

**FOUR CORNERS SAFETY ASSOCIATION  
CONTRACT FOR 6 HOURS BEHIND-THE-WHEEL DRIVING LESSONS**

**Please note that this is a legal and binding contract. Read entirely before signing it.**

Each lesson is 2 hours long and costs \$80/hr. The 1st lesson is \$190, 2nd is \$190 and 3rd is \$120. Total cost for 6 hours behind-the-wheel (BTW) is \$500. **This does not include the fee for the drive test. If paid in full, student has one year to complete the 6 hours of driving with 4CSA.**

Payment can be made in cash, check (made to 4CSA) or Venmo (fcsadgo–Venmo is accepted for total payment only). If paying by Venmo, there will be an additional fee of \$10 assessed to cover fees (total \$510).

All returned checks will be charged \$25 return fee and only cash or Venmo will be accepted after that.

Every student under the age of 18 is expected to have a parent’s signature on this contract. If you are over 18 years old (or an emancipated minor) you are able to sign for yourself.

Every student of any age must have on their person a valid permit. If the permit is temporary, it must be whole, legible, untorn and un mutilated. A digital ID will be accepted however the following inspection must be passed:

- Holder must close and reopen the myColorado app to show their digital ID.

- The holder of the ID must rotate their phone and the hologram must move.

A static photo is not allowed.

- Holder must press on the ID so tester can see if the text size enlarges.

Please note that summers are very busy for 4CSA and we book up fast for drive times. Winter driving may be rescheduled during inclement weather. Please also take note that we live higher than town and there may be times that we have to cancel because we cannot get out.

Each student’s time schedule will be worked out on an individual basis. Student will meet their instructor at our office location which is 1911 Main Avenue in the north parking lot. The instructor will be in a vehicle clearly marked “Driver Education.” Please plan to arrive a few minutes early. On sunny days, please have sunglasses (if worn) and **be sure to bring student’s permit.**

If student is unable to drive at the scheduled time, please call our office **at least 24 hours in advance** and an attempt to accommodate the student will be made. If the student **does not show up** for an appointment or **shows up without a permit**, there will be a **\$50 fee collected before the next lesson.**

If student misses a scheduled drive time and does not call before 3pm the day before the driving appointment, or arrives too late for their scheduled appointment, he/she **will be assessed \$50.00**, and will have to reschedule.

If the student is physically ill or emotionally/physically impaired by attitude, drug or alcohol use or anxiety (for example if their pupils are dilated or they are unable to sit still and/or pay attention) our instructors reserve the right to choose not to drive that session.

If student decides not to complete the 6 hours BTW, **there will be no refund** issued.

We suggest students drive the last of their 6 hours close to the time they plan to get their license (which will be **AT LEAST 12 months AFTER** they get their permit if they are under 18 years old).

When the BTW is complete and all fees have been collected, we will submit documentation to the DMV and the **completion forms will be emailed from the DMV.** Replacement and/or additional completion certificates cost \$25 each regardless of whether they are picked up, emailed, or mailed.

Before the student is licensed, they must take a driver’s licensing test. Currently, the DMV does no testing. The driver’s test must be taken with a 3rd party. We are the only school in Durango to do this. This test must be booked with our secretary and **will cost \$65.**

We as a school will do our best to teach the student driver how to not only pass the Colorado Driver’s License test but also how to be a defensive driver with the tools needed to safely drive anywhere. **We cannot, however, assure that students will drive safely and defensively after they finish their 6 hours of driving with us OR that they will pass their first driving test.**

This agreement constitutes the entire contract between the school and the student, and any verbal assurances or promises not contained herein are not binding on either the school or the student.

Under this agreement an instructor may not provide behind-the-wheel training to more than two individual students per session. 4CSA’s policy is one on one instruction, with **parents encouraged to ride along.**
