\_\_\_\_\_ **TOBIT** – *Fr Luke Childs* - Blinding through bird poop. Entertaining an angel unaware. A cross-country voyage to obtain riches. Love destined from eternity. Exorcism. And a dog. What could be more fun? Come and see.

\_\_\_\_\_ **THE ORIGINS OF BAPTISM** - *Fr David Peterson* - This course will take an in-depth look at the origins of baptism, Jesus' baptism, baptism and conversion, baptism and discipleship, and the significance of the act of baptism. We will learn why there are different baptism practices in the broader Christian Church and have a deeper appreciation of Anglicanism.

\_\_\_\_\_ **IT'S A MYSTERY** – *Dcn Jim Stubblefield* - Exploring the history, traditions, mysteries, and praying of the Holy Rosary

\_\_\_\_\_ **EXPLORING BIBLICAL MANHOOD** - *Fr Townsend Waddill* - THIS IS A MALE ONLY CLASS. Much of the conversation about the role of men and women in our 21st century culture is governed by radical secular forces rather than Biblical theology and Catholic teaching, and because of this, relationships are much more strained, and our divorce rates are higher than they've ever been. Since we are called by God to live with the Holy Scriptures as our guide and not the secular culture, this course will explore God's unique design for men and how we are called to live as spiritual leaders and as men of God.

\_\_\_\_\_ **THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS & FAITHFUL CHRISTIAN LIVING** - *Fr Noah Lawson*- What is the mystical bond between the Church on earth, in purgatory, and in heaven, allowing for intercession and spiritual support across these realms? The goal of this class is to explore the doctrine of the Communion of Saints which teaches that all believers, both living and deceased, are united in a spiritual community with Christ as the head, sharing in the grace and prayers of one another. The class will focus on the biblical basis for this doctrine, the role of saints, and the practice of invoking the prayers of the saints.

*Fr Hayden Butler* - “There is a story about a schoolboy who was asked what he thought God was like. He replied... that God was ‘The sort of person who is always snooping round to see if anyone is enjoying himself and then trying to stop it.’ And I am afraid that is the sort of idea that the word Morality raises in a good many people’s minds, as something that stops you from having a good time. In reality, moral rules are directions for running the human machine” from *Christian Behavior* by C.S. Lewis. This course will look at Christian decision making and our relationship with our Heavenly Father.

\_\_\_\_\_ **CHURCH HISTORY – (REQUIRED for all THIRD-YEAR students)** – The Sweeping Saga of the great commission unfolding through the pages of history from the Acts of the Apostles to the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

# FAQ'S, Rules, & Other Information

*Parents: PLEASE READ these final pages diligently and keep them for your reference.*

## **What is Saint Michael's Conference?**

Originally founded in Massachusetts in 1960, St Mike's is a group of young people, lay leaders, and priests who come together to form a spiritual family. The daily rhythm of corporate worship, study, discussion, recreation, and relaxation establishes the community in a vital, integrated, and lived faith. Participants return to their home parishes energized to fight against the temptations of the world, the flesh, and the devil. For most, it such a joyful experience, they return year after year.

## **Who can attend St Mike's?**

The conference is open to young people from 12 to 19 years of age. To be eligible, a candidate must be 12 years old at the START of the conference. Conferees should be Christians who desire a deeper intimacy with God. Questions and doubt are normal, especially for young people, and thus do not disqualify anyone from the conference. If anything, they are even more encouraged to attend.

## **What is the cost of attending St Mike's?**

The total cost is \$500. A **non-refundable** registration fee of \$150 is paid when this application is sent. The remaining balance of \$350 is paid upon arrival to the Conference. This amount covers room & board, food, and materials for each conferee as well as the overall expenses of the Conference.

## **How can I pay the deposit and fees?**

Currently, we can only take checks or cash. Information on how to fill out the check can be found above. We are hoping to have an online payment option soon, but as of right now, that is unavailable.

## **Do we really need to bring dress clothes?**

**YES.** The conferees, counselors, and clergy will be wearing their "Sunday best" for God from Morning Prayer until Lunch each day. We encourage one another to embrace formal dress as an expression of love for Christ and one another.

## **Can I come visit during the week?**

Those who are not officially a part of the Conference will not be accommodated overnight or for meals at any time. We maintain a "closed community" for the week in order to ensure an environment that encourages growth in love and knowledge of Jesus Christ. We ask that those bringing the conferees leave after the child is registered and settled in, and return for the Pageant on Saturday.

## **DROP-OFF PROCEDURE**

Please arrive at Santa Teresita between 4:30pm and 6pm on Sunday, July 20<sup>th</sup>. Registration will take place at Ollie Craig Hall, the central dining hall. Follow the signs if you are unfamiliar with the campus. NOTE: The staff will NOT be able to register you before 4:30pm.

## **PICK-UP PROCEDURE**

It is a long-standing tradition that the conferees perform the "Pageant of Redemption," recounting the key events in the story of salvation history. This takes place at 11:30am in St Junipero Serra Chapel. **We highly encourage parents to come to watch the Pageant!** Once finished, you are free to take your child home. Please do not forget to pick up medications, cell phones, and keys from the staff!

- Electronic devices (Cell Phones will be turned in at Registration)
- Inappropriate reading materials

Formal Night – Also on Thursday, this is when we encourage conferees to bring out their nicest clothes.

## RULES

Conferees are NOT permitted to:

- Leave the camp grounds during the conference
- Possess or use drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products
- Mistreat property belonging to Camp Crucis or other persons
- Engage in inappropriate behavior toward members of the opposite sex or any other person
- Bully or poorly mistreat others
- Use profane language
