

Lithuania Visa Guide

➤ Schengen Visa (Type C)

Purpose

- Tourism
- Business meetings
- Family visits
- Conferences
- Short training
- Medical visits

➤ Stay Period

- ✓ Maximum **90 days within any rolling 180-day period.**

➤ Required Documents

- Passport
- Visa application
- Passport photographs
- Travel insurance
- Flight itinerary
- Hotel booking or invitation
- Proof of financial means
- Employment or business documents

❖ Processing Time

- ✓ Usually **around 15 calendar days**, although additional checks can extend processing.

➤ National Visa (Type D)

Suitable For

- Certain long-term work categories

- Exchange students
- Researchers
- Seasonal workers
- Athletes
- Volunteers
- Other eligible long-term purposes under Lithuanian law

➤ **Validity**

- ✓ **91 days to 12 months**
- ✓ Applications are submitted through the **MIGRIS** information system and then completed via the authorized external service provider where applicable.

➤ **Temporary Residence Permit (TRP)**

Suitable for:

- Employment
- Study
- Family reunification
- Business
- Research
- Other long-term residence categories
- ✓ Applicants normally begin the process in the **MIGRIS** portal before attending an appointment for biometrics and document submission.

➤ **Employment-Based Immigration**

For most non-EU nationals, the process generally includes:

1. Receive a job offer from a Lithuanian employer.
2. Employer completes required labour market formalities (where applicable).
3. If required, obtain a work permit or labour market decision.
4. Submit a National D Visa or TRP application through MIGRIS.
5. Attend biometric appointment.
6. Receive approval.

7. Travel to Lithuania.
8. Complete registration and begin employment.

➤ **Seasonal Work**

Suitable for:

- Agriculture
- Food processing
- Hospitality (seasonal roles)
- Tourism-related work
- ✓ A seasonal work permit may be required depending on the duration and circumstances.

➤ **Student Immigration**

- ✓ Students admitted to recognized Lithuanian educational institutions may apply for:
 - Temporary Residence Permit
 - National D Visa (for eligible categories)

➤ **Required documents generally include:**

- University admission letter
- Financial proof
- Accommodation details
- Health insurance
- Passport

➤ **Family Reunification**

- ✓ Eligible family members of qualifying residents may apply for residence on family grounds.
- ❖ Common documents include:
 - Marriage or birth certificates
 - Sponsor documents
 - Accommodation evidence
 - Financial support evidence
