SURVEY – (REQUIRED for all FIRST-YEAR students) – *Fr Spencer Stubblefield* – A study of the basic aspects of Christian life.

RECEIVING THE WORD OF GOD – (REQUIRED for all SECOND-YEAR students) – *Fr Jeff Stubbs* – An introduction to the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments.

ANGLICAN SAINTS – (REQUIRED for all THIRD-YEAR students) – *Frs Peterson & LeTourneau* - This lively class explores the saints who shaped Anglicanism—holy, human, and sometimes a little surprising. Expect great stories, faithful courage, and plenty of inspiration

FROM MILK TO SOLID FOOD: A Journey through Hebrews – *Fr Luke Childs* - How do the Old and New Testaments link together to form a cohesive narrative of God's dealings with humanity? What does it mean for Jesus to be our Great High Priest in the order of Melchizedek? What does it really mean on-the-ground in everyday life to walk by faith? How do we keep going with Jesus in times of difficulty? Answers to these questions and more as we walk through the New Testament Book of Hebrews together.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS - *Fr Hayden Butler* - St. Peter writes, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith." Christians have always been aware of the reality of spiritual evil. In this class, we will discuss spiritual warfare in the Christian life and how the ordinary Christian can practice a good defense against the enemies of our souls.

EXPLORING BIBLICAL MANHOOD - *Fr Townsend Waddill* - THIS IS A MALE ONLY CLASS. Much of the conversation about the role of men and women in our 21st century culture is governed by radical secular forces rather than Biblical theology and Catholic teaching, and because of this, relationships are much more strained, and our divorce rates are higher than they've ever been. Since we are called by God to live with the Holy Scriptures as our guide and not the secular culture, this course will explore God's unique design for men and how we are called to live as spiritual leaders and as men of God.

THE DUTIES OF LAITY - *Fr Noah Lawson* - The life of Christian Discipleship is a high call received by all people who have completed the Rites of Christian Initiation. The Duties of the Laity describe the extraordinary way of living all Christians, particularly in the Anglican Church of North America, are called to embrace by God's grace.

THE MASS – (REQUIRED for all FIRST-YEAR students) – *Fr Brandon LeTourneau* –
What is the Mass? Why do we do what we do? What did Jesus mean when he said, “Do this in remembrance of me”?

TRAINING IN RIGHTEOUSNESS – (REQUIRED for all SECOND-YEAR students) –
Fr Hayden Butler - “There is a story about a schoolboy who was asked what he thought God was like. He replied... that God was ‘The sort of person who is always snooping round to see if anyone is enjoying himself and then trying to stop it.’ And I am afraid that is the sort of idea that the word Morality raises in a good many people’s minds, as something that stops you from having a good time. In reality, moral rules are directions for running the human machine” from Christian Behavior by C.S. Lewis. This course will look at Christian decision making and our relationship with our Heavenly Father.

CHURCH HISTORY – (REQUIRED for all THIRD-YEAR students) – *Fr Luke Childs* –
The Sweeping Saga of the great commission unfolding through the pages of history from the Acts of the Apostles to the 21st Century.

ELECTIVES FOR 4TH YEARS AND ABOVE

FAQ'S, Rules, & Other Information

Parents: PLEASE READ these final pages diligently and keep them for your reference.

What is Saint Michael's Conference?

Originally founded in Massachusetts in 1960, St Mike's is a group of young people, lay leaders, and priests who come together to form a spiritual family. The daily rhythm of corporate worship, study, discussion, recreation, and relaxation establishes the community in a vital, integrated, and lived faith. Participants return to their home parishes energized to fight against the temptations of the world, the flesh, and the devil. For most, it such a joyful experience, they return year after year.

Who can attend St Mike's?

The conference is open to young people from 12 to 19 years of age. To be eligible, a candidate must be 12 years old at the START of the conference. Conferees should be Christians who desire a deeper intimacy with God. Questions and doubt are normal, especially for young people, and thus do not disqualify anyone from the conference. If anything, they are even more encouraged to attend.

What is the cost of attending St Mike's?

The total cost is \$700. A **non-refundable** registration fee of \$200 is paid when this application is sent. The remaining balance of \$500 is paid upon arrival to the Conference. This amount covers room & board, food, and materials for each conferee as well as the overall expenses of the Conference. **PLEASE CHECK WEBSITE FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH CAMP SAN JOAQUIN!**

How can I pay the deposit and fees?

Currently, we can only take checks or cash. Information on how to fill out the check can be found above. We are hoping to have an online payment option soon, but as of right now, that is unavailable.

Do we really need to bring dress clothes?

YES. The conferees, counselors, and clergy will be wearing their "Sunday best" for God from Morning Prayer until Lunch each day. We encourage one another to embrace formal dress as an expression of love for Christ and one another.

Can I come visit during the week?

Those who are not officially a part of the Conference will not be accommodated overnight or for meals at any time. We maintain a "closed community" for the week in order to ensure an environment that encourages growth in love and knowledge of Jesus Christ. We ask that those bringing the conferees leave after the child is registered and settled in, and return after Closing Ceremonies.

DROP-OFF PROCEDURE

Please arrive at Santa Teresita between 4:00pm and 5:00pm on Sunday, July 19th. Registration will take place at Ollie Craig Hall, the central dining hall. Follow the signs if you are unfamiliar with the campus. NOTE: The staff will NOT be able to register you before 4:00pm.

PICK-UP PROCEDURE

The Conference ends with Closing Ceremonies at 11am. This is a closed ceremony for present and past Michaelites. Parents may pick up their kids and gather belongings at the conclusion (about an hour). Lunch will be available on Saturday for a fee.
