The year strengthened the foundation's core work in education, healthcare, women livelihood, digital literacy, donor engagement and community celebrations.

Kalam Centers / Abhyasikas

Daily learning spaces supporting children in underserved communities.



Program Highlights

- 8 centers running across community locations
- 150+ children attending daily evening sessions
- Academic support, value education and learning motivation
- Focus on regular attendance and continued learning



Health Activity & Breast Cancer Screening

Extending accessible healthcare, awareness and early detection support to vulnerable communities.



Free Medical Camps

Organized free medical camps at 5 places and covered 1,000+ patients through consultation and basic health support.

Breast Cancer Screening

Screened 520 women; 296 were referred for mammograms; 27 positive cases were referred to Basavatarakam Cancer Hospital with support from DEEP Trust.

Skill Development for Women

Livelihood training in bangle making and embroidery to strengthen financial independence.



Annual Progress

During April 2025 to March 2026, 90 women received livelihood-oriented training. The first phase trained 60 women in bangle making and embroidery in the Golconda area. The second phase trained 30 women in bangle making. The initiative successfully created livelihood for 15+ women, helping them earn around ₹5,000 per month.



Digital Learning Centre

Building basic computer skills and employability pathways for madrasa and degree students.



6 Computers

Established a digital learning centre with six computers.

10 Madrasa Students

Trained in basic MS Office skills.

8 Degree Students

Trained in MS Office and Digital Marketing.

Future-Ready Skills

Computer literacy, typing practice and workplace readiness.

Digital literacy is a new growth area for the foundation, connecting traditional education settings with practical modern skills.

Scholarships & Educational Pathways

Helping students access government and private scholarship opportunities.



The foundation facilitated 70+ students in applying for different government schemes from State and Central Government, covering students from Class 9 to Graduation. Students were also guided for private scholarships through the Buddy4Study portal.

Pink Marathon for Breast Cancer Awareness & Republic Day Celebrations

800+ students participated in the annual Pink Run / Pink Marathon awareness event, supporting early detection and community health awareness.

Republic Day was celebrated at 10 centers with 150+ children, strengthening civic awareness, unity and national pride.
