Arrive in Casablanca, Morocco's largest city on the Atlantic coast, where French influenced Moresque architecture blends with contemporary design.

Visit the magnificent Hassan II Mosque, one of the largest mosques in the world and an extraordinary showcase of Moroccan craftsmanship.

After your visit, continue with your private English speaking driver to Rabat, the elegant and tranquil capital of Morocco. Rabat balances ancient city walls, historic landmarks, and peaceful gardens with a modern and cosmopolitan atmosphere.

Discover hidden workshops where artisans weave textiles, hammer copper, create pottery, and prepare leather in traditional tanneries. Visit madrassas and inner courtyards that reveal the layered history and artistry of Fez.

Visit a local farm to select fresh seasonal produce, then continue into a **cave style** home where you will **cook side by side with a Moroccan family**. Learn traditional techniques, prepare a full meal, and experience the deep warmth of Amazigh hospitality.

Savor mint tea inside the cave and listen to stories that bring local culture to life.

Afterwards, continue to **Sefrou** to meet Amina Yabis and the **women she has empowered** through her work with silk button craftsmanship and cooperative development.

Participate in a couscous rolling experience with the women and enjoy the dish you created together, followed by a joyful traditional dance and celebration.

Today is designed for you to **experience Marrakech** in a way that feels vibrant, elevated, and personal.

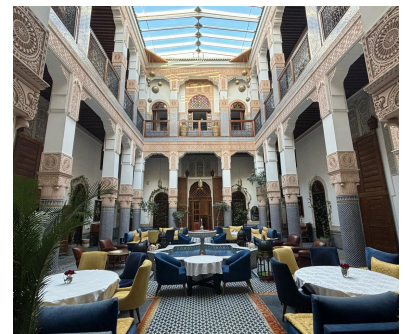
