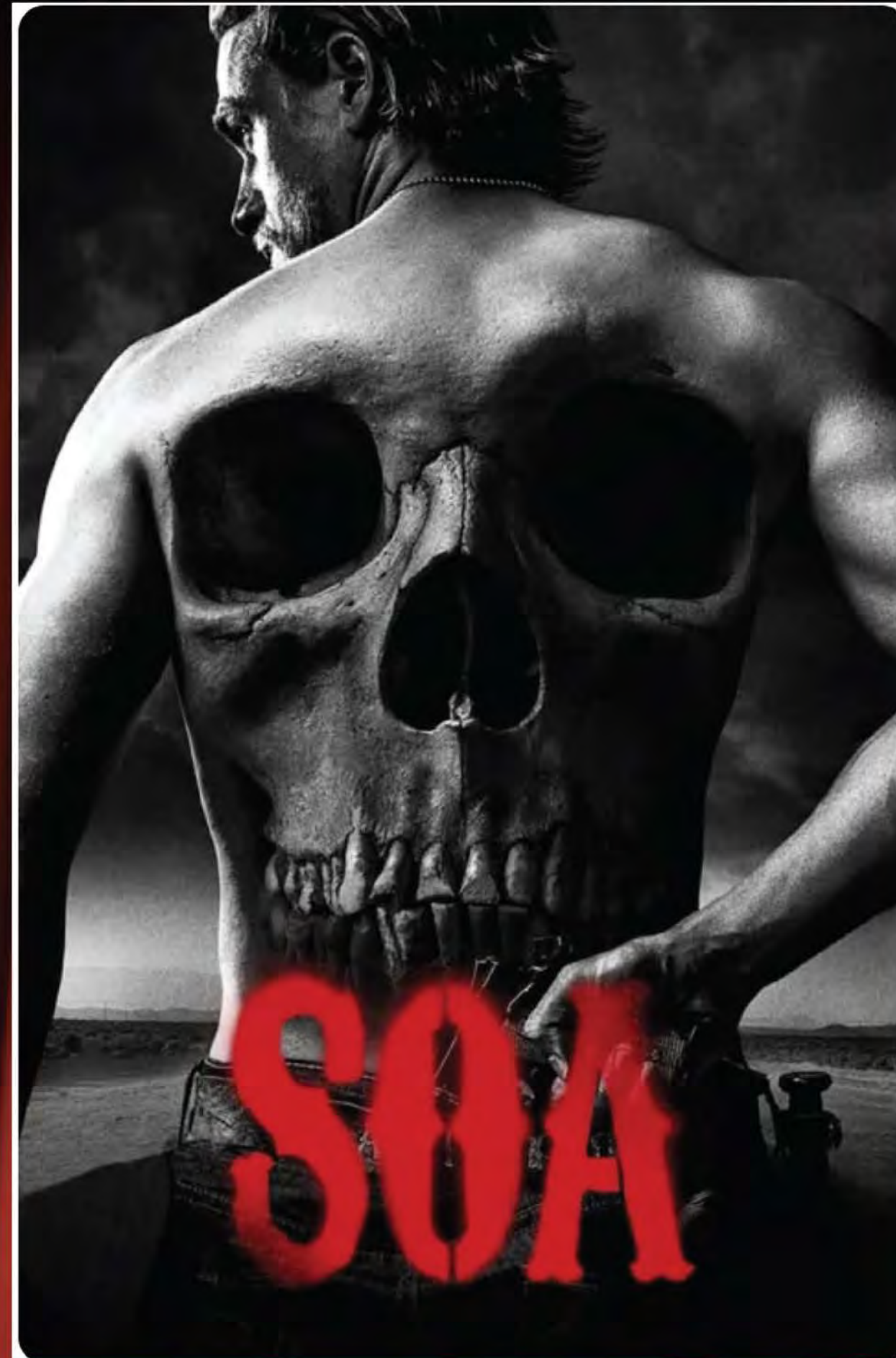

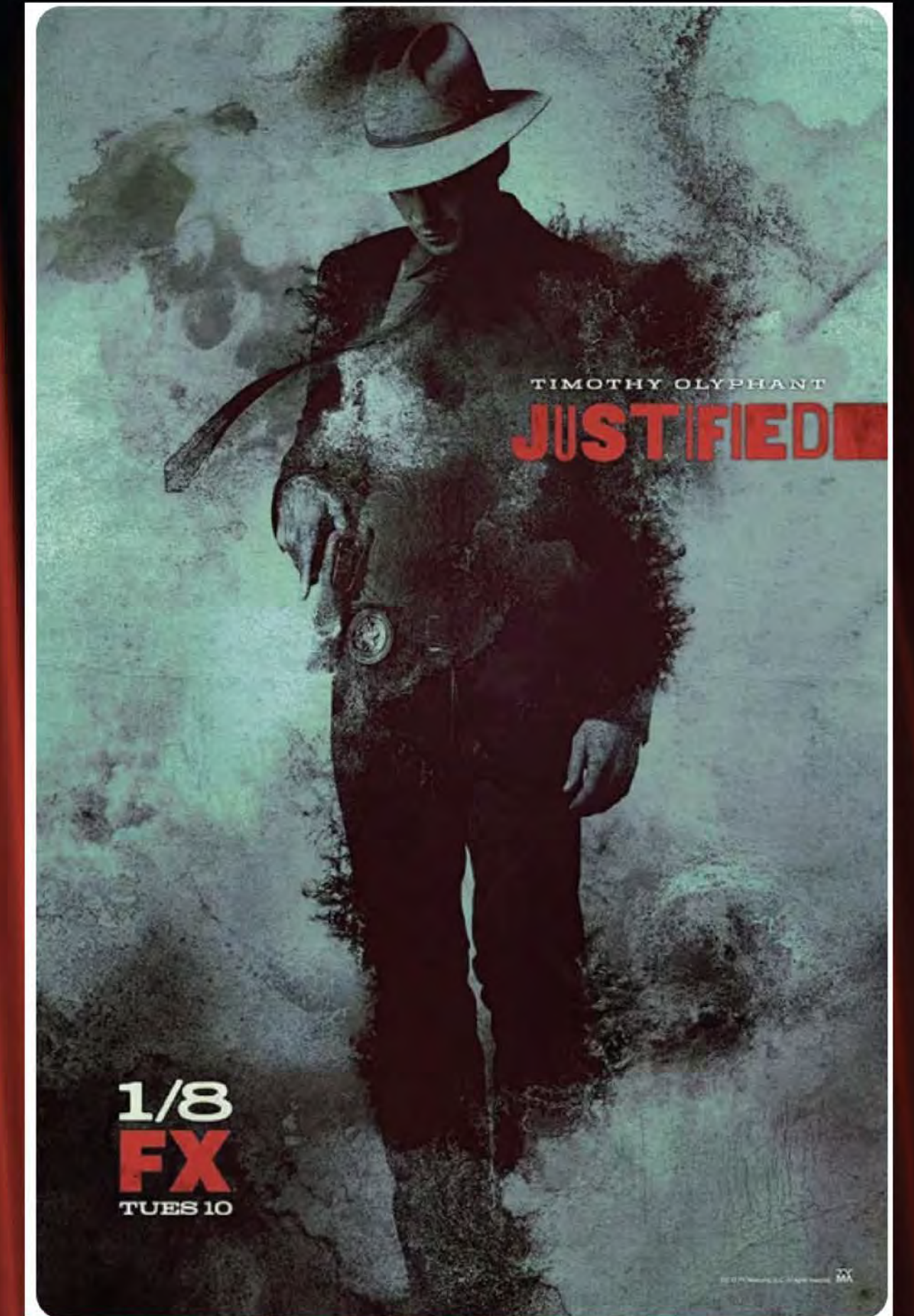
