Policy Regarding Payment / Cancellation

In case of cancellation of tour/travel services due to any avoidable/unavoidable reason/s we must be informed in writing. Cancellation charges would be effective from the date we receive letter in writing and cancellation charges would be as follows:

Registration and Planning Fee (Non Refundable)

A **\$350 per person non refundable registration and planning fee** is due at the time of booking and is **included as part of the initial booking payment**. This fee covers tour development and planning time, supplier coordination, administrative processing, and reserved group space. **In the event of cancellation for any reason, this \$350 fee is retained and is not refundable**, regardless of the cancellation date. All other payments are subject to the cancellation schedule listed below.

1. Due at time of booking - 25% of the tour/service cost.
2. 90 Days prior to arrival of the tour - 50% of the tour/service cost.
3. 60 Days prior to arrival of the tour - 100% of the tour/service cost.
4. **Any cancellations received within 60 Days prior to arrival of the tour or NO Show – 100% of the tour/service cost (No Refund – Full retention charge).**
5. **Any services included in the group program not availed by any participant are non-refundable.**

Refund:

In regard to refund of unused/initialized services (which are paid for and canceled in advance) the refund amount (after deduction/ relevant expenses/ fees) would be worked out on the basis of cancellation policy as described above and the money would be accordingly refunded to the person who has made the payment to us. **Please note that the refund process may take 4-5 weeks due to banking procedures OR can be adjusted in future tour bookings.**
