

Privacy – The Coalition of Jamaican Alumni Associations of Florida Website

Effective Date: April 30, 2026

The **Coalition of Jamaican Alumni Associations of Florida** (the "Coalition") is committed to respecting and protecting the privacy of its website users. This privacy policy (the "Policy") sets out how the Association collects, uses, and protects personal information provided by website users.

1. Collection of Personal Information

The Coalition may collect personal information from website users, including, but not limited to, the following:

- Contact information, such as name, address, phone number, and email address.
- Professional information, such as current or past employment, job title, and industry
- Educational information, such as the name of the educational institution attended, degree or certification, and year of graduation
- User-generated content, such as comments, messages, or other submissions made on the website.

2. Use of Personal Information

The Coalition may use personal information for the following purpose:

- To communicate with users, including sending newsletters, event invitations, and other updates related to the Association's activities
- To provide services to users, such as connecting alumni with each other for networking, job opportunities, etc.
- To improve the Association's website and services.
- To comply with legal obligations.

3. Sharing of Personal Information

The Coalition may share personal information with third parties in the following circumstances:

- With service providers who help us provide the website and its services, such as website hosting and email distribution.
- With educational institutions, to verify alumni status and connect alumni with each other.
- With alumni, for the purpose of networking and connecting.
- With law enforcement or other government agencies when required by law or to protect our legal rights.

4. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

The Coalition's website may use cookies and other tracking technologies to improve user experience and monitor website traffic. Users may be able to disable cookies in their web browser settings, but this may affect certain features of the website.

5. Security of Personal Information

The Coalition takes reasonable measures to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or destruction. However, no data transmission over the internet or storage system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

6. Links to Other Websites

The Coalition's website may contain links to other websites, which are not governed by this Policy. Users should review the privacy policies of those websites before providing any personal information.

7. Children's Privacy

The Coalition's website is not intended for use by children under the age of 13. The Association does not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13.

8. Changes to this Policy

The Coalition may update this Policy from time to time. The effective date of the current Policy will be posted at the top of the page. Users should review the Policy periodically for any updates or changes.
