What a year! A year in which three corporate foundations are funding three major construction, expansion, and compliance upgrade projects! A year in which our annual fundraising exceeded projections by 18% and surpassed 2024 by 77%!

This is the year when Froggies Family community has grown significantly and become more diverse, with members who are increasingly loyal and engaged! It's also the year we revamped our communication tools with a new website and launched our LinkedIn page!

All of this enables us to carry out projects on the ground through our trusted local partners, Teach Love Care Network (TLC) and Hewlin Compassion (HC), and thus, through various programs, to help 1,000 children over the course of the year (school sponsorship, construction / renovation / expansion of the facilities that care for the children, food distribution).

We recognize the (growing) responsibility that comes with the trust placed in us and, more than ever, we are committed to upholding impeccable governance as an ethical imperative.

This pivotal year of 2025 heralds a 2026 unlike any other!

2026

This is indeed a special year with a different rhythm, thanks to our six-month relocation in Cape Town. It is the perfect time for us to prepare for the next decade of Froggies Family's impact by immersing ourselves in the communities we've chosen to support and the ecosystem that surrounds them.

Our main objectives are as follows:

- to support our local partners (TLC, HC) in streamlining their existing activities, thereby ensuring their sustainability and future growth.
- to raise awareness of Froggies Family and build its reputation locally, with a view to, among other things, launching a fundraising approach in South Africa.

- understand and master the governance and operational model issues related to a potential presence (and thus growth) in both countries: Froggies Family (as we know it) and Froggies Family South Africa.

Our guiding principle is to stay focused and reposition our efforts on education (by reducing food aid), while strengthening the foundations of local organizations to ensure a clear vision and sustainable growth.

As we write this report, we have been settled here for eight weeks. Every day spent here reminds us of this country's potential, but also of its complexity—the sources and mechanisms of which we will strive to further understand.

What we are convinced of, however, is the ever-present need to provide sustainable assistance to these disadvantaged children and thereby make a modest contribution to breaking the intergenerational cycle of poverty.

The sheer scale of the task can sometimes make our heads spin a little, but we are equally encouraged by the number of people with good intentions and established, recognized NPOs that are increasingly organizing themselves locally and pooling their expertise to implement systems that work toward systemic change addressing the root causes rather than the symptoms.

Together with our long-standing partners, this is the path we wish to follow as well: Focus, Collaboration, and Long-Term Impact!

EDUCATION

Programs that facilitate access to education and improve learning conditions for children living in the Bloekombos townships. Support programs for vulnerable children in Parow.

- ♥ Sponsorship Center
- 📍 Bloekombos Primary School - Kraaifontein
- 🤝 Partner: Hewlin Compassion

- Sponsorship of 40 children starting Grade 1. Provision of school supplies at the start of the school year and throughout the year (school and gym uniforms, backpacks, shoes, and school supplies). Weekly support sessions for extracurricular activities, including field trips and events such as the end-of-year party. Parent involvement through monthly meetings. Progress reports sent to sponsors every quarter. 100% of the children advance to Grade 2.
- Weekly mentoring of 20 middle school students (Grade 7) and 20 high school students (Grade 11), including hands-on experience supporting Grade 1 children. The impact of their weekly volunteer work includes helping with cooking, cleaning the center, and leading activities—thereby helping them develop transferable skills in event coordination and community engagement.

- ♥ Drop-in center
 - 📍 Parow
 - 🤝 Partner: Teach Love Care / El Theos

- Funding for a pay raise (+1,500 rand per month) for the social worker, whose expertise in supporting street children is vital (and recognized by the institutions).
- Organization of “outreach” camps for vulnerable children, and those at high risk. This is an important step in the recovery of these children, who have suffered trauma, neglect, abuse, and repeated losses of loved ones. Trust is built between these children and the staff who care for them daily at the El Theos center.
 - May 2025, 3 days, 20 children aged 12 to 18
 - July 2025, 3 days, 100 children aged 10 to 18.
- Organization of a Christmas party for 140 children, including the distribution of a school supply kit and a hygiene kit.



CONSTRUCTION / RENOVATION

Funding programs for construction, renovation, expansion, and compliance standards upgrades at various child care facilities.

- ♥ Sponsorship Center
- 📍 Bloekombos Primary School - Kraaifontein
- 🤝 Partner: Hewlin Compassion

- Conversion of a recycled shipping container into a 14m² extension to serve as a kitchen and storage area—so that the existing space can be dedicated solely to the activities of the sponsorship program.
- Painting the exterior walls (maintenance) of the main “building”

- ♥ Victory Educare creche
 - 📍 Bloekombos - Kraaifontein
 - 🤝 Partner: Teach Love Care

- Construction of a perimeter fence and installation of a gate to ensure the safety of the creche.

-
- ♥ Drop-in center
 - 📍 Parow
 - 🤝 Partner: Teach Love Care / El Theos

- Construction of a dedicated, protected, and covered 50m² space (an extension of the main building, which is a creche) to separate activities and create a dedicated space for the welcoming and activities of vulnerable children (psychological support, child protection, re-enrolment in school, provision of food and hygiene supplies, and preparation for school).



NUTRITION

Meal distribution programs for children in the facilities we support (expanded since COVID to include the most disadvantaged communities in the area we operate).

- 📍 Bloekombos Primary School - Kraaifontein
- 🤝 Partner: Hewlin Compassion

- Meals are served to each of the 40 children attending the sponsorship center twice a week, in accordance with nutrition counselling programs.
- Weekly food packages are distributed primarily to the families of the five volunteers assisting with the sponsorship program, as well as to the 40 low-income families of the sponsored children.

- ♥ Lilitha, Elokhanyo, Siphamandla creches
 - 📍 Wallacedene - Kraaifontein
 - 🤝 Partner: Teach Love Care

- Daily food distribution ("Soup Kitchen" - 5 days a week) by the creches to the community (children and adults). 146,000 meals (1 dish) served.

-
- ♥ Families
 - 📍 Kraaifonten, Kuils River, Eerste River, Athlone
 - 🤝 Partner: Hewlin Compassion

- More than 10 tons of food collected from registered partners (Food Forward SA, SA Harvest, Ladle of Love). Funding for collection, processing, and distribution costs: 65% benefits children in the sponsorship program and their families/communities, 20% for mentors (Grade 7 and 10) and their families, 15% for street distribution. 1,800 people reached each month.

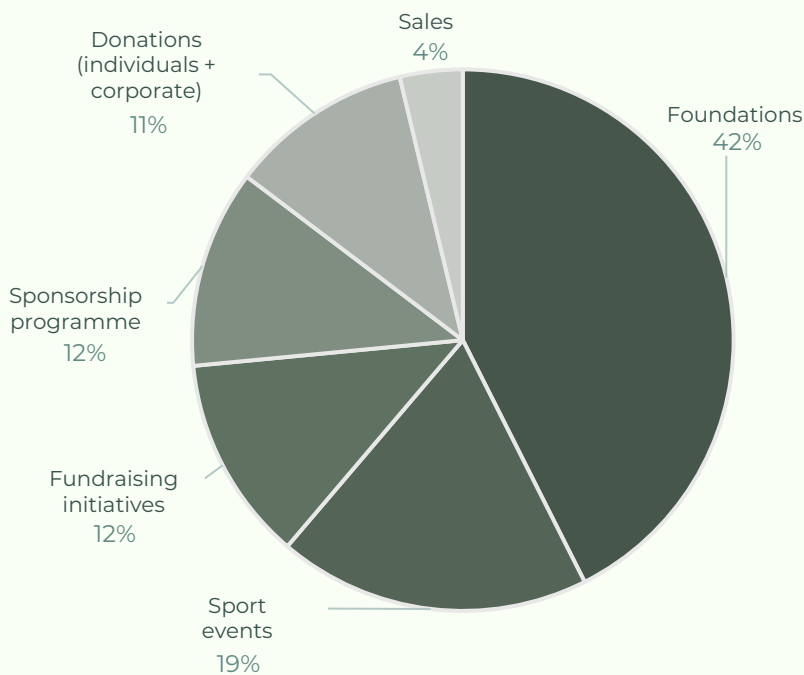

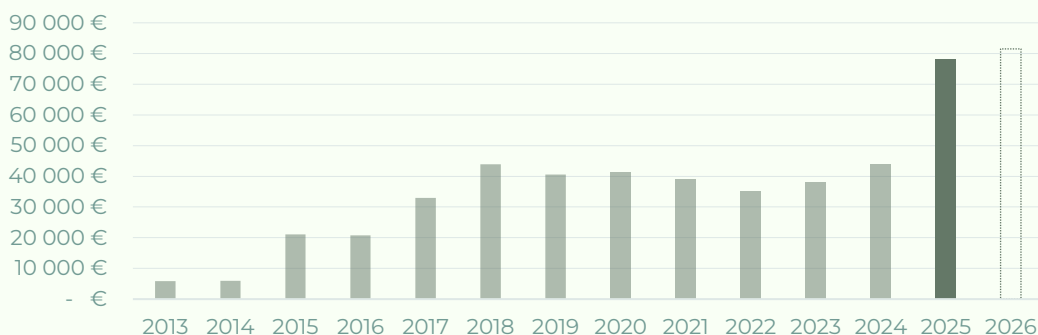
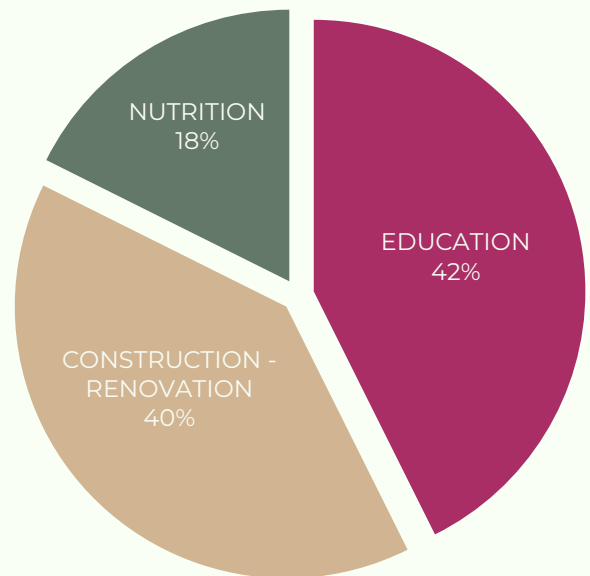
