# The Concept

Examinations in the field of aviation must not only meet the highest standards, but also be constantly up to date in terms of aviation regulations, operational procedures and technical possibilities. ## EASA and ICAO Compliancy

The starting point for the development of our question databases are the specifications of ICAO and EASA. Learning objectives, difficulty levels and published definitions are the basis for conceptual design and implementation. This procedure allows for the greatest possible global harmonisation.

## Adaption to national curricula and syllabi

During implementation with aviation authorities, national and regional regulations and curricula are the main focus. If predefined learning objectives exist, our databases are seamlessly integrated. If they do not yet exist, we implement detailed learning objectives and develop new ones if necessary.

## Regionalisation and Customisation

Generally, all question databases of AIRCADEMY are available in English. For some licences, such as PPL, other languages are also available. Own translations can be implemented on request as well.

# Writing and Review Concept

The development of question databases and questions itself follow a very strict procedure and validated rules. Experts from different fields and international aviation authorities are involved in the procedures, thus ensuring high quality and continuous improvement.

## Types of Questions

Most questions follow a multiple-choice format with three or four answer options, including one correct choice. These questions have many advantages, for example automatic evaluation and the adaptation to different difficulty levels. But also, other question types such as fill in the blank and essay questions are included and possible.

## Images and Attachments

Numerous high-quality images and attachments are implemented in the question databases. They are used for illustrations or as necessary part of the question, such as navigation charts, weather charts and performance tables. They are either directly inserted in the question or provided as digital attachment in case of larger images.

## Development Process

The development of a question comprises multiple steps, starting with the question writing. After the initial writing process, the question passes different reviews by other experts. This is necessary to minimise individual biases and to ensure that each question is appropriate for the examination.



## Authors and Experts

Numerous experts from the fields of aviation law, technology, cockpit, cabin, human performance, meteorology and much more contribute to the high quality and continuous improvement of the databases. Aviation authorities are also involved in the process and act as a supervisory body.

## Review and Update Procedure

All AIRCADEMY question databases are regularly updated according to requirements. Current technical and legal developments as well as feedback from users are considered. Regular updates take place approximately 2-4 times per year depending on operational needs and the type of QDB.
