Helps patient accomplish treatment plan and accept therapeutic devices by:

Administering manual exercises

Instructing, encouraging, and assisting patients in performing physical activities, such as nonmanual exercises, ambulatory functional activities, and daily-living activities

Using assistive and supportive devices, such as crutches, canes, and prostheses.

Occupational Therapy

Maximizing the patient's functional independence within his or her home

Increasing the patient's and caregiver's knowledge of proper therapeutic techniques

Ensuring that the patient and family adhere to the prescribed treatment program.
