### HE WORLD AGAINST THOSE NOT OF THIS WORLD...

If the world hates you [and it does], know that it has hated me before it hated you.



19 If you belonged to the world, the world would love you as its own and would treat you with affection. But you are not of the world [you no longer belong to it], but I have chosen you out of the world. And because of this, the world hates you. John 15:18-19

Are gone the days when in the back of every mind is the memory of a time when life was harmonious and reverent, times when there were no wars, civil unrest, and little in the way of want, conveniently greet strangers on the street, and there was no subjugation or class division? Are gone the days when we read our Bibles and said our prayers in school gatherings, classes, assemblies, parks, and hospitals?

Permit me to draw your attention to the reasoning and remembering of times when spirituality and morality were the compasses of pursuit for most families, the church, the community, and the nation at large. Everything prospered as if it were the politicians and the political system of government that worked, as most people abide by and rule by the law; everything works just fine, peaceful, and loving.

# Morality is the standard, and epitome of every family and community.

The Christian community was functional and self-sufficient.

Unfortunately, leaders and many others seem to have forgotten the role of the spiritual atmosphere and its benefits for the community, the nation, and the world as a whole.

Now, it seems quite clear and factual that if you take away the practice and subdue the role of Christianity from society—the sole disinfecting and preserving salt of the earth—you will not be able to hire enough police, intelligent politicians, think-tankers, and policymakers to control the aftermath chaos. This is the honest reflection we are now seeing around the world.

Today, Christians are disempowered in an existential state, confined to circumscribed, socially-vetted roles, with fewer resources, to prevent them from standing out, luring evil policy over them; that is evidence everywhere, especially from the so-called "corridors of power."

#### **Anti-Christian**

Anti-Christian bias has been happening in many parts of our culture, from the public sector to the private sector, in

the mainstream media, on the internet, in the movie industry, in the public education system, and in our communities.

Often, the discrimination comes from activist judges misinterpreting the law (the hostility to Christian religious freedom infects our judiciary as much as anywhere else); the laws and regulations now seem biased; other times, it comes from entities misapplying the law. It also comes from what we call "political correctness." The discrimination mainly stems from hostility toward Christianity and from rampant disinformation in our society about what the Constitution requires in terms of the so-called "separation of church and state."

Though a significant body of law safeguards religious liberties, the law is not always followed, even when the courts interpret it correctly (in accordance with the framers' original intent).

Every day, the discrimination against Christians in our society becomes more evident and widespread. The cultural assumptions of our community influence changes in the law, and the culture is moving against the public expression of Christian belief everywhere, and we haven't seen anything yet.



e, as Christians, must understand that the war against Christians is on multiple fronts.

"Of course, anytime you speak about or live by moral absolutes, you'll get attacked by people who don't want to be told—either by your words or practical living example—that what they're doing is wrong."

If you will remember, from time past, most people, even those who don't believe who Christ is and what He says, conceded that He was "a great teacher" or a "morally upright man." Other than that, they want nothing to do with Him, and if you have everything to do with Him, then you are a problem for this world.

So the upshot is that if you are truly living for Christ, the eventual outcome is that many people who do not know Him—the world—will hate you simply because of who and what your Master, Christ, is. And yet you and I persevere because the message that the world hates so much—that God loves us deeply and dearly and wants to enfold us in His arms—is one that individual people within the world are crying out to hear and experience within their circle.

As extremism and violence against Christians continue to rise worldwide, on the upside, Christianity is growing at a rate of about 1.5 percent globally. Around 2.5 billion Christians represent a third of the world's population.

The faith is growing fastest in Africa and Asia, where churches are generally more orthodox than in the West.

However, Christians are dying worldwide, being tortured, persecuted, and cast in horrendous ways, and what are we doing about it? Many nations in the West are quick to take on refugees from Islamic countries with conflicting values, disrupting social cohesion, and even committing unprecedented acts of immorality. Would it not make sense to legally correct the immigration disaster and consider our brethren with shared values and beliefs? Indeed, they'd find it easier to integrate.


otwithstanding, confessional Christianity is also in a perilous state; medical professionals, parents, and clergy are often harassed in their respective roles for daring to be Christian. It seems it is no longer socially acceptable in Christian countries to hold to traditional Christian views.


This timeline would help provide context for understanding how these




Amidst the worldwide chaos and uncertainty, the largest UFO spectacle show will take place right at the heart of the globe.

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# Paralytic's Greatest Need — Extraordinary Encounters with Jesus Christ. -Alístair Begg

In 2013, the Wall Street Journal published an article titled "Is Smart Making Us Dumb?" The writer reasoned that technology and technological advancement might be able to fix human behavior in a broken world. One way that we could leverage technology toward this end, the article explains, is by "making the real world more like a video-game, with points for doing good."

This article is a good reminder for Christians to be reading with our Bibles in one hand and our newspapers in the other. (Of course, the former is immeasurably more important.) The Bible has something to say about our broken world. In truth, Scripture plumbs far deeper into the brokenness of human experience than technology ever could.

# Jesus is the only one in the entire universe who can forgive sins.

The good news that the Bible provides is that Jesus has come to deal with our brokenness. Indeed, Jesus' kingdom ministry principally involved addressing it. (See, e.g., <u>Luke 4:18</u>). And in Mark 2:1–12, we witness Jesus confronting one man's brokenness in particular—though, as we'll discover, it wasn't the brokenness with which the man was initially preoccupied. In His encounter with this man, we see Jesus forgiving sin and facing opposition.

# **Forgiving Sin**

Mark describes the scene in verse 2: "Many were gathered together, so that there was no more room, not even at the door. And [Jesus] was preaching the word to them." People were flocking to Jesus. It was standing room only in the house as the crowds gathered around to hear Him, the living Word, proclaim the written Word. And His teaching ministry, we may safely presume, would have involved an explanation of the Old Testament writings. He wanted the people to know what it was to repent and believe

the Gospel (Mark 1:15), to turn around and walk the narrow path that leads to life (Matt. 7:13–14).

Jesus' message calls each of us to self-examination: Have we repented, doing an about-turn from sin and toward God? Are we walking on the narrow way? Or are we merely interested in Christian ideas, ourselves unmoved by the power of God in Christ? C. S. Lewis fell into the latter group in his early adult years. Later, reflecting on his conversion, Lewis would describe himself as "the most dejected and reluctant convert in all England."

Yet though reluctant, he was changed. God's light had shone in his heart through the Scriptures, leading Lewis to embrace Christ as Lord. And so God does for all who walk the narrow path by faith.

The drama in Mark 2 continues. The crowd gathers, Jesus preaches, and a paralyzed man appears (v. 3). His four friends, determined that he would see Jesus (we are not told why), think up an unusual plan: bypassing the crowds, they would lower their paralyzed friend through the roof. We can picture the scene: amid a vast crowd, Jesus is preaching, and suddenly He is interrupted by the sound of vegetation and clay being pulled apart above His head—before a paralytic is lowered and presented to the Lord.

No one could have prepared for what happened next. Jesus, seeing the faith of the man and his friends, said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven" (Mark 2:5). What a strange response! The man had an obvious problem. His friends believed Jesus had some sort of solution. But rather than heal him, Jesus forgives him.

# Our free forgiveness came at a great cost to Christ.

The genius of Jesus in this passage lies in His laying hold of the paralytic's greatest need—the need for forgiveness. He wasn't uninterested in the man's physical condition; He later heals him (vv. 11–12)! Nor is Jesus unconcerned with our health, marriages, or relationships. But God's Son didn't come merely to help us through temporary trials, making our lives more comfortable. He came to restore us to a relationship with the living

God for whom we were created. Forgiving the man's sins, He dealt with a brokenness far deeper than his inability to walk—and so He does for us still.



# Facing Opposition

We might expect that the religious establishment would have responded with delight to Jesus' words—but the reverse was the case. "Now some of the scribes were sitting there," Mark tells us, "questioning in their hearts, 'Why does this man speak like that? He is blaspheming!

Who can forgive sins but God alone?" (2:6-7).

Jesus encountering opposition wasn't anything new. Earlier in his Gospel, Mark records Him already having been opposed by the devil in the wilderness (1:12–13) and by demons in the synagogue (1:21–26). But in this instance, in the context of compassion and forgiveness, it was the religious leaders who opposed the Lord's work. Their question, admittedly, is a reasonable one: "Who can forgive sins but God alone?" The answer is: nobody. They were right on that one. But then they went wrong by accusing Jesus of blasphemy, assuming He was merely a man. In their minds, it was

wrong for an ordinary Galilean carpenter to claim to forgive sin. Only God could do that.

Perceiving what was in their hearts, Jesus proceeded to pose a masterful question. Turning the tables on the religious establishment, He asked, "Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, take up your bed and walk'?" (Mark 2:9).

From one perspective, it's far easier to say "Your sins are forgiven." It's unverifiable. Anyone can utter those words without knowing whether or not the saying accomplished anything. But for a paralyzed man to walk would be indisputable. So the logic of Jesus' question is striking. Since He had already done the supposedly easier of the two deeds—telling the paralytic his sins are forgiven—He would now go on to do the second: He would tell the man to walk.

The terminology Jesus uses in verse 10 is crucial to understanding the message of this passage: He heals the man, we're told, in order that the Jewish leaders "may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." The title "the Son of Man" is a reference to <u>Daniel 7:13–14</u>, where the prophet speaks of a divine-human "son of man" who would one day rule over God's people. It was a messianic prophecy with which the Jews would've been familiar. By invoking this language, Jesus made known that His authority to forgive sins was grounded in His very identity.

When we say that Jesus has authority to forgive sins, we're not being presumptuous. Jesus is the only one in the entire universe who can forgive sins. He's the only Savior, because He's the only one who is qualified to save. And the forgiveness that Jesus offers—the kind that He gave to the paralytic man, as He does to all who approach Him in faith—came at great cost to Himself. Free to believers, our forgiveness cost our Lord His very life.

At the cross, Jesus bore the punishment that sin deserves in order that those who trust in Him might enjoy a forgiveness that we don't deserve. Indeed, the whole Bible is a book about what God has done for us in Christ. He entered our brokenness and met our greatest need.

# Trysting at the Tree


In an old hymn, the writer describes Jesus' cross as the "trysting place where heaven's love and heaven's justice meet." A *tryst* is an appointment, usually made secretly between two lovers, to meet at a certain place or time. And it's at a tree, the hymn writer says, where Jesus set His "trysting place" with us. Jesus declared His love for His bride, the church, on the tree at Calvary.

# Only the free forgiveness of God in Christ fixes our brokenness and saves our souls.

We can see from the story of paralytic man why the cross is central to our interpretation of Scripture. *If the paralytic would have gained function in his legs without having his sins forgiven, then he would have had a healthy body with a perishing soul.* His presenting issue wasn't his deepest need. Initially, he wanted healing for his body; Jesus instead began by forgiving his sins—a forgiveness that would be purchased at the cross.

And so we're reminded: Healthy bodies won't save our souls. Technology won't fix our brokenness. Only the free forgiveness of God in Christ accomplishes these things. There is no doubt that every man and woman stands in need of Christ's healing help. And when we cry for it, He responds by addressing not only what we find to be our superficial needs but also the deepest longings of our hearts.

# **PERSECUTED**

# Christian in Mali tells of conversion, and evangelism.

Christian," the plumber told Charles Yabaga Diarra, "I can't give you the same price to fix your stuff that I would do for a Muslim. There is a price for Muslims and there is a price for Christians."

Such open disdain is as good as it gets for

Christians in Mali, at least in the south. Since a 2012 military coup removed the country's democratically elected leader, conditions are much more severe in northern Mali, where abductions, murder and sexual enslavement are common.

Diarra is internally displaced in the war-torn country where several al-Qaeda factions have united to control the entire Sahel region. Open Doors, an international religious freedom advocacy and humanitarian aid group helping Christians in 70 countries, ranks Mali as the 17th most difficult country for Christians.

"I think it's important that Christians (in other parts of the world) know that being a Christian in Mali is not easy. There is very insidious persecution from your family, your friends, even the government," said Diarra, a

husband, father, educational administrator and preacher, in an interview with Baptist Press. "But I think they need to know there's also hope. That

churches are growing despite the persecution coming from every side... They need to continue to pray for Mali, for the Sahel."

Diarra grew up in a Muslim family where Christians were disparaged. Christians didn't pray, he believed. Christians drink alcohol. They eat pork. His father was a school headmaster, government employee and a politician whose leadership Diarra considered too strict and regimented. Diarra ran away from his home in Léré, seeking refuge about 150 miles away at his uncle's home.

There, he first heard the Gospel.

Diarra's uncle was already a Christian pastor, having accepted Jesus through the ministry of evangelical missionaries.

"And he said something very strange: 'Because we are Christians, we pray before meals.' And my uncle prayed," Diarra said. "I was shocked. Because this man prayed, he prayed in my mother tongue. I understood everything he said. I was so impressed, at the same time I was shocked, because I was told Christians don't pray. And here this man prayed over food. I was very, very impressed by what I heard."

Diarra embarked on a journey that has led to perhaps 100 conversions to Christianity in his extended family.

His uncle took him to Vacation Bible School for a week before advising him to return home. Still not a Christian, he shared the New Testament with his Muslim teenage friends, telling them he had met several praying Christians. His father overheard. He forced Diarra to return to Quranic school – commonly attended by 5- to 7-year-olds – to be proselytized in Islam before enrolling him in high school.

Again in his uncle's home, Diarra tried to convert the uncle to Islam. Diarra asked one of his schoolteachers what he could do to convert his Christian uncle to Islam.

"This is what he said to me. He said, 'Listen young boy, you are not supposed to discuss with Christians, you are not supposed to eat their food, drink their water, otherwise you will get converted. I was staying with my uncle, eating his food and drinking his water," Diarra said with amusement. "Maybe that's why I got converted."

Diarra recalls his conversion in November 1981.

"I said Lord, I'm really tired of seeking the truth. If it's Islam, Christianity or maybe another religion, just show me the way," Diarra said. "I was just lost really.

"I'd hardly finished my prayer when a Bible verse I'd learned during Vacation Bible School came to my mind. So He saved me, not because of my works of righteousness, but because of His mercy. I think I was saved that night."

The most difficult days of his teen years followed. His father learned of his conversion, summoned him home and scheduled a "family talk." He urged Diarra to recant.

An aunt, one of 30 or 40 relatives present, urged the family to give Diarra time. Diarra was only a child, she said, and would soon forget about Christianity.

Shouting ensued. The family was divided. Diarra doesn't remember the exact sequence of events, but his father arranged for him to live elsewhere. Diarra was the lone Christian among as many as 400 classmates when he returned to high school. There, he studied the Bible and religious books to defend his faith in a sea of Islam, and grew in knowledge and faith.

Upon marriage, Diarra asked his father to allow him to raise one of his siblings.

"My father said no. He said, 'You are a Christian. I am a Muslim. If I give you one of my children, it means I gave you permission to make him a Christian."

But when Diarra's father died within two years, Diarra, as the oldest son, had the privilege of raising his siblings, all 14 of them.

"This is how God works. I asked for one, he said no, but God gave me the 14," Diarra proclaimed. "And today, most of my brothers and sisters are Christians."

He and his wife, also a Christian, now have children of their own. At a recent family gathering, Diarra said, an onlooker remarked that perhaps 100 Christians were in attendance. His uncle who took him to VBS is also now internally displaced by the coup.

Diarra's family endures daily persecution as a way of life. His children are called children of infidels, chided and insulted daily at school. Government and businesses work against them.

"Community members don't want to come to your house," he said. "They don't want to greet you. They are doing everything they can to just make your life miserable; it's very difficult."

It's vital that the international community continue to advocate on behalf of persecuted Christians in the Sahel and elsewhere, where violent conflicts increasingly disrupt daily life.

Diarra finds freedom in Christianity.

"Salvation by grace, it's so wonderful to get that. We are free to come to Him," Diarra said. "He gave us freedom to believe.

"Freedom is very, very important to me."



#### AI PHONE IS THE FUTURE HANDHELD DEVICE

Artificial intelligence is already widespread on phones. Most existing smartphones have integrated AI features that use machine learning to optimize apps, camera functions, processors, batteries, and various other phone capabilities. However, the degree of intelligence is still fairly narrow.

Dedicated AI processors are coming: Several smartphone makers are building custom AI chips and co-processors to enable more on-device machine learning. This will bring new levels of autonomy without relying as much on the cloud. Phones will get smarter about user context and behaviour.



Revolutionizing interactions: Advanced natural language processing and computer vision could allow for much more conversational, intuitive interfaces on phones powered by AI. Rather than tapping apps, people may simply talk to their phone similarly to a smart assistant similar to 'Alexa, G-speech, or SIRI.' Are we going to witness the phase-out of Android, Magic OS, and, IOS OS? It is highly likely that all phones will be powered by AI.

Reinventing the camera: AI promises phones that can take professional-grade images and videos through computational photography. Features like intelligent composition, lighting adjustment, motion prediction, and manipulation of photo subjects after the fact could become standard.

Anticipating user needs: With on-device machine learning, people may no longer have to actively search for or input things. Phones may predictively provide relevant information and recommendations at the right time based on understanding habits and interests.

While current AI phone capabilities are narrow, steady improvements in ondevice intelligence and dedicated neural processing units will likely yield much more automated, conversational, contextual, and visual-based interactions over the next 5-10 years. The phone will morph into an intelligent assistant more than an app launcher.



# PHONE APPS WILL DISAPPEAR IN A DECADE'S TIME

Phone apps have become an integral part of daily life for many people, providing convenience and efficiency for various tasks. However, the technology landscape is constantly evolving, leading to a gradual phase-out of apps for a more app-less phone experience, thus paving the way for AI+ phone use, in which users give instructions to their phones in a manner similar to "SIRI."

This will be the format or method of accessing app features in the future, becoming an important part of the digital ecosystem for years to come.

#### AI WILL AID IN CENSORSHIP AND NON-MSM NARRATIVE

The artificial intelligence (AI) algorithm will aid in content moderation and censorship, with a significant impact on eliminating non-mainstream media narratives when the migration to an app-less phone is complete, and when the use of AI mobile handheld devices is in full gear.

We have seen instances where platforms like Google's Gemini failed to display pictures of the 'White.' Similarly, any algorithm-based system can be

influenced by various factors and may not always provide a balanced representation of different perspectives. This could lead to the elimination of certain individuals, news reports, history, events, and other content, from the information space, based on specific algorithmic input in the systems.


It is crucial to understand that AI systems are only as good as the data and algorithms they are trained on, and they can be improved and refined over time to address such concerns.

As AI aids in content moderation, striking a balance between ensuring a safe and inclusive online environment and preserving freedom of expression, and diverse perspectives will be critically difficult. Due to the lack of alternatives, people can only learn about what these systems offer them.




he practice of analyzing and actively participating in invisible conflicts is commonly referred to as spiritual warfare.


